SCRATCH IT AND MOVE ON

Sugar Land shut out Round Rock by a final score of 5-0 at Constellation Field on Sunday night. Space Cowboys RHP Blair Henley, RHP Shawn Dubin and RHP Luis Contreras combined for the clean slate and allowed only two hits to give Sugar Land the series victory. After three scoreless innings, Sugar Land took a 2-0 lead in the fourth when C Luke Berryhill hit a two-run home run to left field, which scored DH César Salazar. Sugar Land extended their lead to three thanks to a sacrifice fly by Salazar that plated 2B Will Wagner in the sixth inning. Round Rock ended the no-hitter in the seventh inning when DH Sam Huff singled into left field. Wagner scored again in the eighth inning for Sugar Land. After drawing a walk, LF Cooper Hummel smacked a two-run homer to extend the advantage to 5-0.

YO, ADRIAN

Express RHP Adrian Sampson is scheduled to start on Tuesday. The right-hander is 5-2 on the year with a 4.53 ERA (24 ER/47.2 IP) over nine starts. In his last outing on May 21 in Sugar Land, he suffered a loss, allowing five runs on six hits and one walk with four strikeouts over 5.0 innings.

HUFF HALTS THE NO-NO

Express C Sam Huff broke up Space Cowboys RHP Blair Henley's no-hit bid in the seventh inning of Sunday's contest. Huff recorded the only two Round Rock hits of the night, going 2-for-4 with two strikeouts.

SUGAR IS KRYPTONITE

Round Rock dropped four of six games in last week's series against Sugar Land for their first series loss since April 16-21, which also came against the Space Cowboys. The Express had won the last four series they played in.

SANDRO LOVES CHIHUAHUAS

Round Rock OF Sandro Fabian loves seeing El Paso on the lineup card. The righty is hitting .351 (46-131) in 36 career games against the Chihuahuas with four home runs and 21 RBI. This season, he is locked in at the plate, hitting .545 (12-22) with a home run and eight RBI in five games against El Paso.

ANDREW BRINGING HIS A-GAME

Express C Andrew Knapp is currently leading the team with a .356 batting average. The number places him in a tie with Albuquerque INF Coco Montes for the Pacific Coast League lead. The switch-hitting backstop has hit safely in 29 of 39 games this season, while also drawing 20 walks, tied for fourth on the team. Knapp's .976 OPS ranks seventh in the PCL.

HOME COOKING

Dating back to last season, Round Rock has had a lot of success at home against El Paso. In the last ten games played at Dell Diamond between the two clubs, the E-Train is 8-2, outscoring the Chihuahuas 62-38 in those contests. Round Rock has not had a losing record against El Paso at home since 2003, when both teams were in Double-A. In Round Rock, the Express hold an all-time record of 80-49 against the Chihuahuas at the Triple-A level and a 41-25 home record in Double-A.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the

most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
