FRES-NOTES

WALK THIS WAY: Fresno continues to be one of the most disciplined offensive clubs in the California League, ranking 3rd in walks (283) and 3rd in on-base percentage (.365) entering Thursday night. Much of that starts with Cameron Nelson, whose 44 walks rank 2nd in the league while his .407 OBP ranks 10th among qualified hitters. The Grizzlies don't need to rely solely on the long ball to generate offense—they consistently force pitchers into deep counts, create traffic on the bases and give their middle-of-the-order bats opportunities to drive in runs.

LEFTY LOCKDOWN: While Fresno's bullpen has battled through injuries and roster movement, two left-handers have emerged as key weapons. Brady Parker ranks 3rd in the California League with 66 strikeouts despite making only two starts, while posting a 1.59 ERA in June with 13 strikeouts over 5.2 innings. Meanwhile, Bryson Van Sickle has yet to allow a run this month, tossing 7.2 scoreless innings while holding opponents to a .185 average. Together, they've given Fresno valuable swing-and-miss stuff from the left side and helped stabilize the pitching staff during a challenging stretch.

STAR POWER AT THE TOP: Few teams can match Fresno's presence on the California League leaderboards. Tanner Thach ranks 1st in hits (82), 1st in RBI (57, tied), 1st in total bases (132), 2nd in batting average (.343), 7th in slugging (.552) and 5th in OPS (.970). Roldy Brito ranks 2nd in hits (78), T-3rd in RBI (51), 4th in runs scored (49), T-5th in doubles (16), 2nd in total bases (120) and 10th in batting average (.316). Together, Thach and Brito have formed one of the most productive offensive duos in the California League.

DOING THE LITTLE THINGS: Fresno enters the series ranked among the league's best at turning offense into wins through situational baseball. The Grizzlies rank 3rd in the California League in runs scored (383) while also ranking 3rd in team OPS (.795) and 3rd in home runs (59). They have reached those marks despite ranking just 6th in stolen bases (55), illustrating that their success has been built more on quality at-bats, extra-base hits and getting runners home than pure speed. Fresno's lineup features four players among the league's top 10 in major offensive categories, helping drive one of the California League's most consistent offenses.
