FOR STARTERS: The Rocket City Trash Pandas conclude their first series of the second half with the finale of a six-game series at Montgomery. The Pandas have lost a club-record 14 straight games, and are coming off a 3-10 homestand, going 0-7 against the Chattanooga Lookouts and 3-3 vs. the Pensacola Blue Wahoos. The Pandas are 2-15 so far this season against Montgomery and 1-10 at Riverwalk Stadium. Montgomery leads the all-time series, 37-21. Rocket City returns home for three games with Knoxville, July 1-3, then travels to Knoxville for three, July 4-6.

PANDAS BLOW NINTH INNING LEAD ON SATURDAY: The Montgomery Biscuits secured a 3-2 walk-off victory against Trash Pandas on Saturday night at Riverwalk Stadium. The Trash Pandas initially led 2-0 after Nelson Rada hit a two-run homer in the third inning, his first of the season. Rocket City starter Jorge Marcheco dominated early, retiring the first 11 consecutive Montgomery batters, and 4.0 shutout innings. However, the Biscuits rallied in the fifth and ninth innings, aided by key errors from the Trash Pandas. A fly ball mishap allowed the tying run to score in the bottom of the ninth, and Tres Barrera's sacrifice fly clinched the win for Montgomery. The game featured just three hits with Rocket City's lone hit coming on the Rada home run, and two for Montgomery, alongside three errors committed by the Trash Pandas.

RADA REPORT: CF Nelson Rada, the youngest player in the Southern League at 19 years and 10 months, leads the Southern League, and is 4th in Double-A with 28 stolen bases this season, including 19 in May. He hit his first home of 2025 on June 28 at Montgomery, his second as a Trash Panda and first since June 7 of last season against Pensacola at Toyota Field. Rada ranks among the league leaders in stolen bases (1st, 28), OBP (4th, .391), batting average (5th, .288), walks (T-9th, 36), and hits (T-5th, 71). Rada has recorded a team-best 21 multi-hit games, including four three-hit games.

RADA SINCE MAY 21: Rada has reached base safely in 30 of 34 games, since May 21, and ranks fourth in the Southern League with a .311 batting average over his last 33 games since May 21, collecting 38 hits.

NOT THE GOOD KIND OF STREAK: The Trash Pandas have dropped a club-record 14 straight games since June 14. The streak exceeds when Rocket City had dropped eight consecutive games in 2023 (9/3-9/12) and 2021 (9/5-14). The 14-game losing streak is the longest in MiLB this season. Altoona dropped 15-straight games in 2024 (4/19-5/4), and Augusta lost 14-straight (7/19-8/4) in the Southern League, Pensacola suffered an 11-game losing streak from May 20-31.

BLANKENHORN BLASTING OFF: Travis Blankenhorn has hit in nine of 12 games since returning from the Injured List on June 13; the veteran outfielder is batting .310 (13-for-42) with three doubles, five home runs, 12 RBIs, and a 1.108 OPS. He's upped his batting average from .145 to .212.

FIVE HOMERS IN FIVE GAMES: Blankenhorn hit five home runs in five games, June 22-26, including his eighth career two-homer game on Wednesday. He was the first Trash Panda to hit two home runs in a game this season, and the first since Christian Moore did so on August 9, 2024, against Birmingham at Toyota Field. With homers on Sunday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, Blankenhorn became the fifth Panda to homer in three straight games, and first since Jeremiah Jackson, June 22-24, 2023 vs. Montgomery. Other Trash Pandas that have homered in three-straight games or more include Luis Aviles Jr. (4 straight games, 7/6-9, 2021), David MacKinnon (3 straight games, 7/6-9, 2021), and Ryan Aguilar (3 straight games, 5/15-19, 2022).

DENZER DEMANDS RESPECT: The 21-year-old ranks among the Southern League leaders in doubles (7th, 14), RBIs (13th, 35), extra-base hits (T-7th, 22), and home runs (T-11th, 8).

NEW HALF, NEW TRASH PANDAS: In June, the Trash Pandas have had 25 roster moves impact the roster, with 10 moves coming on June 17. Only 17 of the current 28-man roster were active on May 19. Newcomers joining the June line include OF Oscar Colás (6/3), 1B Evan Edwards (6/3), INF David Mershon (6/17), INF Ben Gobbel (6/17), LHP A.J. Block (6/17), RHP Sam Ryan (6/17), while OF Travis Blankenhorn (IL, 6/7), C Jaxx Groshans (Dev. List, 6/24) and RHP George Klassen (IL, 6/7) have been reinstated from the IL, or Dev. List.

EDWARDS BACK IN MONTGOMERY: New addition, Evan Edwards played 161 games for Montgomery during the 2022 and 2023 seasons. In 2022, over 261 plate appearances, he posted a .220 batting average, .349 on-base percentage, and .425 slugging percentage, with a 14.6% walk rate and 34.5% strikeout rate. In 2023, he hit .251 with a .356 on-base percentage and .823 OPS, along with 16 home runs, 69 RBIs, and 17 stolen bases.

SWEET HOME ALABAMA: The Trash Pandas are in a stretch of 34 consecutive games played in the state of Alabama. This stretch began on May 27 and will continue through July 3. During this time, the Pandas will play six road games in Birmingham from (6/3-8), six games in Montgomery from (6/24-29), and 22 home games at Toyota Field.

LEADING THE LEAGUE IN ATTENDANCE...AGAIN: The Trash Pandas have led the Southern League in attendance in each of the team's first four seasons, and there are no signs of it slowing down. Despite two brand new ballparks, Rocket City leads the league by averaging 4,366 fans per game.

ANOTHER ONE LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: On June 20, Robinson Piña became the third former Trash Panda this month and the sixth in 2025 to make his Major League debut. He pitched for the Miami Marlins against the Atlanta Braves, entering in the top of the eighth inning. He became the 42nd player for the Rocket City Trash Pandas to move on to the Major Leagues. The 6'5" Dominican right-hander was 4-6 with a 4.48 ERA over 78.1 innings pitched, striking out 80 batters and walking 39 across 23 games, including 11 starts, from 2021 to 2023. Piña joins former Pandas, Christian Moore (debuted on June 13), Alan Rangel (June 6), José Fermin (April 26), Edgar Quero (April 16), and Michael Darrell-Hicks (April 11), who all debuted this year.

KEEPIN' IT QUALITY: Starter Joel Hurtado is T-1st in the Southern League (with Ian Mejia, COL) with seven quality starts and leads the league in generating 94 groundouts. He ranks fourth in the Southern League with 72.2 innings pitched. He also ranks among the Southern League leaders in starts (T-5th, 13), wins (T-7th, 5), ERA (6th, 3.10), and WHIP (11th, 1.29).

ADDITIONAL NOTES (CONT)

MAKE IT STOP!!!: During the last homestand, the Trash Pandas faced weather delays that totaled 6 hours and 20 minutes. This season, Rocket City has had 14 home games affected by rain delays or postponements, adding up to 9 hours and 2 minutes of total delay time. According to wunderground.com, rain has been recorded on 22 out of 37 home game days. Despite these challenges, Rocket City continues to lead the league in attendance.

FARRIS WHEELIN' AND DEALIN STRIKEOUTS: LHP **Mitch Farris** is second in the Southern League in strikeouts with 75 over his first 12 outings in 2025. In his first year in the Angels' organization, Farris has 225 career strikeouts in 179.2 innings across 41 games—an 11.3 K/9 mark for his career.

PROSPECTS WITH A HALO: The Trash Pandas roster features four of the Angels' top 10 prospects and nine of the top 25; included in the top 10 are RHP **George Klassen** (3), LHP **Sam Aldegheri** (5), OF **Nelson Rada** (6), and INF **Denzer Guzman** (9). The other members of the roster included in the Top-30 include LHP **Samy Natera Jr.** (16), RHP **Walbert Ureña** (17), RHP **Joel Hurtado** (19), and RHP **Camden Minacci** (21).

THE YOUNG GUNS: The Trash Pandas have three of the nine youngest players in the Southern League. For the second-straight year, OF **Nelson Rada** is the youngest player in the Southern League at 19.8 years old (8/24/05), the only player in the league born in 2005. INF **Denzer Guzman** is the eighth-youngest at 21.4 years old (2/8/04), and RHP **Walbert Ureña** is the ninth-youngest, just 14 days older than Guzman, born on 1/25/04 at 21.4 years old (1/25/04).

MAY WAS A GOOD MONTH FOR BROWN AND RADA: Over 26 games in May, **Sam Brown** finished 4th in the league in batting at .301 (28-for-93), with eight extra-base hits, and 14 RBIs, and **Nelson Rada** finished 2nd in batting at .325 (27-for-83), and 2nd in OBP (.467). Rada led all of Double-A and was 3rd in MiLB with 19 stolen bases.

ANOTHER WALK-OFF AT TOYOTA FIELD: Wednesday night's walk-off single in the 10th inning by **Cole Fontenelle** was the second of the season for the Trash Pandas. This was the first walk-off since **Denzer Guzman** hit a walk-off homer in the ninth inning on April 5 against Chattanooga. Overall, it marked the 24th walk-off victory for the Trash Pandas at Toyota Field.

MLB EXPERIENCE: The Trash Pandas boast seven players on the roster with Major League experience after the recent additions. **Sam Aldegheri** made his MLB debut on August 30, 2024, for the Angels, vs. Seattle, and made three starts for the Angels over the remainder of the season. **Kelvin Cáceres** made his debut for the Angels on September 27, 2023, vs. Texas, and appeared in two total games that season. **Jesus Cruz** made his MLB debut for on August 18, 2020 for the Cardinals, and has appeared in eight games between the Cardinals (20) and Braves (22). **Jordan Holloway** made his MLB debut on July 26, 2020, for the Marlins, and appeared in 15 games (4 starts) for Miami from 2020-2023, posting a 3.29 ERA. **Sean Poppen** made his MLB debut on June 19, 2019, for the Twins and has appeared in 63 games for the Twins (10), Pirates (3), Rays (1), and Diamondbacks (49) since 2019, posting a 5.08 career ERA. **José Quijada** made his MLB debut for the Marlins on April 24, 2019, against Cleveland, and has appeared in 140 games for the Marlins (34) and Angels (106) since 2019, logging a 4.64 ERA and eight saves. The only position player with MLB experience is **Travis Blankenhorn**, who made his MLB debut on September 15, 2020, for the Twins against the White Sox. Overall, he's played in 49 career games for the Twins (2), Mets (24), and Nationals (23) since 2020.

DARRELL-HICKS, QUERO, FERMIN, AND RANGEL LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE:

- The Philadelphia Phillies recalled right-hander **Alan Rangel** on June 6, and made his MLB debut on June 7 against the Pirates, becoming the 40th player to play for the Trash Pandas, and be "Launched to the League." He pitched 3.0 innings, allowing two unearned runs on three hits, issuing two walks, and striking out 1—his first MLB strikeout coming in the 5th inning (Nick Gonzales). Having spent over a decade in the minors, Rangel pitched for Rocket City in 2024, making four starts, going 2-0 with a 2.61 ERA across 20.2 innings, posting 25 strikeouts. Rangel was placed on the IL on May 14, and released by the Angels on July 1.
- The Los Angeles Angels called up right-handed reliever **José Fermin** from Rocket City, becoming the 39th player promoted from Rocket City to the Majors. Fermin, third this season, and 13th to bypass Triple-A. Fermin was 3-0 record and a 1.13 ERA in six relief appearances this season, and was the first Southern League pitcher to earn three wins. A native of the Dominican Republic, he began his professional career in 2024 and advanced through the Angels' minor league system.
- The Chicago White Sox promoted **Edgar Quero** from Triple-A Charlotte, and he made his MLB debut on April 17 vs. Oakland. He picked up his first hit on April 18 at Boston. Quero, a 22-year-old switch-hitting catcher from Cienfuegos, Cuba, was acquired by the White Sox in a 2023 trade with the Los Angeles Angels involving pitchers Lucas Giolito and Reynaldo López. Quero skipped High-A and joined Rocket City in 2023. In 60 games, he posted a .242 batting average with 2 home runs, 32 RBIs, and 35 runs scored. His on-base percentage stood out at .378, thanks to 45 walks.
- Former Trash Pandas pitcher **Michael Darrell-Hicks** had his contract selected by the Angels on April 6 but was optioned back to Triple-A Salt Lake on April 7. The Angels recalled Darrell-Hicks again on April 11 from Triple-A Salt Lake and made his debut that day against the Houston Astros. In his debut appearance, he pitched one inning, allowing four earned runs on three hits and issuing three walks ... He was 6-4 with a 1.73 ERA over 30 relief outings in 2024 for the Trash Pandas, earning eight saves in ten chances and 46 strikeouts to eight walks over 41.2 innings. Overall, Darrell-Hicks had a 6-7 record in Rocket City over 33 games and three starts, striking out 58 and walking 13 over 53.2 innings in 2023 and 2024.

FONTENELLE'S CYCLE: Not only was Cole Fontenelle's cycle on April 8 vs. Knoxville the first in Trash Pandas history, but it was the first in the Southern League since former Smokies star Moises Ballesteros did it on June 15, 2024, at Biloxi. Fontenelle led off each at-bat, which has only been done once in MLB history, by Todd Helton in 1999 against the Florida Marlins. The last LA Angels' minor league player to hit for the cycle was José Rojas, who hit for the cycle on May 11, 2018, while playing for the Double-A Mobile BayBears. Rojas completed his cycle with a grand slam in the eighth inning, leading the BayBears to a 14-3 win over the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park.
