FRES-NOTES

ROSTER REINFORCEMENTS ARRIVE: The Grizzlies received a boost before Saturday's game with the return of two familiar faces and the arrival of a new one. Infielder Derek Bernard and shortstop Cam Hassert were activated from the 7-day injured list, while catcher Cruzmel Arias joined Fresno from the ACL Rockies for his first California League assignment of 2026. Bernard returns after missing nearly a month, Hassert makes his first appearance since April after beginning the year with the Grizzlies, and Arias brings four years of experience in the Rockies organization to bolster Fresno behind the plate.

SERIES SO FAR: The Grizzlies enter tonight's series finale with a 7-4 record against Ontario this season. Fresno took four of six at ONT Field in April, with both teams scoring 60 runs in the series. The matchup shifted to Chukchansi Park this week, where the Grizzlies have won three of the first five and outscored the Tower Buzzers 46-37. After tonight, Fresno and Ontario will meet six more times in Ontario at the end of July.

SEASONAL IMPRESSIONS: The fireworks have come on the field as much as they have after the game when the Grizzlies and the Tower Buzzers have met this year. The first 11 meetings have produced 203 combined runs, with Fresno holding a narrow 106-97 scoring edge. The Grizzlies have hit .269 with a .431 OBP, .449 SLG and .880 OPS against Ontario overall, but the numbers have spiked in Fresno. In the five games at Chukchansi Park, Fresno has scored 46 runs, drawn 53 walks, collected 48 hits and hit seven home runs, while reaching base at a .478 clip with a .978 OPS.
