Today: It's Page Fence Giants Night, with LAFCU Postgame Fireworks, as the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fifth in a six-game series against the Lake County Captains, High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The Nuts are 7-9 against Lake County this year, splitting the first four games in this series.

About the Page Fence Giants: One of the first dominant Black professional baseball teams, the Giants played over two decades before the founding of the Negro National League in 1920. Based in Adrian and sponsored by the Page Woven Wire Fence Company, founded by Black baseball pioneer Bud Fowler, Grant "Home Run" Johnson, former mayor Len Hoch and brothers Howard and Rolla Taylor, and they steamrolled all opposition from 1895-1898 while traveling across the Midwest and Canada in their own private railroad touring car. In their four years in existence, the Giants won over 87 percent of their games, with over 100 victories each season. The Lugnuts' Page Fence Giants uniforms will be auctioned off during and after the game, with all proceeds to benefit the restoration of historic Hamtramck Stadium, built in 1930 and one of five major Negro League ballparks remaining in the United States.

Last Night: Captains 9, Lugnuts 8. Dayan Frias tucked a go-ahead three-run homer over the left field wall, and the Caps rallied back from 6-1 and 7-2 deficits to defeat the Nuts on Friday night in front of 5,635. Caeden Trenkle knocked his second home run of the series and fourth of the season in the losing cause.

Among the Leadures: Tyler Baum is tied for first in saves (10); Daniel Susac is tied for fifth in triples (5), sixth in batting average (.283) and tied for eighth in hits (73); Junior Pérez is tied for sixth in steals (21); Jack Winkler is tenth with 18 steals; and Danny Bautista, Jr. is tenth with a .276 average.

All-Star Nuts: 2017 Lugnuts standouts Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. will appear in the Major League Baseball All-Star Game, named All-Star reserve infielders on the American League squad. It is Guerrero's third consecutive All-Star Game appearance and Bichette's second All-Star nod, joining 2021.

The Future is Now: Lawrence Butler and Tyler Soderstrom, teammates on the 2022 Lugnuts are taking part in today's 2023 Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game, with Butler batting fifth and starting in left field and Soderstrom batting seventh and starting at first base.

Born to Run: The Nuts stole five bases yesterday – one apiece for five different players. The Lugnuts' 121 steals this season ranks second in the Midwest League to Great Lakes' 123 steals and tops the Major League Leader, the Tampa Bay Rays and their 110 steals. (The leader in Minor League Baseball is Clearwater, which has swiped 185 bases in 78 games.)

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts' defense leads the league with 70 double plays this year, six more than second-place South Bend and 43 more than 12th-place Quad Cities. The Nuts' 57 errors ranks tied for third lowest in the circuit, with 38 errorless games this season.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, Jack Winkler went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: Corey Patterson (7/5/99 at South Bend); Donnie Hood (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); Chip Cannon (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); Travis Snider (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); Brad Glenn (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); Edward Olivares (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and Ryan Gold (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has three players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: Christian Fernandez (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); Euribiel Ángeles (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); and Junior Pérez (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2021: Brandon Lewis forced extra innings in the bottom of the 9th with a solo home run, launching the Lugnuts and Loons into a classic at Dow Diamond. In the 11th, Michael Guldberg's RBI single gave the Nuts a 3-2 lead, only to see Leonel Valera's sac fly tie the game in the home half. In the 12th, however, the Nuts scored five runs, aided by a bases-loaded walk to Drew Millas and HBP to William Simoneit, going on to beat the Loons, 8-3.

2022: Jack Owen set down the first 14 batters, tossing six innings of one-hit baseball with seven strikeouts, and Tyler Soderstrom's third-inning RBI double provided the only run in a 1-0 victory at home over Great Lakes. Kumar Nambiar pitched the seventh and Eighth and Trayson Kubo struck out the side in the ninth, ending the game in two hours, three minutes. For his efforts, Owen was named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week.

Profile

The King: First name is pronounced "yo-el-vis," with the emphasis on the middle syllable... nicknamed Elvis... one other Joelvis played professional baseball, Joelvis Gonzalez, a Twins prospect from Venezuela in 2006-07 who hit .270 in 79 games but never made it higher than rookie ball... has been clocked as hot as 98 mph this year; says that he has hit 100 mph once in his life, the first time his mother came in from the DR to watch him pitch in a professional game, in 2022 in the Florida State League... currently rated the No. 29 prospect in the Athletics' organization by MLB Pipeline; Fastball 55, Slider 50, Changeup 50, Control 50, Overall 40.

Path Through the Pros: After signing at age 16 for \$33,000, Del Rosario debuted as a reliever in 2018 in the Dominican Summer League before converting to a starter in the DSL in 2019, tossing 5 2/3 innings at most... made United States debut in 2021 in Florida Complex League; twirled five hitless innings in second start, July 5, striking out seven Orioles and walking one... made full-season debut with Bradenton in 2022, posting three six-inning starts in a four-start span in June; allowed .248 avg. to right-handers compared to .299 to lefties; runners stole six bases in 10 attempts; outstanding in the first inning, limiting opposition to .191/.295/.353 splits; far better on the road (2.95 ERA in 55 IP) than at home (4.74 in 38 IP).

Joining the Athletics: Del Rosario was the first overall selection of the 2022 MiLB portion of the Rule 5 Draft... in the Major League portion, the A's had selected 2018 Lugnut Ryan Noda from the Dodgers with the second overall pick; Noda debuted in the Majors on his birthday on March 30th and has already launched his first MLB home run... Del Rosario was one of a staggering 11 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects to be selected in the Rule 5 MiLB portion after two Pirates prospects, Jose Hernandez and Blake Sabol, were taken consecutively (3rd and 4th) in the MLB portion.

A Taste of the Cactus League: Del Rosario appeared in one Spring Training game for the A's, pitching well initially before bowing out having allowed four runs on four hits and three walks in 2 2/3 innings, striking out four, hitting one and tossing a wild pitch.
