**Last Night: Cubs 8, Locos 5.** Lansing built leads of 3-1 and 5-3, but South Bend scored runs in the 7th and 8th innings to tie things up before tallying three in the 9th to seize the series-opening win. **Felix Stevens** knocked his third home run of the season for the Cubs, while **Brayan Buelvas** swatted his fourth of the year for Lansing in defeat.

### LUG•NOTES

**MLB Sensation:** One of the best stories ongoing in the Majors is the emergence of 25-year-old **Mason Miller**, who made three starts for the Lugnuts at the end of 2022, debuted with the Oakland Athletics in April 2023, and is now the A's lights-out closer, going 8-for-8 in saves with a 1.35 ERA in 13 1/3 innings, posting a 28:4 K:BB ratio while limiting hitters to a .149 batting average.

**Where There's a Will, There's a Way:** 1B **Will Simpson** went 2-for-4 with an infield single and a double last night; he has reached base in 19 of 20 games and leads the Midwest League in batting average (.382), is tied for 2nd in walks (19), ranks 1st in OBP (.511), 1st in OPS (1.114), tied for 3rd in hits (26), tied for 2nd in triples (2), 4th in RBIs (20), tied for 4th in total bases (41) and 5th in slugging (.603). Last year, **Daniel Susac** hit .303 to become the first Lugnut since **Bo Bichette** (2017) to win the Midwest League batting crown.

**League Leaderboard, Will Excluded:** **Colby Halter's** 19 walks tie him for 2nd in the league with teammate Simpson. **Brayan Buelvas** is 2nd in runs scored (20); and **Henry Bolte** is tied for 4th in stolen bases (9).

**Streiking:** **Jonny Butler** went 0-for-3 with a walk last night and has now reached base in 15 consecutive games, while **Brayan Buelvas** is riding a 13-game on-base streak. The longest streak on the team is 17 games, belonging to **Will Simpson**.

**Lighting Up the Scoreboard:** The Lugnuts are tied for 2nd in the Midwest League in runs scored with 126, trailing only the Great Lakes Loons (129). The Nuts are 2nd in the league in walks (111), 2nd in the league in base hits (190) and 1st in total bases (190).

**Putting the Home in Home Run:** The Lugnuts only had one home run in their first 10 home games, but have hit four in their last three games: **Cam Masterman** on Saturday, **Euribiel Angeles** and **Jonny Butler** on Sunday, and **Brayan Buelvas** last night.

**A Grand Start:** On April 3, **Will Simpson** crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

**Prospecting:** The Nuts' roster includes three MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 12) and first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 30). Morales was just activated off the Injured List and made his 2024 Midwest League debut last night; he is the top pitching prospect in the organization. Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** Before an electric crowd of 8,212, the Lugnuts dramatically achieved their 1,000th all-time win in Lansing, 3-2, thanks to a Chris Hopkins walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 9th against Fort Wayne. The win came 5,138 days after the Lugnuts' first victory as a franchise.

**2014:** Aroldis Chapman made a rehab start for Dayton, striking out D.J. Davis and Jason Leblebajian and retiring Mitch Nay on a flyout to left before departing. The game turned into a pitcher's duel before L.B. Dantzler's grand slam highlighted a six-run seventh inning, and the Lugnuts won, 9-6, at Fifth Third Field.

**2018:** With Roger Clemens in attendance, son Kacy Clemens drilled an oppo grand slam onto Home Run Hill in left, but the Lugnuts lost to the Kane County Cougars, 6-5.

**In a Nutshell:** Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts... he has spent all but one MiLB inning (of 93 total professional innings) with the Lugnuts... in last outing, earned his first win of the year with five strong innings at Lake County, April 19, limiting Captains to a third-inning solo tally.

**Good Company:** Shares March 3 birthday with Alexander Graham Bell (1847), Jackie Joyner-Kersey (1962), Herschel Walker (1962), Tone Loc (1966), Jessica Biel (1982), Camila Cabello (1997) and Jayson Tatum (1998).

**Entering Draft Day:** Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

**Inked:** Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Colby Thomas in the third round).

**WVU to the Pros:** First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps featured two WVU teammates in 2021 draftees Jackson Wolf (4th round) and Ryan Bergert (6th round); pitched against Bergert on May 26, 2023, and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last WVU player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who in 2022 joined John Means as the only Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

**Glory Days:** Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

**Off to College:** Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Mid-season Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

**Hometown Hero:** Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system... cousin is Jason Michaels, who played 11 years (2001-2011) in MLB.

**Prospecting:** Until midseason 2023, MLB Pipeline had ranked Watters the No. 26 prospect in the A's organization and the A's No. 12 pitching prospect... his grades: Fastball 60, Curve 60, Changeup 45, Control 45, Overall 40... his scouting report: "Watters is a strong presence on the mound at 6-foot-4. His fastball was up to 99 mph during his junior year and touched triple digits in his time as a reliever. He also possesses a plus pitch in his power curve, missing plenty of bats as a true 12-to-6 that sits in the mid-80s. There's also a mid-80s changeup in there, though it's less polished compared to his other two offerings. Command will need to improve for Watters to have a chance to start at the next level. While the stuff was high-octane in college, he usually had little idea of how to locate it. Given his track record as a reliever, there's a strong chance he ends up back in the bullpen, where he can rear back and overpower hitters with two plus pitches."
