Yesterday: Lake County 4, Lansing 3. The Caps rallied from a 3-1 eighth-inning deficit on an RBI single from Maick Collado in the eighth and consecutive RBI singles from Aaron Walton and Nolan Schubart in the ninth, snatching victory for the second straight day over the Nuts.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and Captains will play at 7 p.m. tomorrow night and Saturday, wrapping things up with a Sunday matinee before Lansing returns to Michigan's state capital to welcome in archrival West Michigan from May 26 through May 31.

LUG-NOTES

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**) and No. 24 (**Nate Nankil**). Baseball America's recent re-ranking of A's prospects puts Devin Taylor at No. 10, Steven Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

Starting Spotlight: Lansing right-hander **Zane Taylor**, the A's 5th-round selection in 2025 from UNC Wilmington, enters tonight coming off a quality start on May 14 vs. Quad Cities with career highs in innings (6.0) and strikeouts (7). Lake County lefty **Franklin Gomez** is coming off 5 1/3 IP at Dayton in his last outing, his longest start since a seven-inning gem vs. Lakeland on July 9, 2024.

Casey at the Bat: Second baseman **Casey Yamauchi** went 2-for-4 with a stolen base yesterday and is now hitting .392 (20-for-51) in May after a .233 (14-for-60) April. In his last 10 games alone, Yamauchi is batting a sizzling .450 (18-for-40) with a .540 OBP.

The Amazing Otto: In 2019, the Lugnuts' **Otto Lopez** won the Midwest League batting title with a .324 average. Seven years later, Lopez – now with the Miami Marlins – leads the Majors with a .349 batting average, thanks to a sizzling .390 May.

Hogan-Mania: Southpaw **Hogan Harris**, who made seven starts for the Lugnuts in 2022, is leading the Major Leagues with 26 relief appearances. Harris has limited MLB right-handed hitters to a .136 batting average (6-for-44).

Family Ties: Lansing outfielder **Myles Naylor's** older brother, Bo, played for the Lake County Captains in 2019, batting .243/.313/.421 in 107 games, with 18 doubles, 10 triples and 11 home runs as a 19-year-old. (Myles and Bo's oldest brother, Josh, came up to the Majors through the Marlins' and Padres' systems.)

Green Power: On May 12, **Rodney Green, Jr.** launched a 490-foot home run into the second floor of the Outfield Lofts apartments, the longest tracked home run of the 2026 season, Major League or Minor League.

Bolting to the Show: The most recent Lugnut to make his MLB debut is 2024 Lugnuts outfielder **Henry Bolte**, who went 2-for-2 for the A's on May 13 to become the 203rd all-time Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues and the third this season (**Daniel Susac**, **Eduardo Rivera**).

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

MAY 21 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2015: The Lugnuts wrapped up a four-game home sweep of South Bend with a 17-2 rout, the most runs scored by the Nuts in a game since they plated 18 on 8-26-13 vs. Dayton. Chase De Jong threw 8 2/3 innings (5 hits, 2 runs, 5 K's, 0 walks), one out shy of his first complete game. The Nuts broke the game open with eight runs against MSU Spartan David Garner in the sixth inning. The Lugnuts had eight extra-base hits, seven of them doubles.

2018: With the tying and go-ahead runs on base in the seventh inning, right fielder Chavez Young turned into Superman, laying out in the deep right-center gap to rob Jhonny Bethencourt and send the Lugnuts onward to a 2-1 victory over the South Bend Cubs at Four Winds Field.

In a Nutshell: Rated the A's No. 19 prospect by MLB Pipeline... made pro debut on Sept. 20, 2025, for Triple-A Las Vegas vs. Salt Lake, striking out four in two innings... member of the A's Spring Breakout roster, but did not pitch in the game...earned his first pro win in his Lansing debut, April 3 vs. Dayton, with five scoreless innings in a 5-1 victory over the Dragons... **last time out**, posted first quality start: 6 IP, 6 H, 3 R, 1 BB, 7 K vs. QC on 84 pitches in 12-3 win.

Stats Dive: Ranks 3rd in the Midwest League in ERA (2.45)... 7 2/3 innings behind Dayton's Nestor Lorrent for the league lead... limiting left-handers to .135 avg. (7-for-52) compared to right-handers' .275 (19-for-69)... of 12 runs allowed, seven have been scored in the 1st inning.

Scouting Report: Pipeline's grades - 55 fastball, 50 curveball, 50 slider, 55 changeup, 50 cutter, 55 control... "A mainstay in UNC Wilmington's rotation over his four years there, Taylor produced one of the best seasons in school history as a senior in 2025 by leading NCAA Division I in K/BB ratio (9.6) and WHIP (0.76), while also ranking second in walk rate (1.0 per nine innings) and fourth in ERA (1.98). Entering the 2025 Draft as one of the top senior arms in the class, he was selected in the fifth round by the A's and signed at a full-slot bonus of \$513,900, becoming the highest-drafted pitcher out of UNCW since supplemental first-rounder Bradley Holt in 2008. With Triple-A Las Vegas in need of a starter at the end of the season, Taylor was called upon for his pro debut with a start for a playoff-bound Aviators squad."
