ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn scored seven early runs and held on to beat Jersey Shore 7-5, clinching a series victory having taken the first four games. RHP **Luis Moreno** put together his first quality start in a month, allowing two runs over six innings. INF **Jose Peroza** and OF **Jaylen Palmer** each mashed home runs. Mets INF **Eduardo Escobar** went 0-for-3 as the designated hitter in his second and final rehab game with the Cyclones. RHP **Trey McLoughlin** tossed the final three innings for the victory and the 11th consecutive triumph over the BlueClaws.

DIVISION ON THE LINE: Including today, the Cyclones have 14 games remaining and three series: two games at Jersey Shore, six games vs. Wilmington, and six games at Winston-Salem. Brooklyn is vying for a playoff spot with a second half division title in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, sitting in second place just a half game behind first place Hudson Valley.

PEROZA PRODUCING: Since July 9, INF **Jose Peroza** has a OPS of .925 over his past 37 games with a 25-game on-base streak. The 22-year-old Venezuelan has been on base in 36 of the past 38 games, hitting .329 with a .418 OBP. In August, Peroza leads the league with 30 hits and nine doubles.

CRACKING THE CRABS: OF **Alex Ramirez** leads all Mets minor leaguers with 122 hits. In seven games against Jersey Shore, the No. 4 Mets prospect is hitting .419 (13-for-31) with four doubles, two home runs, and 12 RBIs.

JT JOLTING: Since returning from injury on August 17, 1B **JT Schwartz** is hitting .303 with a .893 OPS, going 10-33 with four doubles, a home run in eight games. Coincidentally, Schwartz's first game back from injury was also the day he fell from the No. 19 spot in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Mets list to being out of the ranking.

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate sits in last place in the North Division of the at ShoreTown Ballpark in Lakewood, New Jersey. Against the BlueClaws, the Cyclones are 20-5 in 25 games. Jersey Shore hosts three of Philadelphia's Top 30 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline*: No. 6 INF Hao Yu Lee, No. 21 RHP Christian McGowan, and No. 27 SS Casey Martin. The BlueClaws own a North Division worst -110 run differential.

TOP 30 UPDATE: *MLB Pipeline's* new rankings that were released last Wednesday: OF **Alex Ramirez** at No. 4, RHP **Mike Vasil** at No. 11, RHP **Dominic Hamel** at No. 12, RHP **Junior Santos** at No. 16, OF **Stanley Consuegra** at No. 23, RHP **Christian Scott** at No. 28 and LHP **Keyshawn Askew** at No. 30.

MASTERS OF THEIR DOMAIN: The Cyclones have allowed the fewest runs in the league and is tied for the fourth-fewest in Minor League Baseball overall, having allowed 473 runs in 118 games (4.0 runs/game).

THAT'S OFFENSIVE!: The Cyclones have scored just 471 runs in 118 games (4.0 runs/game) which ranks second-to-last in the South Atlantic League and fifth-worst in MiLB in fewest runs.

2021 CYCLONES TAKEOVER QUEENS: With Monday's promotion of RHP **Connor Grey** to the Mets roster, the Cyclones saw three 2021 members of the roster earn the callup in the past two weeks. 3B **Brett Baty** has played with the big club August 17 and RHP **Jose Butto** made his MLB debut Sunday in Philadelphia.

BRETT THE BAT: Former Brooklyn Cyclones 3B **Brett Baty** homered again for the New York Mets last night against Colorado. He is also the first from the 2019 Mets draft class to make his debut with New York.

RANKINGS: Dominic Hamel ranks as the No. 12 prospect in the New York Mets organization and the No. 5 pitching prospect in the system.

TREND BEHIND RIGHTED: Of his 14 runs allowed with Brooklyn, six have been runners who reached on a walk. Hamel tied his career high on Tuesday vs. Hudson Valley, walking five batters and then walked three in 2 1/3 innings on Sunday.

PROMOTED: Dominic Hamel, who is the Mets No. 12 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, earned the promotion from Low-A St. Lucie, joining the Cyclones on the Fourth of July.

ST. LUCIE: With the Low-A St. Lucie Mets, Hamel made 14 appearances and 13 starts, posting a 3.84 ERA in 63 1/3 innings. Hamel posted a 27% strikeout rate, 11% walk rate, and a 3.91 FIP.

DOM-INANT JUNE: Hamel posted a 2.84 ERA in June, making five starts. He struck out 30 and walked 10 in 25 1/3 innings.

BEGINNINGS: The Arizona native was drafted by the Mets in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist, signing for \$755,300 and made two appearances for the Florida Complex League Mets last year.

COLLEGE DAYS: Hamel pitched at Dallas Baptist in 2020 and 2021 after two seasons at Yavapai College. At Dallas Baptist in his senior season, Hamel set a school record with 136 strikeouts in 91 2/3 innings.
