HIGHLIGHTS

RODON'S ROAD BACK: In Tuesday's series opener, Carlos Rodon made his Yankees organizational debut with 3.0 IP, 1 ER on 2 H and 5 K. Rodon threw 52 pitches to 10 batters and retired the final eight that he faced. Today, Rodon will make the second start of his rehab assignment, as he works his way back from a left forearm strain and a back injury.

WHAT A RELIEF IT IS: After 3.1 perfect innings of relief by the Patriots bullpen combination of lan Hamilton, Blas Castaño and Alex Mauricio on Saturday night, Somerset's bullpen has now combined to post a 1.65 ERA over 27.1 IP with 38 K in the five games of this week's series. In the month of June, the Patriots pitching staff possesses a Double-A best 2.78 ERA, which ranks fourth among all MiLB teams, and 1.09 WHIP, which ranks third.

EVER-SINCE HE'S RETURNED: On Friday night, Everson Pereira made his return to the Patriots' lineup for the first time since May 30. He went 2-for-2 with a walk, his eighth homer of the season and 3 RBI. Dating back to May, Pereira now has a 14-game on-base streak in tact in which he has slashed .444/.500/.778 with 4 HR, 9 RBI, 8 R and a 1.278 OPS.

PATH TO THE POSTSEASON: Somerset's 12-1 win on Friday night locked up the Patriots' second consecutive first half championship in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. Entering May 28th, Somerset trailed Portland by a season-high 5.5 games. From that day forward, the Patriots have gone 18-6 with a +52 run differential and 40 HR in the next 24 games.

SEE YOU IN SEPTEMBER: Today the Patriots and Fisher Cats will round out the Eastern League's first half slate. Somerset and New Hampshire will not meet again until the final week of the regular season, when the Patriots visit the Flsher Cats for the only time this season.

2022: Spent all of 2022 with High-A Hudson Valley, tying for second on the team with 20 GS, ranking third on the team with 104.2 IP and fourth on the team with 88 K. Over his final 12 games of the season (nine starts) dating back to 6/28, he went 5-2 with a 2.93 ERA (58.1 IP, 53 H, 44 K, 30 BB).

2021: Split his professional debut season between Single-A Tampa and the FCL Yankees, combining to go 5-3 with a 5.37 ERA (55.1 IP, 43 H, 71 K, 35 BB, 4 HR) in 17 games (10 starts)... Was named the Low-A Southeast League Pitcher of the Week for the week of 9/5, after tossing six scoreless innings in his start on 9/3 at Bradenton (W, 6.0 IP, H, BB, 9 K). Across three starts from 8/20 - 9/3, Abeyta went 2-0 with a 0.57 ERA (15.2 IP, 4 H, 20 K, 6 BB, 0 HR). Following the season, he played for Surprise in the Arizona Fall League and went 1-1 with a 10.13 ERA (10.2 IP, 12 ER) in eight appearances.

College: Coming out of high school as a catcher, Abeyta transitioned to pitching upon beginning his college career at Modesto Junior College (CA) in 2018. Working as the team's closer during his freshman season, he went 1-0 with a 1.62 ERA and five saves over 16 appearances (16.2 IP, 15 H, 22 K, 14 BB). During his second season as a pitcher, he went 5-4 over 17 games (10 GS) with one save and a 4.55 ERA (65.1 IP, 70 H, 60 K, 27 BB). Following two seasons at Modesto, Abeyta transferred to the University of Nevada in 2020, leading the Wolfpack with two saves, closing out both of the team's wins in the COVID-19 shortened season.

Personal Notes: Lettered in both baseball and basketball at Ceres High School (CA). Was named an All-League performer at catcher and was Team MVP, batting .354. **Career Notes:** Signed with the Yankees as a non-drafted free agent on June 20, 2020, following the COVID-19 shortened college season and MLB Draft.

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (1st year)

Dominguez begins his 1st season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 9th overall as a manager and 17th overall coaching in the Yankees organization. He spent the past two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and was assigned to the same post for 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dominguez becomes the 5th manager in Patriots franchise history and the 3rd since becoming the Yankees Double-A affiliate. He succeeds 2022 Eastern League Manager of the Year Dan Fiorito. Dominguez also previously served as the defensive coach for Trienton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). The Panama City, Panama native has managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). From 2012-2015, his teams finished at least 10 games over .500, including reaching the DSL semifinals in 2012 and 2015. An outfielder during his playing days, Dominguez signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent in 2001 and spread four minor league seasons for New York between the DSL and the GCL. After a groin injury that landed him on the IL in May, Wells returned to playing with Single-A Tampa from 6/25-7/4, spending eight games with the Tarpons and hitting .231 with a .950 OPS and 2 HR. Wells was promoted to Somerset on 7/5/22, ending the season with 55 games for the Patriots, plus the postseason. From the point Wells joined Somerset on 7/5/22 through the end of the season (playoffs included), he led all Eastern League batters with 51 RBIs. In total, Wells led the Patriots in the following offensive categories from the time he joined the team through the end of the regular season: AVG (.261), HR (12), RBI (43), SLG (.479), OPS (.839), H (55) and TB (101). Overall, Wells ranked among the Yankees' minor league leaders in HR (20, 4th) and RBI (65, 3rd). During his time playing for the Patriots in 2022, Wells lived at teammate Anthony Volpe's house in Watchung, alongside teammates Max Burt and Blake Perkins. 2021: In Wells' pro debut season during 2021, he combined to hit .264/.390/.476 in 103 games with an OPS of .886, 16 HR, 76 RBI and 82 R between Single-A Tampa (65 games) and High-A Hudson Valley (38 games). Wells ranked among the Yankees' minor leaguers in BB (2nd), R (2nd), RBI (3rd), OPS (4th), 3B (T-4th) and XBH (5th). Following the 2021 MiLB season, Wells played for the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League. Across in 18 games during the fall, Wells ranked 6th in the AFL with a 1.034 OPS, adding 2 HR and 14 R. His 18 RBI were tied for the most of any catcher in the AFL. Among his honors while at Arizona, Wells was first named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year in 2019, when he was also a Freshman All-American honoree per Collegiate Baseball, Baseball America, NCBWA and Rawlings. In 2020, Wells was a Collgiate Baseball Second-team All-American and was named to the Buster Posey National Collegiate Catcher of the Year Award watch list (top NCAA catcher). During the summer of 2019, Wells played in the Cape Cod League with the Yarmouth-Dennis Red Sox. In 42 regular season games, where he was named a Cap Cod League All-Star starter, after hitting .308 with 7 HR, 26 RBI and 23 R. Wells was named a 2019 Cape Cod League Outstanding Pro Prospect.

Personal Notes

Wells spent his preps career at powerhouse Bishop Gorman High School in his hometown of Las Vegas, combining to hit .428 with 87 RBI and 85 during his preps career. He was named team captain and Most Valuable Player as a junior and senior. As a junior, Wells was the 2017 Nevada Gatorade Player of the Year. Upon graduating high school, Wells was originally selected by the Yankees in the 35th round of the 2018 MLB Draft. After electing to play college ball at Arizona, the Yankees selected him again in the first round of the draft two years later, 28th overall. For the second consecutive season, Wells is living with close friend and former teammate Anthony Volpe's family in Watchung, New Jersey.
