RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (23-22)

Lake Elsinore Storm (22-23)





RHP Alex Makarewich (0-0, -.-- ERA) vs. RHP Sam Whiting (0-0, 4.05 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue their series at The Diamond in Lake Elsinore, taking on the Lake Elsinore Storm (SD) in game three of the six-game set. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 4. VS THE STORM: This is the 12th of 30 match-ups and the sixth of 15 here at LoanMart Field. The Quakes are 6-5 against the Storm in 2024, 1-4 here at The Diamond. Last season, the Quakes won the season-series (17-13). **LAST GAME:** The Storm won in extras for the second straight, as Chase Valentine's RBI single brought home Wyatt Hoffman in the bottom of the tenth for a 5-4 win over the Quakes on Wednesday night at The Diamond. Jeral Perez

tied the game with a two-run homer with two outs and two strikes in the ninth inning, helping the Quakes get to the tenth. Rancho reliever Waylin Santana (0-2) pitched 1.1 innings of relief and got hit with the loss, while Storm reliever Thomas Balboni (3-1) earned the win. Valentine finished the game with three hits and two RBIs, while Perez finished with two hits, including his sixth homer of the year for the Quakes.

ROUGH STRETCH: The Quakes' five-game lead in the South Division has been trimmed all the way to one game due to losses in nine of their last ten games. Prior to back-to-back wins in this series, Lake Elsinore had dropped five of six at home, but with a win tonight, they can move back into a first-place tie for the first time since April.

LACK OF LONG-BALLS: The Jeral Perez two-out homer in last night's ninth inning was the first home run for the Quakes since Jordan Thompson went yard in a home game against Inland Empire on May 19, ten days and eight games ago. Rancho is second in the league in home runs (29), behind only Modesto (36). Lake Elsinore, by contrast, is the second least prolific home run-hitting team, with 19 in 45 games. Only Visalia (17) has hit less in the league.

BOBBY MILLER AGAIN?: Dodgers' right-hander Bobby Miller made his first career appearance on Sunday for the Quakes, allowing three runs, all in the second inning, on four hits with four strikeouts and two walks in a no-decision. Miller is slated to make two more rehab starts, including a potential start on Saturday in Lake Elsinore. Right shoulder inflammation has sidelined Miller for the last six weeks. Miller is 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA this season across three starts. Miller was a first-rounder (29th overall) in 2020 out of Louisville. All Dodger rehabbers are sponsored by Yaamava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made several roster moves prior to this series. RHP Jose Rodriguez, who has five wins to lead the team, has been promoted to High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League. 1B Joe Vetrano was placed on the Injured List, retroactive to May 24. The Quakes have added just one player, RHP Jesus Luna, from the Arizona Complex League. The Quakes still have an open roster and are expected to officially add another player soon.

ALEX MAKAREWICH: Right-hander Alex Makarewich makes his Rancho debut, after being added to the roster earlier today from the Arizona Complex League. In three games this year in the ACL, he's 0-1 with a 7.20 ERA, allowing four earned runs on five hits over five innings. Makarewich was drafted by the Dodgers in the 13th round of the 2023 draft out of Northwestern State in Louisiana.

SAM WHITING: Righty Sam Whiting will make his sixth start with the Storm and second against the Quakes, after opening up the year with three games (one start) with High-A Fort Wayne of the Midwest League. In his lone outing against Rancho on April 28, he started and went one inning of scoreless work, allowing one hit. In his last game overall, he allowed four runs on ten hits over four innings in a no-decision on May 23 against San Jose. Whiting made seven relief appearances (1-0, 2.35 ERA) for the Storm last year, after being drafted by San Diego in the 16th round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Santa Barbara.
