CURRENT NOTES: Opening day starter, went 1.2 innings with no hits, 2 walks, and a strikeout in his first professional action of his career. Pitched two innings the next week, giving up one run (unearned due to E4). Took loss in his third start after struggling with command at Myrtle Beach...

CAREER: Spencer Schwellenbach was a 2nd round pick of the Braves out of Nebraska in 2021, falling despite being a projected first rounder due to reports of a potential injury during workouts. The Braves were thrilled that he fell to them, and signed him despite knowing he would likely need the Tommy John surgery which sidelined him for the entire 2022 season. Out of Saginaw, Michigan, Schwellenbach was a 34th round pick of the Guardians in 2018, but elected to fulfill his commitment to the Cornhuskers. In college, Schwellenbach was a dominant two-way player his senior year after featuring solely as an infielder his first three years. He held opponents to a .198 batting average with a dominant fastball, recording 10 saves and a remarkable ERA of 0.57. He also hit .284, with 9 stolen bases and 9 home runs. Those stat lines led to him being named as the Big 10 2021 Player of the Year, a first-team All-American, the John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year, a Golden Spikes semifinalist, and more. He is expected to feature as a pitcher.

CURRENT NOTES: Dazzled in his season debut, going 4 scoreless innings with 6 strikeouts...picked up first decision (L) on first game of doubleheader 4/28...

CAREER: Murphy was a two-sport standout, also playing QB and WR for his high school team. During his senior year, he gave up just 10 hits in 58.1 innings while striking out 137 – more than 2 batters per inning. He tossed four no-hitters and two perfect games, while also hitting .548 with 10 homers. He was a projected top-100 pick as a two-way player, but his pitching elevated him to first-round status. He was named the 2022 Illinois Gatorade Player of the Year and was originally committed to Notre Dame, but after being selected 20th overall by the Braves he elected to sign for \$2,560,000. He pitched 5 scoreless innings in the FCL, striking out seven, before giving up six runs in seven innings on just five hits with ten punchouts in three Augusta starts late in the season.

CURRENT NOTES: Stellar in debut, fanning 7 in 3 perfect innings....struggled in 4th inning of work in second outing, giving up 6 hits in that frame and getting tagged for 5 ER....made two fielding errors on 4/29 that cost him two runs...

CAREER: Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in Competitive Balance Round-A as the 35th overall pick in the 2022 Draft. Was the pick acquired by the Braves from the Kansas City Royals in return for prospects Drew Waters, Andrew Hoffman, and C.J. Alexander. Pitched at Bainbridge High School in Washington who finished his senior season with a 0.39 ERA, 0.45 WHIP, 75 K, and 4 BB in 35.1 innings on the mound, allowing just 2 runs on 12 hits on the season as he helped lead his team to the Washington State Tournament. Lost just one game in his entire high school career which occurred his freshman year. Had originally committed to UCLA prior to being selected by the Braves.

BIO

CURRENT NOTES: Became youngest player in last 6 years to play for any affiliate when making start on 4/11...also became youngest GreenJackets pitcher of all time...struck out 4 in 2.2 innings. Struggled in next two outings, coming in relief on Tuesday 4/17 and 4/25...gave up 5 runs on 5 hits including first homer of the year in last two outings of April...

CAREER: Signed as an international free agent out of Columbia for \$75,000 in January of 2022. Was utterly dominant in the DSL as 16 and then 17 year old, becoming a DSL All-Star and pitching 44 innings across 11 games. He struck out 50 batters in that time, with a WHIP of 1.02 and limiting opponents to a .217 batting average. At the age of 17 years, 9 months, and 17 days old on Opening Day, Fuentes becomes just the fifth 17 year old to appear on an opening day roster in affiliated baseball since 2017, and the youngest player since Eguy Rosario in 2017 to feature for an affiliated club. He will turn 18 in June. Known for an "outlier" fastball that can touch 93 as a 17-year old.

Current Notes: Named to Augusta's opening day roster after making 9 appearances (8 starts) with the GreenJackets in 2022, placed on 7-day IL with ankle injury to start season...went 5 innings in first outing, allowing 4 hits and fanning 5 with 0 runs...struggled with command in next outing, going 3 innings in relief on 4/23...got second win on 5/5, going four and allowing one run in 6-5 victory...

2022: Started season with Augusta, making two appearances before being sent down to the FCL Braves. Following 8 dominant starts in the complex, Bautista returned to Augusta, where he recorded wins in the final three starts of the season and two straight quality starts to end the year. Opponents hit .383 against him in Augusta, the highest of any GreenJackets pitcher, argely inflated by his second start of the year, when he gave up 8 runs on 9 hits in one inning of work.
