**SPRINGDALE, AR** – In similar fashion to much of the series, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals fell behind early and could not come back, falling 8-2 to the Springfield Cardinals Sunday afternoon at Arvest Ballpark, swept in six games to end the first half.

- Springfield scored four times in the second and three times in the third, jumping out to a 7-0 lead early.
- Third baseman **Jake Means** went 3-for-4, with singles in his first three at-bats, including the fifth, when he came around to score on a two-out Cardinal error.
- Designated hitter **Robbie Glendinning** produced his third straight multi-hit game, going 2-for-4 with his second home run of the week and eighth of the season in the sixth inning, the Naturals' final run of the day.
- While starting pitcher **Anthony Veneziano** could only pitch 3.0 innings, he was followed by 3.0 innings of relief from **Walter Pennington**, the left-hander's best outing of the season, as he struck out four in his second appearance of the week.
- Over the six games against the Cardinals, the Naturals were outscored 53 to 24 (-29 run differential) and out-hit 67 to 46 (-21) ... it was just the fourth series (of 12) this season where the Naturals have been outscored and the highest differential, topping the 12 the Arkansas Travelers outscored them the previous week.
- Of the 54 innings played in the series, the Naturals led after 3 innings (the 3rd through 5th innings on Thursday), were tied after 7 and trailed the Cardinals after 44 of the 54 innings played, or roughly 81% of the week.

### THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 3-8 all-time when playing on June 28

On June 28, 2015, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Tulsa Drillers, 12-1 at Arvest Ballpark. After starting pitcher **Cody Reed** allowed Tulsa to score in the top of the 1st inning, he kept the Drillers scoreless over the next five, then three relievers – **Mark Peterson**, **Daniel Stumpf** and **Malcom Culver** – combined for 3.0 scoreless innings to finish the game. The Naturals scored nine runs in the first four innings to jump out to a large lead and finished the afternoon with 16 hits, including two homers from third baseman **Alex Liddi** (solo homers in the 2nd and 6th innings) and three-hit efforts from Liddi and first baseman **Balbino Fuenmayor**. All nine Naturals in the starting lineup had at least one hit, while seven drove in runs, including a team-best three from left fielder **Lane Adams**.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER**

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 16 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 8 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter** and **John Rave**.

**EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 25-3, while when scoring six runs or less, just 6-34.
- The Naturals are 19-8 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 12-29.
- The Naturals are 29-10 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 2-27 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 20-10, whereas 11-27 when the opponent scores first ... in June, the Naturals have scored first in 7 of 23 games (30.4%) and are 4-3 in those games ... in the recent 12-game homestand, the club scored first three times, the last three games against the Travelers on 6/17, 6/18 and 6/19, not scoring first at all against Springfield.

**ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY**

The Naturals are 3-13 in one-run games this season, meaning 13 of their 37 losses this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the winning run at the plate in eight losses this season (six one-run losses) and had the tying run at the plate or on base in 15 losses this season (including 10 of their one-run losses).

**RIGHT WHERE THEY BELONG**

The Northwest Arkansas Naturals have generally hovered around .500 for most of the season, but the loss Sunday brought the team down to a season-worst six games under .500 with a 31-37 record ... the Naturals have been at or within a game of .500 after 40 of 68 games this season (58.9%).

- The team has peaked at two games above .500, at a 15 - 13 record after the game May 10, but with a low-point of six games under .500 currently.
- After 14 of 68 games this season, the Naturals have ended the day with an even .500 record.
- After 26 of 68 games this season, the Naturals have ended the day within a game of .500, either one game over or under.

**Yo, You Wanna See Some Real Speed?**

Through 68 games, the Naturals have stolen 92 bases in 108 attempts (average 1.35 steals/game, 85.19% success rate).

- 92 steals ranks second in the Texas League, fourth in Double-A and tied 23rd in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's** 23 steals (in 25 attempts) ranks tied second in the Texas League and tied fourth among all Double-A hitters/basestealers.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 12 times, meaning 24 of 92 steals this year (26.1%) have come on a double-steal.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 44 of 68 games this season, including 24 games with two or more steals ... there have been three occasions where the team has stolen five bases, with perfect 5-for-5 steal efforts as a club on 5/13 vs. Wichita and 5/21 @ Arkansas.
- Naturals players have stolen two bases in a game 11 times, led by **FOUR** two-steal games from Garcia.

**GAR-SEE YA ON BASE**

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** has reached base in 56 of the 64 games he has played in this season, reaching base multiple times on 36 occasions, including a team-best 20 multi-hit games.

- In 302 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 111 times (75 hits + 36 walks), for a .370 on-base percentage.
- Garcia has walked 36 times and struck out 50 times, a 0.72 K/BB rate that ranks second among Royals minor league hitters with at least 250 plate appearances.
- The shortstop places among the Texas League leaders in several categories, ranking tied second in steals (23), fourth in hits (75), fourth in doubles (19) and tied 10th in runs scored (46) ... he ranks among the Double-A leaders steals (tied fourth), hits (tied sixth) and doubles (tied eighth).
- Maikel's 19 doubles are second among all Royals Minor League hitters, as are his 75 hits and 23 steals ... he ranks tied second in runs scored (46), fourth in walks (36), fifth in total bases (102), sixth in on-base percentage (.370) and batting average (.286) and tied seventh in extra-base hits (22).
- His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year, tied for the 15th-longest in club history and tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

**PUSHIN P(ORTER)**

Catcher **Logan Porter** has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks ninth in on-base percentage (.441), fifth among all Double-A hitters in OBP ... in the Texas League, he is fourth in OBP and ninth in OPS (.932).
- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest on-base percentage, ranks second in OPS, third in batting average (.302) and tied fourth in slugging percentage (.491) ... his 36 walks are tied for the second-most in the system, with teammate Maikel Garcia, behind Omaha's Nick Pratto (38).
- Porter has reached base in 45 of 50 games he's played this season, with hits in 31 of 50 and 17 multi-hit games, nine of which came in May.
- Porter's 17-game on-base streak between May 31 and June 23 is tied with Robbie Glendinning for the longest on the team this season, a stretch where he hit .321 (17-for-53) with 15 walks and a .493 on-base percentage ... last Friday was the first game this month where Porter did not get on base at least once, Friday and Saturday's games are the first time Porter has not gotten on base in any way back-to-back games.

**QUALITY OF STARTS**

Northwest Arkansas Naturals starting pitcher have delivered 10 quality starts this season through the first 68 games (average of one quality start every 6.8 games)... a QS requires a pitcher throws at least six innings and allows three earned runs or fewer.

- Anthony Veneziano** threw three straight quality starts earlier this month: June 9 @ Tulsa (7.0 IP, 0 ER), June 14 vs. Arkansas (6.0 IP, 3 ER) and June 19 vs. Arkansas (6.0 IP, 0 ER).
- While no longer with the team, **Drew Parrish** lead the Naturals with four quality starts, including the team's first of the season on April 26 vs. Amarillo (6.0 IP, 0 ER).
- Marcelo Martinez** delivered a quality start in his first outing of the year with the Naturals on May 4 in Springfield (6.0 IP, 0 ER), while **Ángel Zerpa** offered his first on May 29 on Midland (6.2 IP, 3 ER).
- Most recently, **Alec Marsh** delivered a quality start in his last outing, on June 23 vs. Springfield (6.0 IP, 3 ER).
- Naturals starting pitchers have had 11 starts this year of 6.0 innings or more, the only one that was not a quality start was from Marsh, on May 31 vs. Corpus Christi (6.0 IP, 5 ER).

**Pitchers of the Month (1)**

\* **May: LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

**Players of the Week (2)**

\* **April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.

\* **May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

**Pitchers of the Week (3)**

\* **May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.

\* **May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.

\* **June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).

## #27 CHRISTIAN COLÓN • ASSISTANT HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



## #23 MIKE JIRSCHOLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.
- Jirschele previously managed the Triple-A Omaha franchise for 11 seasons (2003-13), leading the team to four division titles, three-straight trips to the Pacific Coast League championship round (2011-13), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and a Triple-A Championship in 2013.

- Prior to his 11-year stint with Omaha, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years (1998-2002), while he held managerial positions with Omaha (1995-97), Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.

- Accola graduated from the University of Central Missouri in 2014 and previously held an athletic training internship with the Denver Broncos in 2013.

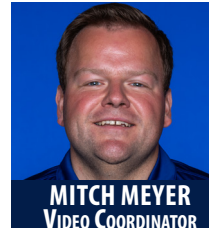
