OFFENSE SPUTTERS IN 5-0 LOSS TO MIDLAND:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Midland RockHounds 5-0 on Thursday night from Momentum Bank Ballpark. Frisco (44-22) was held to just two hits on the offensive side, stranding only four runners. On the mound, they walked eight Midland (37-29) hitters, their most in the month of June. The RockHounds jumped out in front early in the second on a two-run home run from Denzel Clarke off of **Ben Anderson** (4-3). Those were the only runs Anderson allowed over his four innings, striking out four and walking two. **Andy Rodriguez** then threw a scoreless inning and **Triston Polley** added 1.1 runless frames before **Bryan Chi** took over on the mound, allowing three runs in the eighth. Sahid Valenzuela knocked in a run with an RBI single before Jack Winkler doubled home two more to blow the game open at 5-0. The three runs allowed by the Frisco bullpen were more than they had allowed in their previous 12 games combined.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

After a Midland loss on Sunday, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. They have the best record in all of Double-A at 44-22 and they have a 7.0-game lead on the Midland RockHounds in the Texas League South. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022. Frisco has not finished the first half with the best record in Double-A since 2008. Triple-A Omaha (Royals, .700) are the only team with a better winning percentage in all of Minor League Baseball than Frisco's .667. The Riders are on pace for 92 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007).

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

With an error on Tuesday, it snapped a streak of seven-straight games without an error for the RoughRiders. The Riders have the fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (37) while also owning the best fielding percentage (.984) in the minors. Frisco's 63 double plays are second among non-Triple-A teams. Frisco has also allowed the second-fewest stolen bases in MiLB (43), throwing out 29 percent of total base runners against them.

THE HATCHER HAMMER:

Josh Hatcher has crushed the baseball this season for the RoughRiders. He is third in the league, hitting .299, while also tied for second in the league with 40 RBIs. Over his last 19 games, he is slashing .284 (21-for-74)/.329/.446/.775 with four doubles, a triple, two home runs, 14 RBIs and nine runs. In his last eight games, he has driven in eight runs with four extra-base hits.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.93 ERA, which is also the third-best in all of Minor League Baseball. The Riders' pen allowed three runs last night, which was more than their previous 12 games, owning a 0.41 ERA (2 ER/43.2IP) over that span. In their last four series, spanning 22 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 1.52 ERA (14ER/82.2IP). In June, **Steven Jennings** has been fantastic, not allowing a run over his six outings, throwing 13.1 innings.

FIRING BLANKS:

In their last 13 games, the Riders have allowed just 21 earned runs over 115.0 IP (1.64 ERA). Frisco has the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball during the month of June, at 2.36 through the first 17 games. Having won 20 of their last 24 games since May 25th, the Riders have the best ERA in Minor League Baseball (2.21) during that stretch while also being tied for second in saves (eight) and first in wins (19) since May 25th. The team with the second-best ERA in that stretch (Palm Beach) has a 2.21 ERA. In those last 24 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just five times and twice in the last 12 games. On Tuesday, their 2-1 loss marked their first loss when allowing three runs or fewer, dropping them to 36-1 in those games.

HICKS IS THE PICK

Liam Hicks has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 30 games, batting .333 (34-for-102)/.444/.471/.915 with five doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 17 walks, 12 strikeouts and 20 runs. In his last 14 games, he is hitting .353 (22-for-65)/.449/.538/.987. Last Friday in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

CHAVEZ RACKING UP THE HITS:

In his first two seasons with the RoughRiders combined, **Frainyer Chavez** just played 44 games with Frisco, but having played his 54th game of the season with the Riders on Thursday, he is on fire at the plate. Over his last 15 games, he is hitting .333 (18-for-54)/.390/.463/.853 with two doubles, a triple, a home run, five walks, five steals and 13 runs scored. In his last 28 games, he is slashing .295 (28-for-95)/.362/.421/.783.

RISP-ECT THIS

The RoughRiders have been great with runners in scoring position this season, but have struggled recently. Over their last 31 games, they are 21-10, but are hitting .246 (63-for-256) with runners in scoring position. On the season, they are still second in the Texas League, batting .273 with RISP.

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five onerun innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2024 SEASON

-Krauth enters 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Became the first RoughRiders pitcher to complete a quality start on 4/14/24 against Corpus Christi.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.
