TONIGHT'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field for tonight's game, as your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (Los Angeles Dodgers) host the Fresno Grizzlies (Colorado Rockies) in the first game of a six-game series. Tonight is a Healthy RC Recycle Tuesday, as fans that pledge to recycle ten CRV-eligible bottles and cans on our website can get a free Club Seat Ticket for the game. Tickets are available by visiting rcquakes.com.

VS THE GRIZZLIES: Today's game is the seventh of 12 against the Grizzlies in 2024 and the first of six at home. Back in June, the Quakes split a six-game set with the Grizzlies at Chukchansi Park in Fresno. Last season, the Quakes went 5-7 against the Grizzlies, 4-2 here at home.

LAST GAME: The Quakes won their third straight with a 6-2 win over the San Jose Giants, giving them four of six in the series. Rancho starting pitcher Christian Zazueta (1-2) enjoyed his best day as a Quake, as he took a perfect game into the fifth inning. He'd allow just one run on one hit while striking out a career-high eight batters in earning his first win. Offensively, Juan Alonso had three hits, matching his season-high, including a two-run double in the first inning against Giants' starter Ryan Vanderhei (2-2). Wilman Diaz had two hits and drove in a pair as well.

MIGUEL ROJAS ON REHAB: Dodgers' injured infielder Miguel Rojas makes his first rehab appearance of the year with Rancho, as he's scheduled to DH and hit second tonight against Fresno. Rojas was injured on July 21 against Boston, with a right forearm strain. He's hitting .271 with three homers and 21 RBIs over 67 games this year with the Dodgers. Rojas appeared in two rehab games in 2023 for the Quakes, slugging a homer and driving in two. All Dodger rehabbers are sponsored by Yaamava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel.

HISTORIC NIGHT FOR DECKER: Cameron Decker missed the first three games of the San Jose series, after being hit by a pitch in the previous series at Inland Empire, but he had a week's worth of production this past Friday, in Rancho's 17-5 win over San Jose. Decker had a career-night, matching a franchise record held by Mike Darr (1997) and Jorbit Vivas (2021) by going 6-for-6. He set a new franchise record with ten RBIs, surpassing the previous high of eight, set by Ibandel Isabel (2017), Quincy Lattimore (2017) and Jesus Galiz (2023).

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes had their busiest transaction day of the year today, with nine total moves. The headliner is Dodgers rehabbing INF Miguel Rojas. In addition, the Quakes have transferred INF Sean McLain, OF Juan Alonso and RHP Christian Ruebeck to High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League. They've also placed RHP Gabe Emmett on the Injured List and released LHP Moises Brito. Joining the Quakes are tonight's starting pitcher LHP Sterling Patick, OF Eduardo Quintero and INF Eduardo Guerrero. The Quakes now have 27 active players.

STERLING PATICK: Left-hander Sterling Patick makes his Cal League debut and just his seventh pro appearance, his sixth start. He joins the Quakes from the Arizona Complex League, where he was 0-1 with a 5.93 ERA over six games (five starts) and 13.2 innings. His last outing was July 24, where he allowed just two hits over two scoreless innings in a no-decision against the Milwaukee Brewers ACL club. Patick was an 18th rounder in the 2023 draft out of South Hills High School in West Covina, CA.

ALBERT PACHECO: Lefty Albert Pacheco makes his 18th appearance, 17 start and second start against Rancho. In his lone start against the Quakes, he allowed three runs on four hits over 5.2 innings in a no-decision at home on June 11. Pacheco's last start was on July 31 vs the Storm, where he tossed five shutout innings, allowing three hits. Pacheco was signed by the Rockies in 2019 out of the Dominican Republic.
