## JUMBO SHRIMP BLOWN OUT, 12-2

The Jumbo Shrimp lost 12-2 in Tuesday's series opener to the Sounds. Two Nashville runs in the fourth broke a scoreless tie. Will Banfield crushed a home run in the bottom of the fourth, but from there, the Sounds dominated the game. Nashville plated four in the sixth, three in the seventh and three in the eighth to take a commanding lead. A Jacksonville run in the ninth made it 12-2. The 12 runs and 16 hits the Jumbo Shrimp surrendered were the most in a game this season. The 10-run margin of victory matched the club's worst.

### TO THE VICTOR GO THE SPOILS

Jacksonville outfielder **Victor Mesa Jr.** missed the first six games of the season with an injury, but the 22-year-old has quickly made up for that lost time. In 31 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp, Mesa Jr. is 34-for-126, slashing .270/.336/.468/.804 with seven doubles, six home runs, 26 RBIs, 13 walks and 22 runs scored. In 123 games last season with Double-A Pensacola, Mesa Jr. struck out in 22.9 percent of his plate appearances. He has shaved that to 17.1 percent this season with Jacksonville.

# FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 26 of Jacksonville's 40 games (65.0 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including eight of the last nine contests and 11 of the club's last 13 affairs. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 10 of its last 11 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 13-13 in these affairs.

# TWO DOWN, A MILE TO GO

Over the club's last 10 games dating back to May 3, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 66 runs (6.6 per game), tied for the sixth-most in Triple-A during that span. Of those 66 runs, a whopping 38, or 57.6 percent, have come with two outs. On the season, Jacksonville pitching has ceded 123 hits in 111.2 innings pitched with two outs, the second-most in Triple-A. Opponents are hitting .270 with an .819 OPS against the Jumbo Shrimp with two down, which respectively place as the third- and fourth-highest marks at the level.

# **TOUGH TIMES DON'T LAST**

After falling 12-2 on Tuesday vs. Nashville, Jacksonville has now dropped 12 of its last 13 games - its worst stretch since losing 12 of 13 games from June 2-13, 2016. The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled in nearly every facet of the game during this stretch. Offensively over this stretch, the club ranks 29th in Triple-A in batting average (.219), 28th in OBP (.310), 29th in SLG (.337), 29th in OPS (.647), 27th in hits (95) and 29th in runs scored (47). On the other side of the ball, Jacksonville has surrendered the fourth-most hits (128) and tied for the seventh-most runs (80) on the fifth-worst BAA (.284) and seventh-worst OPS-against (.835).

## ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Jonah Bride** has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 33-for-105 (.314/.460/.638/1.098) with eight doubles, one triple, eight home runs, 19 RBIs, 26 walks and 18 runs scored in 31 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks second in the IL in both OBP and OPS, respectively, fourth in slugging percentage, tied for 10th in walks, tied for 11th in home runs, tied for 14th in extra-base hits (17) and 15th in batting average. After posting a 22.4 percent line drive rate and 30.6 percent pull rate with Triple-A Las Vegas in 323 plate appearances with Triple-A Las Vegas in 2023, Bride has compiled a 31.0 percent line drive rate and 45.9 percent pull rate this season with Jacksonville.

# WALK OF LIFE

Jacksonville pitching has excelled thus far in 2024 in not giving out free passes to opponents. The club's 149 walks issued are the fifth-fewest in the International League entering play on Wedneday. Of late, the Jumbo Shrimp have upped their game to a new level, walking three batters or fewer in seven of the last 10 games. On the season, Jacksonville's pitching staff has walked three batters or fewer in more than half of the club's games, a total of 22 out of 40 contests (55.0 percent).

# **SHRIMP BITES**

Over his last 10 games, **Will Banfield** is 14-for-37 (.378/.439/.676/1.115) with three doubles, one triple, two homers, eight RBIs and four runs scored.

## ABOUT KENT

-Emanuel was originally selected by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 19th round of the 2010 draft out of Woodstock High School (Ga.) but opted to attend the University of North Carolina. He later signed with the Houston Astros after they picked him in the third round of the 2013 draft.

-Emanuel made his major league debut for the Astros on April 24,2021 by firing 8.2 innings with just two runs against in a 16-2 win over the Angels. He pitched in relief that day.

-Emanuel was named the ACC Pitcher of the Year following his junior season in 2013 at North Carolina. He went 11-5 with a 3.14 ERA in 21 games, including 18 starts. He helped North Carolina reach the College World Series twice in his three years in Chapel Hill (2011, 2013).

-On November 19, 2021, the Philadelphia Phillies claimed Emanuel off of waivers. He pitched in Philadelphia's organization in 2022 and then the Pittsburgh Pirates' organization during the 2023 campaign.

# 2024 SEASON - Unith Triple-A Indianapolis, Emanuel held left-handed hitters to a .236/.299/.393/.692 slash line in 97 plate appearances. However, right-handed batters hit .344/.384/.552/.936 against him in 281 plate appearances.

-Allowed more than three earned runs in a start just once (four runs, all earned on June 19 against Portland).
