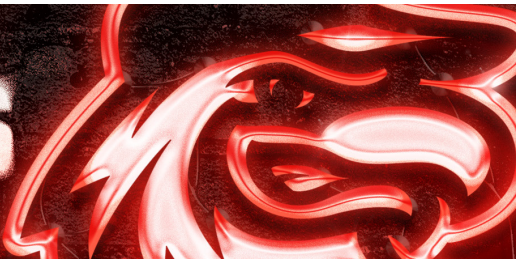

WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Double-A Harrisburg dropped their series opening game to Akron (CLE) last night, 8-6 in 10 innings...1B **ETHAN PETRY** picked up three hits, including his 11th Double-A homer, and an RBI single in the ninth to force extra innings.

🔴 OMAHA, OMAHA, SET HUT! The Rochester Red Wings were victorious over the Omaha Storm Chasers by a score of 8-7 Tuesday night, in their long-awaited return to the Cornhusker State... two home runs from C **MAXWELL ROMERO JR.** powered the Red Wings offense, with the latter serving as the go-ahead run in the top of the eighth inning...three other Red Wings notched home runs of their own to open up the road set against the Storm Chasers... seven different Rochester pitchers saw time on the mound, as RHP **JUSTIN LAWRENCE** picked up his first win as a Red Wing...Rochester looks to string together five wins in a row for the third time this season in game two of their series tonight, sending southpaw **JARED SIMPSON** to the mound against Storm Chasers right-hander Lucas Braun...

🔴 The Red Wings' five home runs are their most in a single game since 7/30/2025 at CLT.

🔴 HOMER'S WORST NIGHTMARE: Taking the mound first for the fifth time as a Red Wing tonight will be southpaw **JARED SIMPSON**...he has not allowed a run in seven consecutive appearances dating back to 7/26 at BUF, including 2.1 hitless innings in his previous outing on 8/15 vs. CLT...Simpson has allowed six hits and two earned runs through his first 11.2 Triple-A innings, while adding 17 strikeouts with a 1.20 WHIP and .143 BAA...as a starter with Rochester, the 26-year-old has fired 6.0 scoreless innings on just two hits, posting a .095 BAA...he is just two strikeouts shy of 150 in his professional career.

🔴 WHERE ART THOU ROMERO: C **MAXWELL ROMERO JR.** reached base five times in last night's one-run victory, going 3-for-3 with two homers, three RBI, with a pair of walks and runs scored...he now has a combined 20 home runs this season (13 w/ HBG), making him the fifth Nationals Minor League to reach that milestone this season...this is the second time he has gone 3-for-3 in his career and the first time he has done so with at least one home run, and marks his fifth career multi-homer game (4th in 2026)...Romero Jr. is one of two catchers in all of Triple-A (Cooper Ingles - COL), with two games this season with at least three hits and two home runs...since making his Triple-A debut on 7/18, the Miami alumni ranks fifth in the International League in SLG (.639), seventh in OPS (1.039), and T-7th in home runs (7)...

🔴 On the road with the Red Wings, Romero Jr. is slashing .378/.477/.919 with six of his seven homers and a pair of doubles across 10 games.

🔴 THE QUARTER CENTURY CLUB: Last night's victory moved the Red Wings to a season-high 25 games over .500 at 72-47, the first time they have reached that mark since finishing the 1997 season 83-58 before going on to win the Governor's Cup over Columbus...72 wins are the most by any Triple-A team (SAC & STP T-2nd, 69) and third-most in Minor League Baseball behind only High-A Bowling Green (TB, 75) and Double-A Tulsa (LAD, 74)...the Red Wings are now just 1.0 game back in the International League second-half race (27-19), sitting in a three-way tie for second behind Indianapolis.

🔴 THE KING HAS LEFT THE BUILDING: SS **SEAVER KING** extended his hitting streak to nine games last night with a third-inning solo homer last night, a high fly ball that carried over the left field fence and came off the bat at 104.7 MPH...he now has five homers over those nine games since 8/8 at SWB...over the course of the streak, the Wake Forest product also carries a .432 batting average (16-for-37) with a .500 OBP while adding two doubles and six RBI...he is now just one hit away from 250 in his professional career.

🔴 UP 6 ADAMS: 1B **RILEY ADAMS** left the yard for the 13th time this season last night, one shy of his career-high set in 2019...the San Diego native finished the contest 2-for-5 while adding a second run scored...over his last 32 games since the Fourth of July, Adams is T-4th in the International League in XBH (18), ranks sixth in OPS (1.027) and SLG (.617), T-6th in total bases (71), T-7th in RBI (26) and runs scored (26).

🔴 I AM KING OF THE CASTLE: 3B **TREY LIPSCOMB** continued his hot streak, finishing the game 2-for-5, with a double and run scored...the former Tennessee Volunteer now ranks in the International League top 10 in nine different categories (AVG 10th, HR 3rd, RBI 2nd, SLG T-3rd, OPS T-9th, H 4th, 2B T-8th, XBH 2nd, and TB 2nd)...Lipscomb's single in the top of the third inning extended his hitting streak to 14 games, the second-longest by a Red Wing this year, only behind **ANDREW PINCKNEY**, who held a 15-game streak before getting called up to Washington.

🔴 GLASS HALF FULL: LF **PHILLIP GLASSER** finished 1-for-4 with a single, an RBI and a walk during Tuesday night's series opener vs. OMA...he has reached base in 24 consecutive games, the fourth-longest active on-base streak in the International League and the longest by a Red Wing in 2026...during the span of the streak, he has an OBP of .432...he is slashing .250/.432/.321 during this streak...

🔴 Glasser is three RBI shy of 150 in his professional career.

Entering his fourth professional season, all with the Nationals organization after he was selected in the seventh round of the 2022 MLB Draft, out of Texas Christian University.

- Optioned to Rochester on 8/4 after pitching 10.5 innings for the Nationals since his recall to the team on 6/29...allowed just one hit in his last four appearances with Washington.
- Since returning to the mound for Rochester on 8/4, the right-hander has tossed 8.0 scoreless innings across four appearances, striking out 14.
- Carries the second-lowest ERA (3.92) and WHIP (1.22) of any Red Wings pitcher with at least 50 innings of work.
- Holds the most strikeouts per nine innings (13.65) of any Triple-A arm (min. 50.0 IP)...furthermore, holds the lowest ERA (2.22) in night games among all Red Wings (min. 20 IP), while also having posted an undefeated record (3-0) in such games.
- Recalled by Washington on 4/24 for his MLB debut the same day at Chicago-AL...allowed two earned on two hits across 2.0 innings of relief, striking out one and walking four.
- Named Nationals Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2025 with a 6-7 record, 3.28 ERA (49 ER/134.1 IP), 135 strikeouts, and 55 walks across 27 games (26 GS) between High-A Wilmington, Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester, setting career marks in nearly every category.
- Began the season with High-A Wilmington...transferred to Double-A Harrisburg on 5/23, and Triple-A Rochester on 8/6.
- Matched his career-high three times with 7.0 innings pitched (4/23, 5/17, 6/19)...set a career-high with 10 strikeouts in game one of a doubleheader on 4/12 against Hub City (TEX).
- Across seven appearances (6 GS) from 6/8-7/27 with Double-A Harrisburg, allowed just five earned across 39.2 innings (1.13 ERA) while holding batters to a .163 BAA.
- Made Triple-A debut on 8/7 at Norfolk, striking out seven across 5.0 innings.
- Has compiled 68 MiLB appearances (67 GS) in his professional career, surpassing 300 career strikeouts in his Triple-A debut.
- 2025 pitch mix; Sinker - 92.6 MPH, 58% usage; Changeup - 85.9 MPH, 18% usage; Slider - 85.0 MPH, 24% usage.

Entering his seventh professional season, all with the Nationals after he was selected in the second round of the 2020 MLB Draft, out of LSU...named an Arizona Fall League Rising Star in 2021 with Surprise.

- Registered his first MiLB save on 6/11 vs. WOR.
- Logged two scoreless outings in three appearances with the Nationals after being reinstated from the Injured List (5/29)...optioned to Rochester on 6/7...recalled by Washington on 7/6 and re-joined the Red Wings via option the next day.
- Began the 2026 season with Washington...appeared in seven games and was placed on the 15-day Injured List on 4/13 with a right rotator cuff strain...sent on a rehab assignment to the Florida Complex League on 5/14, appearing in one game before continuing his assignment with Rochester the next day...completed the assignment and returned to Washington on 5/29, before being optioned back to Rochester on 6/7, called back up on 7/6, before ultimately being optioned again the following day.
- Made his Major League debut on 4/13/2025 at Miami...struck out two in a scoreless inning...tossed five consecutive scoreless outings to begin his career from 4/13-26.
- Ranked among NL rookie pitchers (min. 50.0 IP) in opponents' average (6th, .219) and opponents' slugging (8th, .367)...led all NL rookie pitchers (tied with teammate Jackson Rutledge) with 34 inherited runners and ranked second with 22 inherited runners stranded.
- Tossed a no-hitter from May 10 to May 31, pitching 9.0-consecutive innings without allowing a hit...his 15.1 scoreless innings streak from May 2 to June 7 was the longest by a Nationals pitcher in 2025.
- Earned his first Major League win on 7/2 vs. Detroit...earned his first career save on Aug. 14 vs. Philadelphia.
