LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones were upended by the IronBirds, 8-7, on Tuesday night...Aberdeen walked off in the bottom of the 9th thanks to a SS Jackson Holliday single and a wild pitch...Brooklyn tallied 3 home runs in the game...CF Omar De Los Santos and LF Jaylen Palmer pounded solo shots in the 2nd and 4th innings, respectively...3B Mateo Gil added a 3-run blast in the 6th...2B D'Andre Smith added a pair of hits and an RBI...RF Dylan Beaves accrued 4 hits for Aberdeen, including a solo home run in the 7th and a 2-run double in the 8th... Brooklyn pitching walked a season-high 14 batters in defeat.

HOMER HAPPY: Brooklyn smashed a season-high 3 home runs in Tuesday's loss at Aberdeen...CF Omar De Los Santos blasted a solo home run to left in the 2nd and LF Jaylen Palmer added a solo shot off the batter's eye in center in the 4th...3B Mateo Gil added a 3-run blast around the pole in left in the 6th...lt is the most home runs the Cyclones have tallied in a single game since they smashed 4 of them on July 31, 2022, at Hudson Valley...RF Alex Ramírez homered twice in that contest — a solo shot in the 4th and a 2-run clout in the 6th...C José Mena and 1B Joe Suozzi each tallied solo home runs for Brooklyn in the 7th of a 7-0 win against the Renegades.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects on Monday...6 members of the 2023 squad are featured...C Kevin Parada (No. 2), OF Alex Ramírez (5), RHP Blade Tidwell (7), RHP Raimon Gómez (15), RHP Christian Scott (16), and RHP Tyler Stuart (18)...Former Cyclones listed include: INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 1), RHP Mike Vasil (4), OF Matt Rudick (13), RHP Dominic Hamel (14), RHP Junior Santos (19), RHP José Butto (23), RHP Luis Montas (24), OF Rowdey Jordan (25), and RHP Matt Allan (30)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island.

MATEO MASH: INF Mateo Gil has reached base safely in 19 of his last 21 games dating back to May 18 at Hudson Valley...The 22-year-old is slashing .271/.354/.571 and he has registered an impressive .926 OPS, 147 wRC+, .410 wOBA, and .300 ISO in that time...Gil is 19-for-70 at the plate (.271) with 12 runs scored, 6 doubles, 5 home runs, and 16 RBI adding 8 walks...Since that date, Gil is tied for the league lead in home runs (5) with three others...He is also tied for 2nd in extra-base hits (11), 4th in RBI (16) and slugging (.571), tied for 5th in total bases (40), and 6th in OPS (.925)...Gil leads the Cyclones in home runs (6) despite having 28 fewer plate appearances than OF Stanley Consuegra and 100 fewer than OF Alex Ramírez who have each clubbed 5.

1-2, E-STEP: After a bumpy month of April, INF **Chase Estep** picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...ln his last 30 games dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old slashes .289/.345/.452 with a .797 OPS...Estep has accumulated 17 runs scored, 7 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, and 15 RBI in 113 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 118 wRC+...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21...Estep has also raised his batting average by 171 points in that time (.047 to .218).

DOWN TO THE WIRE: DH Kevin Parada delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off victory of 2023 with a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th last Wednesday afternoon vs. Greenville...C José Mena's added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B Chase Estep delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF Alex Ramírez registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF Omar De Los Santos provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen... The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign...ln addition to 5 walk-off wins, the Cyclones have suffered 7 walk-off defeats after Tuesday's loss at Aberdeen...21.1% (12-of-57) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion.

CYCLONE SHUFFLE: The Cyclones made a series of roster moves on Monday... RHP Christian Scott was transferred to Double-A Binghamton, while LHP Quinn Brodey returned to Brooklyn from Binghamton...OF Scott Ota was reinstated from the 7-day injured list and OF Dyron Campos was transferred back to the Florida Complex League Mets...In 6 starts for Brooklyn, Scott tallied a 1-0 record with a 2.28 ERA (6 ER in 23.2 IP) and 27 strikeouts to just 4 walks...Brodey held a 2.65 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) and 23 punch outs in 11 relief appearances during his first stint with the 'Clones...Ota was 0-for-3 in 1 game before landing on the IL on June 1...Campos also went 0-for-3 playing in Game 2 on Saturday vs. Greenville.

BLADE CUTS 'EM DOWN: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision on Sunday, but hurled 4.0 innings and tied a career-best with 10 strikeouts...Tidwell also whiffed 10 on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...Over his last 5 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.77 ERA (4 ER in 20.1 IP) with just 10 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 20 and struck out 33 (14.61 K/9)...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 36.7% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .143 batting average (10-70) against him.

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn hits the road to begin a 6-game road trip against the Orioles' High-A affiliate...The IronBirds posses 7 of Baltimore's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: SS Jackson Holliday (1), OF Jud Fabian (13), 3B Max Wagner (14), OF Dylan Beavers (19), C Creed Willems (21), RHP Trace Bright (27), and RHP Jean Pinto (28)...Brooklyn and Aberdeen are meeting at Leidos Field at Ripken Stadium for the first time since the 2022 SAL Postseason...Aberdeen won both postseason contests at home to defeat Brooklyn, 2-1, in a Best-of-3 series from September 13-16...In 2023, the IronBirds and Cyclones have split the first 6 games of the season series...Both teams won 3 contests in their matchup at Maimonides Park from May 2-7.

TY-NAMIC: At 6-foot-9, RHP Tyler Stuart struck out 9 in Game 2 on Saturday and has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads all qualifiers in the SAL, High-A, and all of Minor League Baseball in ERA (1.47)...The Kankakee, III. native leads the league in LOB% (86.8%) and FIP (2.66), 3rd in xFIP (3.26), and 6th in strikeout rate (30.5%), and 7th in strikeouts per 9 innings (11.20).

JEFE JEFFREY: RHP Jeffrey Colón suffered the loss in Game 1 on Saturday, but permitted just 1 earned run over 5.1 innings...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts on May 26 vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 4 appearances (3 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER in 18.2 IP), allowing 14 hits and 8 walks, striking out 21... In his last 3 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 18.2 innings, allowing 6 runs (4 earned) on 13 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 1.93 ERA and permitted only 6 walks and punched out 20 in that span.

DYLAN THROWS HOT FIRE: RHP Dylan Tebrake has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 8 relief appearances...Tebrake has allowed 2 earned runs (3 total) on 4 hits and 6 walks over 12.2 innings, registering 21 strikeouts (14.92 K/9)...That equates to a 42.9 K% (21/49).

POWER OF PAUL: RHP **Paul Gervase** garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on Friday evening vs. Greenville and added another scoreless frame out of the bullpen at Aberdeen on Tuesday...Among South Atlantic League relief pitchers with at least 20.0 innings pitched in 2023, Gervase ranks 2nd in ERA (1.40)...Only Rome's RHP **Luis Vargas** (1.11) has registered a better ERA in relief this season...Gervase averages 13.33 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 32.8% strikeout rate.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: After dropping Saturday's twinbill to Greenville, Brooklyn dropped to 1-9 in doubleheader games in 2023...4-of-5 doubleheaders Brooklyn has played have been in visiting ballparks...This year, the 'Clones are 23-24 in regularly scheduled 9-inning games.

OH YEAH, OMAR: In addition to his 21 stolen bases in 2023, OF Omar De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 91 stolen bases in that span, which is 6th most in MiLB...Only Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (100), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (98), Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (96), Marliners prospect OF Jonatan Clasé (95), and Royals prospect OF Dairon Blanco (92) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 51 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 40...Omar is already 11 swipes shy of matching INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

CANARSIE'S CROWN PRINCE: IF/OF Jaylen Palmer has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Wednesday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (191), at-bats (629), plate appearances (752), runs scored (97), walks (103), and stolen bases (47)...Palmer passed INF Ronny Mauricio '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (67) on May 23 and is 2 behind INF José Peroza (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (197), 4th in home runs (16), and tied for 4th in hits (116).
