

#### LAST GAME

The Baysox dropped their third-straight game to the Richmond Flying Squirrels on Thursday by a 4-0 final. The loss marked the third time this season the Baysox have been shut out, as Bowie was held to a season-low-matching two hits in the defeat. Right-handed starter Carlos Tavera went five frames, allowing a pair of runs. Tavera did struggle with five walks on the evening, tossing 84 pitches, with only 43 of them going for strikes. Richmond got on the board in the second inning after Logan Wyatt lined a ball off the glove of first baseman TT Bowens, who was able to recover with the help of second baseman Anthony Servideo and retire Wyatt, but the hard contact allowed a runner to score from third. Richmond also scored three in the seventh off right-hander Conner Loeprich. Wade Meckler recorded an RBI triple before Marco Luciano laced an RBI double, with Andy Thomas adding an RBI sacrifice fly later in the frame. The loss dropped Bowie to 2-7 in the second half.

### **TODAY'S OPPONENT**

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter the series with an overall record of 41-37. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, Richmond leads the way in the Southwest division second half standings after winning seven of their first eight contests. The Flying Squirrels hold the best ERA as a staff in the Eastern League (3.65) and have made the third-fewest errors defensively (55). Richmond's roster includes nine of the Giants' top 30 prospects (viaMLB Pipeline) - INF Marco Luciano (No. 2 SF/No. 18 overall), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5 SF), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8 SF), RHP Mason Black(No. 10 SF), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26SF), RHP Jose Cruz (No. 29 SF), and OF Wade Meckler (No. 30 SF).

## **TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER**

Right-hander Mason Black is set to take the ball tonight for Richmond. The No. 10 prospect in the Giants' system, per MLB Pipeline, is coming off a sensational month of June in which he won Eastern League Pitcher of the Month honors. In 21.1 innings through his five starts in June, Black allowed just three earned runs (1.25 ERA) while striking out 25 and walking just six. The past five starts for Black have all been scoreless (22.1 innings), including his most recent start on July 1, when he notched five perfect innings against Reading with eight strikeouts, claiming just the second win for a Richmond starter all season. Against Bowie this season, Black has started twice, totaling eight innings with just one run allowed, including four shutout frames with just two hits allowed on 6/14, and a season-high-matching eight strikeouts on 4/27. A third round pick for the Giants in 2021 out of Lehigh University, in his home state of Pennsylvania, Black features a fastball that sits mid-90s, but can touch 98. He also uses a mid-80s slider with sweep and depth, in addition to a low-80s fading changeup.

### THE A-MAYO-ZING COBY

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo's 49 extra-base hits on the season are the most in Minor League Baseball. The No. 8 Orioles/ No. 78 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, also leads the Double-A level in doubles (30), OPS (1.054) and slugging (.623) on the campaign. Mayo has demolished Richmond pitching this season, posting an average of .385 with six doubles, a triple, and three home runs against the Flying Squirrels. Mayo was named Eastern League Player of the Month on Thursday, after hitting .340 with an 1.178 OPS, 10 doubles, and eight home runs.

## STAY HOT, SERVIDEO

Anthony Servideo is coming off one of his best stretches at the Double-A level thus far. Servideo went 6-for-18 this past week with two doubles and his first career Double-A home run. Despite a 1-for-9 start this week, Servideo has drawn four walks across the three games with a pair of stolen bases. Servideo has drawn 10 walks in his past 12 games after having just five in his first 32 games at the Double-A level. Servideo has also collected seven multi-hit games since the start of June, after having just five-career multi-hit games prior.

## **AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC**

Bowie's bat have certainly hit a rough patch this week. The two total runs scored by the Baysox the past two nights is the lowest total in consecutive nine-inning games this season, along with the season-low five total hits through two-consecutive affairs. The Baysox are just 2-for-25 (.080) with runners in scoring position and have left 27 runners on-base through the first three games of the series. In total, Bowie is hitting .229 as a team this season in such scenarios - the fourth-lowest total in the Eastern League, and just .186 as a team with runners in scoring position across its last 16 games. The Baysox have also fallen victim to three runners being thrown out at home this week.

## TANDEM TROUBLES

The abundance of starting pitching experience on the Bowie roster has led to a reliance on tandems at times this season. Despite a collective starters' ERA of 3.92 - third-best in the Eastern League, when Baysox starters enter the game as relievers, they sport a collective 5.61 ERA. Bowie has utilized a tandem in 39 games thus far in 2023, going 19-20 in those contests. Tuesday night was the seventh blown lead from the back end of a tandem for the Baysox this season and the fourteenth time a back-end tandem arm has allowed four runs or more in an outling.




