WINNA' WINNA'! The Sounds won their fifth straight game, marking their longest win streak of the season as they beat the WooSox 2-1 Saturday night in another close game. Nashville's five-game winning streak is the longest win streak since winning six in a row from August 28-September 3 of last season, defeating Charlotte in four straight games, then winning two more at Norfolk the following week. **The Sounds will go for their fourth six-game series sweep since moving to the longer series ahead of the 2021 season.** The swept both Gwinnett and Columbus in back-to-back weeks during a 15-game winning streak from May 15-June 3, 2021. Nashville's last six-game series sweep - on the winning side - came June 13-18, 2023 against the Strippers.

FEELIN' STRZE-LUCKY: Right-hander Peter Strzelecki will make just his second career start in Sunday's finale against the WooSox. His other start came with the Indianapolis Indians last season against the Louisville Bats on April 12, but had a rough first career start as he worked 1.2 innings, allowed six runs on six hits and had two punchouts in a loss. Strzelecki has posted an 0-1 record with a 3.24 ERA in seven relief appearances for the Sounds this season, and a 13-10 career minor league record with a 4.62 ERA in 218 appearances. The 31-year-old veteran was with Nashville from 2021-2023 and currently has a 5-1 record with a 3.62 ERA in 45 relief appearances with the Sounds.

CLUBBED IT: Infielder Jett Williams ripped his first homer of the season to left field on a solo shot as the Sounds jumped out to a 1-0 lead with his leadoff homer. It was Williams' 9th career lead-off homer and his first at the Triple-A level. He hit three of his nine career leadoff homers last season with his last coming on July 11, 2025, vs. Altoona. The Brewers' no. 3 prospect has clubbed 32 career minor league homers, including a single-season career-high 17 last season when he was with Double-A Binghamton and Triple-A Syracuse. Williams recorded his third multi-hit game of the season going 2-for-4 Saturday night. He's recorded 77 multi-hit games in his four-year campaign, including 31 last season.

DOUBLE-THREAT: Outfielder Eddys Leonard recorded a team-leading sixth double of the season on a gapper to left center field in the bottom of the sixth inning Saturday night. Leonard is currently on a four-game hitting streak which ties for his season-long, and is now tied for 10th in the International League in doubles. He had a single-season career-high during the 2022 season with 32. Leonard's longest streak with a double was four games from May 10-13 of the 2022 season when he was with High-A Great Lakes, while the most doubles he connected on in a single game was three against Double-A San Antonio when he played for the Tulsa Drillers (LAD).

A LITTLE CHILLY OUT: Will Childers extended his current streak without an earned run allowed to eight games and 9.0 IP after working a season-high 2.0 IP in Saturday's win. The right-hander leads the Brewers farm system with his 62 total appearances and 13 saves since the start of the 2025 season. Childers has allowed just six hits over his 9.0 IP this season while his 13 strikeouts are tied with Drew Rom for the most by any Sounds reliever in 2026.

STRIKEOUT MACHINE: Nashville's pitching staff put together another 10+ strikeout night and the third against the WooSox, including 13 punchouts on Tuesday, April 14. The Sounds have posted 11 10+ strikeout games on the season, while they have totaled 186 strikeouts and are ranked 8th in the International League. Since 2005, the Sounds pitching staff have recorded 46 15+ strikeout games, while the highest strikeout total was at 19 when they did it twice, both against Gwinnett, on August 13, 2022, and May 11, 2023.

A LOT OF WINS: With a pair of wins on Friday, Nashville reached 3,500 wins in franchise history. The two wins also gave the Sounds their second series win of the year and a winning streak of four games, their longest of the season so far. After dropping five-of-six games to Gwinnett last week, the Sounds have responded with four straight wins over Worcester who began the week 10-4 and in second place in the International League.
