THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2016, the Sounds belted five home runs as part of a 13 run, 19 hit outburst against the El Paso Chihuahuas. Matt Olson clubbed a solo shot, Renato Nuñez, Joey Wendle, and Bruce Maxwell each belted two-run homers, and Jacob Brugman clubbed a three-run blast.

Tonight's Game: The Sounds are back in action to face the Louisville Bats at Louisville Slugger Field. Nashville took last Sunday's win to get the series victory over Columbus. Louisville is coming off a series split at Toledo. Right-hander Jason Alexander makes his first start for the Sounds since being optioned from Milwaukee. He'll face Bats starter Levi Stoudt.

Jason Alexander: 30-year-old Jason Alexander makes his fourth start for Nashville this evening. The right-hander is 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA (15.0 IP/3 ER) with the Sounds. He's also made two outings with the ACL Brewers and one with Double-A Biloxi. Alexander took a no-decision in his last start on July 5 vs. Columbus, holding the Clippers to a couple of runs (2 ER) on six hits in 5.0 innings in Nashville's 15-14 win. His previous three starts for Nashville came on MLB rehab assignment. Alexander was optioned by Milwaukee on July 8. He was placed on the 60-day injured list on February 18 with a strained right rotator cuff. Alexander split the 2022 season between Nashville and Milwaukee, going 2-3 with a 5.40 ERA in 18 outings for the Brewers and 8-2 with a 2.84 ERA in 13 games (10 starts) for the Sounds. Milwaukee signed the California native as a free agent on November 28, 2021. He originally was signed as an undrafted free agent by the Angels on June 21, 2017.

Levi Stoudt: 25-year-old Levi Stoudt gets the start for Louisville out of the All-Star break. The right-hander is 2-3 with a 5.23 ERA (41.1 IP/24 ER) in 12 outings. He also made his Major League debut this season and is 0-1 with a 9.90 ERA (10.0 IP/11 ER) with Cincinnati. Stoudt's last start came on July 8 at Toledo. He yielded four runs (4 ER) on four hits and two homers in 3.2 innings, taking a no-decision in Toledo's 12-8 win. Stoudt made his big-league debut on April 19 vs. Tampa Bay and took the loss, allowing seven runs (all earned) in 4.0 innings. He was Louisville's Opening Day starter against Nashville in game one of the April 1 doubleheader, holding the Sounds to 4.0 hitless innings (3 BB, 4 K). Stoudt checks in as the Reds No. 12 prospect per MLB Pipeline. Cincinnati acquired Stoudt in the Luis Castillo trade on July 30, 2022. He was originally drafted by the Mariners in the third round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Lehigh University.

2023 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in the second half of 2023: First: 6 (Tied), Second: 6, Third: 0, Fourth: 0, Fifth: 0, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

We Were On a Break: Since 2016, the Sounds have yet to lose the first game coming off the All-Star break. They have scored double-digit runs in four of those five wins, including last year's romping of the Bats on July 22.

Sounds Like a Winner: Nashville is 11 games above .500 going into the All-Star break. It is their sixth-best winning percentage entering the break since 2005 and the third-straight season the team has a winning record. In the second half, Nashville trails just St. Paul by a half game in the International League standings.

Lightning Delay: Outfielder Skye Bolt continued his hot month with a game-tying solo homer and double in Sunday's win over Columbus. In seven games in July, Bolt is batting .321 (9-for-28) with four doubles, a triple, homer and 10 RBI.

Brewers on Rehab: Reliever Justin Wilson made his second rehab appearance with Nashville last Sunday, pitching a scoreless sixth inning (1 H, 1 K). He has a 1.80 ERA (5.0 IP / 1 ER) through five rehab appearances between Nashville and the ACL Brewers. Wilson has been on the 60-day injured list all season, recovering from Tommy John surgery on June 3, 2022.

Putting the League on Lock: Nashville hurlers continue to have the lowest ERA in Triple-A (4.23) ahead of Oklahoma City (4.35). Nashville pitchers lead the level rank among league leaders in fewest hits allowed (2nd, 697), runs allowed (2nd, 401), WHIP (2nd, 1.38), opponent average (2nd, .249) and home runs allowed (2nd, 84).

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect (No. 18 in baseball), left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect, who is on the injured list, and newcomer right-handed pitcher Justin Jarvis is the No. 30 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 648-555 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Alexander took a no decision despite exiting with a 6-2 lead after five innings. He held Columbus to six hits and three walks with three strikeouts. Alexander tossed a season high 80 pitches (47 strikes) in his final start on rehab.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Tonight is Alexander's second career start against Louisville and first in 2023. He earned the win for Nashville on May 20, 2022 at First Horizon Park, pitching 5.0 scoreless innings (3 H, 2 BB, 5 K) on 82 pitches.

2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Placed on Milwaukee's 60-day injured list with a strained right rotator cuff on February 18... started rehab assignment at Arizona complex on June 9, making two starts
- Assignment transferred to Double-A Biloxi on June 20... after one start, moved to Nashville on June 25
- On June 30 at Memphis, earned win with 5.1 innings and one run allowed... was first since August 19, 2022 (G1) at Jacksonville
- Took no decision in Nashville's wild 15-14 walk-off win on July 5...was activated and optioned to Nashville on July 8

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 2-3 with a 5.40 ERA in 18 games (11 starts) over four stints with Milwaukee...went 2-3 with a 4.82 ERA as a starter (56.0 IP) and 0-0 with a 7.47 ERA as a reliever (15.2 IP)
- Went 8-2 with a 2.84 ERA in 13 games (10 starts) with Nashville... won six of first eight games (six starts) with the Sounds, posting 2.66 ERA (40.2 IP/12 ER) over span
- At time of promotion on June 1, led International League with six wins
- Made his Major League debut on June 1 at Chicago-NL, tossing a quality start (7.0 IP, 2 ER) in an extra-inning loss... was first Brewer with quality start in MLB debut since Brandon Woodruff in 2017

- Originally signed as a non-drafted free agent by Los Angeles-AL on June 21, 2017
- His older brother, Scott, has pitched in the Major Leagues for Kansas City (2015-17), Los Angeles-ML (2018-21) and San Francisco (2022)
- His oldest brother, Stu, pitched in the Marlins organization from 2004-09

- Graduated from Cardinal Newman HS in Santa Rosa, CA... led them to two league championships and was named Conference Pitcher of the Year
