### Today's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Ryan Webb** to the mound today looking to even **Andy Tracy's** record as Clipper skipper (361-362).

Indianapolis will counter with RHP **Antwone Kelly**. Columbus is 5-1 (.833) versus right handers this year. Kelly has never pitched against the Clippers in his career (made Triple-A debut last time out, 3/29 vs. St. Paul; 78th career game).

### vs. the Indians

Columbus was 9-9 against Indianapolis last year, despite owning a +13 in run differential (12-5, +45 in 2024; 10-8, -23 in 2023; 12-8, +53 in 2022). Since the start of the 2022 season, the Clippers are 16-6 (.727) in games against Indianapolis that are decided by at least five runs. Individually, **Travis Bazzana** has hit .325 (13x40) with 4HR (all HR in Triple-A career) and 9RBI against Indy in his career (10G).

### Oops

Last night saw the Clippers lose their first game when leading this season, which also happened to be the game in which they had their biggest lead of the season (seven; previous large lead was five, in 6-1 win on Wednesday). Last night also marked the first time this year that Columbus scored before the opponents (5-1 when allowing the first run) and the first time the Clippers lost in the last at bat (3-1).

### Always Halpin Out

**Petey Halpin** nailed two runners at the plate on Tuesday, giving him his first outfield assists of the year (14 in last 50G in the IL, dating to 7/22/25). Since the start of the 2025 season, his 21 outfield assists (130G) pace all of minor league baseball and are 10 clear of 2nd place in the IL. He is also riding a 119G errorless streak, dating to 4/11/25 (committed 10E and had 150FA in 196G of Double-A career).

### Valera Rehab

**George Valera** continued his rehab last night (strained left calf), homering in his first trip to the plate to become the 30th player in Clipper history to reach the 40HR plateau. Valera has played 235G with Columbus over the last five seasons, but has also had five stints on the Clipper DL, missing a total of 148G). Since the 2024 All-Star Break, he is slugging .506 with 14HR in 70G with Columbus.

### Separation

With **Kahlil Watson** (7G, .429OBP) getting the day off, **Travis Bazzana** (7G, .353OBP) has an opportunity to establish the longest on base streak for the Clippers this season (both are tied with 12 others, including Indy's **Esmertyn Valdez**, for longest in the IL). **Nolan Jones** (6G, .500OBP), **Stuart Fairchild** (6G, .571OBP) and **Milan Tolentino** (6G, .458OBP) have also reached in every game this year.

### Big Dog

**Nolan Jones** has hit safely in 14 straight games with the Clippers, dating to 9/21/22, hitting .346 (18x52) with 6HR (.788SLG) and 15RBI over the stretch. Including his time in Albuquerque, he is slashing .331/.450/.676 with 21HR and 72RBI over his last 73G in Triple-A, having reached base in 67 of them (has 20 hitless games). He has also scored 68 times and gone perfect in steal attempts (5).

### East Coast Bias

**Stuart Fairchild** has 13HR in 67G of his International League career, against 13HR in 63G in the Pacific Coast League. His IL average is 21 points higher (.297 to .276) and while he is slugging worse in the IL, his .514SLG is 23% better than the average IL hitter since 2021 (.529SLG in the PCL was 17% better than average). He has hit safely in each of his last 10G in the IL (.459, 17x37 since 9/17/23).

### Eye is for Ingle

**Cooper Ingle** has drawn 6BB in his first 17PA (35%) this season, following a Triple-A debut that saw 21BB in 107PA (20%) last season. Though Ingle has hit only .215 (20x93) in his Columbus career, he has a beefy .403OBP and a +8 differential in the walk to strikeout department (27 to 19). Ingle had a .388OBP in Double-A (79BB to 86K), but was at .439 in Advanced-A (68BB to 48K).

### Filling In

Game eight will find a catcher starting at 1B for the fifth time this year, with **Dom Nunez** getting his third start of the year (17th of career, all with Columbus; **Kody Huff** has 2GS this year and 6GS in his career). **Juan Brito** started at 1B Thursday (32nd career start, all with Columbus; 418 starts elsewhere in the field) and **Dayan Frias** started opening night (47th of 499 career starts).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

## This Date in Clipper History

4/4/2003

Fernando Seguinol went 1x3 with the first of his IL-best 28HR in a 7-1 victory over Indianapolis. The Panamanian slugger finished the day with a .286 average, a figure he would not dip below for the remainder of the season on the way to winning the batting title with a franchise best .341 mark. Seguinol won the MVP in 2003, narrowly missing out on a Triple Crown (87RBI ranked 2nd, six off the lead).

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,407 to 1,352).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers were 132-174 (.431, 2nd worst in the IL) in pitch reviews last season, with batters going 79-117 (.403) and pitchers/catchers going 53-57 (.482). They ran out of challenges in 57G and did not challenge in 13G.

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus was 5-5 in extra innings last season, following a 9-loss campaign in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-33 when playing past regulation (.602, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-16 at home (.619, but 4-6 in last 10G). Of the 83G to require extra play, 66 have needed only one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

## Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

## Return of the Defense

The Clippers were 1st in the IL in defense (.985), a season after turning in their worst fielding percentage (.978) since 2009. They had only two series with more than 5E (8/26-8/31 at Louisville, 9/17-9/21 vs. Omaha), topping out at 3E in a game twice and playing flawlessly 86 times on the year (44-42, .512; 16G errorless streak from 6/20-7/8, longest in the IL over the last 20 years). Behind the plate, Clipper catchers did not have a passed ball from 9/22/24-5/28/25 (53G; 3,949 pitches with men on base between).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

Stuart Fairchild moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 9/16/25 vs. Omaha and those men came around to score in a rare loss (bullpen blew 7-run lead). Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 83-22 (.790) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including an 0-1 (.000) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

## Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following Tony Mansolino's championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; Gene Michael-'79, Joe Altobelli-'80, Frank Verdi-'81, Bucky Dent-'87 and Mike Sarbaugh-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 391-408 (.489), 361-362 with Columbus (.499).
