Tale of Two Series: Columbus enters Tuesday night at Birmingham with the best record in the Southern League on Tuesday at 7-2 ... From Tuesday through Thursday this season, the Clingstones hold the best record in the Southern League at 19-8, pitching to a combined 3.20 ERA, good for 2nd-best behind Birmingham (2.42) and batting a combined .229 (198-863), also good for 2nd-best behind Chattanooga (.230) ... However, from Friday through Sunday, Columbus holds the worst record in all of Double-A at 6-26, including going 2-19 in weekend contests ... The team ERA inflates to 4.53 and the team AVG drops 43 points to .186, the worst in Double-A.

Mejia's The Man: RHP Ian Mejia yielded 6 earned runs to tie a career high but still recorded his 6th win of the season on Tuesday night ... 6 of his 11G this season have been scoreless outings, including a Southern League and career best 36.2-inning scoreless stretch from 4/18-5/21 ... Mejia was magnificent in May, going 3-0 with a 0.31 ERA (1 ER in 29.0 IP), 0.83 WHIP, and .200 BAA ... He ranks Top 10 in several Southern League pitching categories amongst qualified leaders.

Another Happy Landon: RHP Landon Harper turned in one of the best relief appearances in the Southern League this season on 6/10 vs. Knoxville, going 4.0 scoreless innings for a 12-out save (2 H, 0 BB, 7 SO) ... It was the second save of the season for Harper and the fifth 12-out save in the Southern League this season.

McCrushin': INF David McCabe has taken over the team lead in batting once again after beginning June with a 13-game on-base streak from 5/30-6/13 where he batted .311 (14-45), 4 2B, 2 HR, 6 RBI, .959 OPS ... McCabe tallied a multi-HR game on 6/8 at Pensacola and ranks among league leaders in Walks (T-3, 37), Doubles (T-5, 12), OBP (8th, .372), and OPS (9th, .764).

Electric-E: OF Ethan Workinger opened last week by recording a 3-RBI game on Tuesday and smashing his 10th home run of the season on Wednesday... He was named Southern League Player of the Week for 4/29-5/4 and ranks Top 10 in several league hitting categories.

High RISP, High Reward: Columbus ranks as the best offense with RISP in the Southern League, batting .248 (122-492, 24 2B, 3 3B, 10 HR, 163 RBI, .711 OPS) this season.

Pipeline: With the promotion of LHP Hayden Harris to Triple-A Gwinnett on Tuesday, Columbus boasts a roster featuring nine of the Top 30 prospects in the Atlanta organization, including four of the Top 10 ... Of the nine players, six are starting pitchers.

Pitch Mix (5): Fastball/Sinker/Cutter/Slider/Slider

Ian Mejia makes his 12th appearance (8th start) of 2025 and 31st overall start in Double-A on 6/17 at Birmingham ... In 3 career starts against Birmingham, Mejia is 3-0 with a 0.45 ERA (1 ER in 20.0 IP), 0 HR, 5 BB, 20 SO, 0.95 WHIP, and .203 BAA ... Mejia has not allowed a run to Birmingham in 17-consecutive innings, dating back to the 3rd inning in a start for Mississippi on 4/17/24 at Regions Field.

Last Time Out: Tied a career high for earned runs with 6 ER but still collected his 6th win of the season by grinding through 5.0 innings (7 H, 6 R, 6 ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 5 SO) ... Exited with a 7-6 lead while **Landon Harper** collected a 12-out save to hand Mejia his second-straight victory.

Scoreless Stretch: Carried a 36.2 inning scoreless stretch from 4/18 vs. Pensacola through 5/21 vs. Montgomery ... The scoreless stretch was both the longest of his career and the longest in the Southern League this season ... The stretch spanned 6G (4 starts) and ended after 6.0 scoreless innings on 5/21 after a solo home run by Cooper Kinney.

Pipeline: Ranked the Braves No. 23 prospect by MLB.com.

Reliable Relief: Has made 4 appearances out of the bullpen this season, including 6.0 scoreless innings on 5/1 vs. BLX (Win, 5 H, 1 BB, 5 SO) ... In 5G as a reliever in his career, Mejia is 1-0 with a 1.53 ERA (3 ER in 17.2 IP), 1.25 WHIP, .230 BAA, and 9.68 SO/9.0 IP

2024 Season: Went 8-8 with a 3.80 ERA (53 ER in 125.2 IP), 1.37 WHIP, .239 BAA and 10 quality starts over 25G (24 starts) between Double-A Mississippi (24G) and Triple-A Gwinnett (1G) ... Had 3 complete games (1 shutout).

- **Braves MiLB Leaderboard:** Led all Braves farmhands in complete games (3) and shutouts (3) ... Ranked Top 10 in starts (T-2), wins (3rd), innings (3rd), strikeouts (4th, 124), BAA (T-4), ERA (5th), and WHIP (5th).
- **Southern League Leaderboard:** Finished Top 5 amongst qualifying pitchers in complete games (1st, 3), shutouts (1st, 3) strikeouts (T-2, 123), ERA (3rd, 3.47), BAA (4th, .233), WHIP (4th, 1.32), and starts (T-5, 23).
- **No-Hitter:** Threw the 5th no-hitter in Mississippi Braves history on 5/17 vs. BLX-G2: Turned in the second individual no-hitter in M-Braves history (1st since Tommy Hanson on 6/25/08 vs. Birmingham) ... Went 7.0 innings (1 HB, 2 BB, career-high 11 SO) in a 92-pitch, 63-strike effort, leading the M-Braves to a 2-0 victory ... Struck out 5 of the first 6 batters faced ... Retired 13 consecutive batters prior to 5th inning walk, ending his perfect game bid ... Ended the game with 11 strikeout.
- **Scoreless Streak:** Posted a 23.0-inning scoreless streak spanning 5 starts between Mississippi and Gwinnett from 4/28-5/23 ... Saw the streak end on a Griffin Conine grand slam in the 1st inning of his Triple-A debut on 5/23 vs. Jacksonville.
- **Triple-A Debut:** Promoted to Gwinnett for his Triple-A debut on 5/23 vs. JAX: Lasted just 1.1 IP (5 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 2 HR, 3 BB, 1 SO) and took the loss as the Stripers fell 12-11 ... Transferred back to Mississippi on 5/24.
- **Strong Finish:** Over his final 2 starts with the M-Braves in September, went 1-1 with a 2.61 ERA (3 ER in 10.1 IP) ... Closed on a strong note on 9/14 at BLX: Fired his 3rd complete-game shutout, a rain-shortened 6.1 IP effort (4 H, 2 BB, 5 SO) in a 6-0 win.
