LHP Matt Wilkinson, tonight's Captains starter, threw 8 K across 5 scoreless innings in his lone start against Fort Wayne back on April 16. The portsider permitted just 3 H and 1 BB in 80 pitches (47 strikes).

INF Jose Devers leads the Midwest League with 16 RBI during the month of July. He is also tied for the MWL lead with 5 HR this month, batting .319 with 15 H, a .702 SLG, and a 1.109 OPS in 12 games played.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Captains tied their season-high with 5 doubles in their 5-2 series finale @ West Michigan. 1B Ralphy Velazguez, MLB Pipeline's No. 6 Guardians prospect, C Jacob Cozart, MLB Pipeline's No. 14 Guardians prospect, RF Wuilfredo Antunez, SS Jose Devers, and 2B Kevin Rivas each logged a double for Lake County. The Captains also tallied 5 doubles back on May 27 @ Cedar Rapids in a 4-3 victory.

KEVIN'S INCREDIBLE WEEK: On Monday, July 14, C/INF Kevin Rivas was named the newest Captain of the Week, presented by Official League, for his impressive series @ West Michigan from July 8-13. In 13 PA across 3 games, the San Felipe, VZ native ranked top-10 among MiLB hitters (min. 12 PA) in AVG (.583, T-3rd), OPS (1.532, T-8th), and OBP (.615, T-10th). After not recording a multi-hit performance in his first 29 games this season across Lake County and the Double-A Akron

TRENDS & NOTABLES

SANTOS STANDS ALONE: On Jan. 30, it was announced that Manager Omir Santos would return for his 3rd season as Lake County's skipper. He is now the longesttenured manager in Captains history, and 1 of just 2 to win a championship County (Ted Kubiak, 2010). With his 171st win with the Captains on June 8 at West Michigan, Santos is now the winningest manager in history. He surpassed 2003 outh Atlantic League Manager of the Year and former longtime Toronto Blue Jays First Base Coach Luis Rivera (2003-04; <u>father of current Lake County Bench</u> Coach Yan Rivera) for the most wins by a manager in Captains history.

A REUNION 13 YEARS IN THE MAKING: On Tuesday, July 8, RHP Tyler Naquin was promoted to Lake County from the ACL Guardians. Naquin, 34, converted to pitcher after an 8-year MLB career as an outfielder from 2016-23. After not playing n 2024, he signed with the Cleveland Guardians as a Minor League free agent on March 6, 2025. In his 1st pro season as a pitcher, Naquin made 13 relief appearances for the ACL Guardians this year, going 2-0 with a 5.14 ERA, 8 K to 11 BB, and a .170 opposing AVG in 14.0 IP. Cleveland originally drafted Naquin with the 15th overall pick in the 2012 MLB Draft out of Texas A&M. Soon after, he played for the Captains during the 2012 Midwest League Playoffs, batting .353 with 6 H, 5 R. 2 2B. 1 RBI, and a .961 OPS in 5 games. Naquin logged a scoreless, hitless inning of relief in his High-A pitching debut on July 9 at West Michigan, striking out the 1st atter he faced and issuing a walk in 16 pitches (8 strikes).

TWO CAPS TO AKRON: On Friday, July 18, the Cleveland Guardians Player evelopment System announced that OF Wuilfredo Antunez and RHP Yorman Sómez were promoted to the Double-A Akron RubberDucks. At the time of their romotions, Antunez was the only MWL player with a .260+ AVG, 30+ XBH, and a .500+ SLG this season, and Gómez was 1 of just 4 MiLB pitchers with 8+ wins. 80+ K, and a 3.00-or-lower ERA this season.

TWO CATS TO LAKE COUNTY: On Friday, July 18, the Cleveland Guardians Player Development System announced that OF **Nick Mitchell** and RHP **Sean Matson** were romoted to the Captains from the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. At the time of his romotion, Mitchell recorded 20 RBI, 24 BB to 21 K, and 21 SB in 23 attempts in 39 games with Single-A Lynchburg this season. Additionally, at the time of his promotion, Matson ranked top-5 among MiLB pitchers (min. 55.0 IP) in fewest R llowed (9, 1st), fewest ER allowed (8, T-1st), ERA (1.21, 2nd), and WHIP (0.84, 4th), while ranking top-10 in opposing AVG (.161, 8th).

HE FASTEST MAN IN MILB IS HERE: On Monday, June 23, OF Tommy Hawke vas promoted to Lake County from Single-A Lynchburg. At the time of his promotion, e left-handed hitter led MiLB in both SB (63) and R (65), while ranking 4th in OBP 453). Hawke is the 1st MiLB player with 60+ SB and 60+ R through a team's first 69 games of a season since at least 2005, a feat that has been achieved just once (Rickey Henderson, 1982) during MLB's Modern Era (since 1901). Across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, Hawke currently leads MiLB with 65 SB, while ranking top-10 in OBP (.444, 4th) and R (68, T-5th).

FOUR-HEADED MONSTER: Former Captains OF Wuilfredo Antunez (14 HR), OF Alfonsin Rosario (14 HR), MLB Pipeline's No. 24 Guardians prospect, and 1B/LF Ralphy Velazquez (12 HR), MLB Pipeline's No. 6 Guardians prospect, and INF Jose Devers (12 HR) have each hit double-digit HR this season. <u>The Captains are 1 of 2</u> ligh-A teams with at least four 12+ HR hitters this year (also Everett AquaSox (SEA), 4 players).

ROSARIO'S ROBUST HITTING: OF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 24 leveland prospect, has been one of the Midwest League's premier hitters this season The 21-year-old ranks top-5 in the MWL in HR (14, T-2nd), SLG (.506, 3rd), and OPS (.880. 4th), Rosario is 1 of 2 MWL players with a .275+ AVG, 10+ HR, and 10+ SB this ason (also SB INF Jefferson Rojas).

WRECK-IT RALPH: 1B/LF Ralphy Velazquez, MLB Pipeline's No. 6 Guardians ospect, has been one of the Midwest League's premier sluggers this season. The 20year-old ranks top-5 in the MWL in 3B (6, T-3") and XBH (33, T-4"), while ranking lop-10 in HR (12, T-6"), RBI (46, T-10"), and TB (129, T-10"). <u>Velazquez is 1 of 4</u> MWL players with 30+ XBH, 10+ HR, and 45+ RBI this season.



BIO

Mokoro (wears #43) enters her first season as Lake County's Bat Dog, and first season with the Guardians organization. The 1-year-old Chocolate Labrador Retriever is owned and trained by **Victoria Brody**. **Brody** is a professional dog trainer who started Mission Empawthy (pronounced "EMPATHY"), LLC, a local dog training company which focuses on specializing in psychiatric service dogs for those whose disabilities aren't always visible. **Mokoro will retrieve bats and balls for the Captains alongside Brody at all Thursday home games and select additional games this season!**

Mokoro is named after a type of dugout canoe found in Botswana. These vessels, which usually carry 1-2 passengers, are commonly used to navigate the Okavango Delta for both transport and game viewing safaris. While mekoro (plural form of "mokoro") used to primarily be made from Jackalberry, Mangosteen, and Sausage trees, they are now mainly made from fiberglass.

LAST TIME OUT: LHP Matt Wilkinson (ND) did not record a decision in an eventual 10-9 Captains road defeat to the West Michigan Whitecaps back on Wednesday, July 9. The southpaw tied his season-high with 5.2 innings pitched, allowing 4 runs on 5 hits, while throwing 6 strikeouts to just 1 walk in 88 pitches (53 strikes). Wilkinson's 4 runs allowed were courtesy of a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the 1st inning, an RBI groundout in the bottom of the 2nd, and 2 bequeathed runners scoring on a 2-out, 3-run triple off Captains RHP Jack Jasiak in the bottom of the 6nd.

TOP 30 PROSPECT: Wilkinson is currently the No. 23 Guardians prospect according to Baseball America. <u>Baseball America on Wilkinson</u>: "He's a functional mover on the mound despite his size and creates plenty of deception thanks to a low release height and crossfire landing. <u>Wilkinson</u> has a three-pitch mix that is uninspiring in a vacuum but effective in practice."

A HISTORIC 2024 CAMPAIGN: Across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, Wilkinson led qualified Minor League pitchers with 13.20 strikeouts per 9 innings and a 37.6% strikeout rate. He also ranked 2nd in MiLB in: strikeouts (174), ERA (1.90), opposing AVG (.169), and WHIP (0.91). Wilkinson became the only MiLB pitcher with a 0.95-or-lower WHIP, 1.90-or-lower ERA, and at least 170 strikeouts in a season since at least 2005.

2024 HONORS: Wilkinson was named to the 2024 All-MiLB Prospect Second Team and Baseball America Second Team Minor League All-Star Team. He was also named a 2024 Midwest League All-Star; as well as MiLB Pipeline's 2024 Cleveland Guardians Pitching Prospect of the Year and the Canadian Baseball Network's 2024 Wayne Norton Award winner (Top Canadian Minor League Pitcher – Affiliated). From his Hip-Obetton May 25 through the end of the regular season, Wilkinson led High-A in ERA (2.30) and opposing AVG (.174), while leading the Midwest League in strikeouts (103). He also finished 2nd in both the Midwest League and High-A in WHIP (0.98) during this span, going 5-5 in 16 regular season starts for Lake County.

PLAYOFF HEROICS: Wilkinson made 2 starts for the Captains during the 2024 Midwest League Playoffs. The left-hander was the only pitcher to log double-digit innings (12.1) during the 2024 MWL Playoffs, while also leading in win percentage (1.000, 1-0), wins (1, tied), and games started (2, tied). Wilkinson saved one of the best performances of his career for last with Lake County's season on the line in Game 2 of the 2024 MWL Championship Series vs. Wisconsin. The southpaw recorded the longest start of his professional career, pitching a career-high 6.2 innings in his first career postseason quality start. He allowed just two earned runs, and two walks, while throwing five strikeouts in a career-high 96 pitches (career-high 60 strikes). Wilkinson ultimately helped force a decisive Game 3, which Lake County eventually won the following night to clinch the 2024 Midwest League Championship.

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": Wilkinson has held the nickname "Tugboat" from a young age. His father's best friend growing up, Phil McNeil, gave Matt the nickname, "after seeing Wilkinson run around the bases at a pace he thought was similar to that of the boat designed to tow larger vessels." MLB.com's Rob Terranova wrote. "I love it, I love being called Tugboat," Wilkinson said to Terranova. "But I don't want people to forget that I'm Matt Wilkinson, too."

THE INVISI-BALL: When Wilkinson trained at the Okotoks Dawgs Academy in Canada early in his career, a place where he still trains during the offseason, one of his coaches, Joe Sergent, took note of the left-hander's unique delivery, particularly for his fastball. "He's just got a certain run and life on his fastball that you don't see in regular pitchers. There's just another gear that comes out of his hand." Sergent told lan Wilson of AlbertaDugoutStories.com. "It's just the way the ball comes out of his hand — we call it the "invisi-ball."

PROMOTED TO THE CAPTAINS: Wilkinson was promoted to the Captains from Single-A Lynchburg on May 21, 2024. <u>The portsider led MiLB with a 1.12 ERA and 71 K at the time of his promotion in 8 starts for the Hillcats, while ranking 2nd with a 0.77 WHIP and 7th with a .159 opposing AVG.</u>

A START FOR THE AGES: On April 25, 2024, Wilkinson made Minor League Baseball history in his start against the Myrtle Baach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC). The left-hander pitched 6 scoreless, hitless innings, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 16 strikeouts in 82 pitches (56 strikes). According to MilLB com's Jesús Cano, Wilkinson became the 5th MilLB pitcher since 2005 to record at least 15 strikeouts without allowing a hift. The MLB pitchers to do this are Hall-of-Famer Warren Spahn (1960), 1971 NL All-Star Don Wilson (1967), Hall-of-Famer Nolan Ryan (3 times), 3-time NL Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw (2014, whom Wilkinson said was his favorite player at the 2015 Little League World Series), and 3-time Cy Young Award winner Mas Scherzer (2015)

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Wilkinson was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April 2024 as a member of the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. In 4 starts, he went 2-0 with a 0.44 ERA, a Minor League-best 41 strikeouts, and a Minor League-best .091 opposing AVG. Wilkinson also allowed just 6 hits and 6 walks in 20.2 innings of work.

VALIANT VAQUERO: After initially committing to the University of Washington, Wilkinson pitched collegiately at Central Arizona College (JUCO), where he was the 2023 NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year, a 2023 NJCAA 1st Team All-American, the 2023 ABCA/Rawlings Pitcher of the Year, and the Arizona Community College Athletic Association Pitcher of the Year. In 2023, he went 10-2 with a 1.07 ERA, 136 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP, and 2 complete games in 16 appearances (14 starts), and won the NJCAA Division I Baseball World Series in 2022. Following his 2023 campaign, Wilkinson eventually chose to forgo his commitment to Arizona State after being selected by the Guardians in the 10th round of the 2023 MLB Draft.

LITTLE LEAGUE LEGEND: When he was 12 years old, Wilkinson had a remarkable performance at the 2015 Little League World Series as a member of Team Canada. In his only start, he pitched 5 scoreless innings against Team Mexico, allowing just 2 hits and throwing 16 strikeouts in a 1-0 defeat. "(The LLWS) was definitely a cool experience, it was like a dream come true," Wilkinson told The Daily Sentinel's James Burky. "It felt like more than a game for the first couple of weeks. Leading up to the tournament, you had to do ESPN interviews, all of those walkup things. I loved it because it was something that I wanted to do since I was eight."

MORE ON WILKINSON: Wilkinson grew up in Ladner, British Columbia, the same hometown as former longtime MLB LHP James Paxton. He has 2 Australian Kelpie dogs, Reggie and Mookie, who are named after Baseball Hall-of-Famer Reggie Jackson and 8-time MLB All-Star Mookie Betts.

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

2 former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut during the 2025 season.

RHP Nic Enright: On Saturday, May 24, RHP Nic Enright was promoted to the Cleveland Guardians. He made his MLB debut on Sunday, May 25 at Comerica Park against the Detroit Tigers, <u>just under 2 ½ years after being diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma.</u> The right-hander pitched 2 scoreless innings, allowing 2 hits and throwing 3 strikeouts on 36 pitches (25 strikes), as Cleveland lost 5-0. Enright made 11 appearances for the Captains in 2021, going 1-0 with a 1.47 ERA, a 32/3 K/BB ratio, a .179 opposing AVG, and a 0.82 WHIP in 18.1 IP. <u>During his tenure with Lake County (May 7-June 24, 2021), the right-hander ranked top-five among Midwest League pitchers (min. 18 IP) in fewest runs allowed (3, T-1st), fewest HR allowed (0, T-1st), fewest earned runs allowed (3, T-3rd), saves (3, T-3rd), fewest walks (3, T-3rd), WHIP (4th), ERA (5th), and K/BB ratio (10.67, 5th).</u>

LHP Doug Nikhazy: On Saturday, April 26, **LHP Doug Nikhazy** was promoted to the Cleveland Guardians as the 27th man for a home doubleheader versus the Boston Red Sox. The left-hander started Game 2 of the twin bill, suffering the loss in a 7-3 defeat. He pitched 3 innings, allowing 5 hits, 6 earned runs, and 6 walks, while throwing 3 strikeouts. **Nikhazy** made 21 starts for the Captains in 2022, going 4-4 with a 3.19 ERA, 118 K, and a .182 opposing AVG in 93.0 IP. <u>His 118 K were tied for the Lake County lead, while his 93.0 IP and 21 GS (tied) ranked 2nd on the team.</u>
