LAST GAME OUT

(MOOSIC, PA - May 25) -The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders lost to the Syracuse Mets 9-6 on Saturday evening at PNC Field. The Mets tallied nine runs over the first two innings and held off multiple comeback attempts by the RailRiders.

Syracuse plated five runs in the top of the first. After Luisangel Acuña and Jose Iglesias singled, Rylan Bannon was hit by a pitch to load the bases. Luke Ritter cleared the base paths with a double giving the Mets an early 3-0 advantage. Mike Brosseau's RBI single made it 4-0, and Rylan Thomas doubled in Brosseau to give Syracuse a five-run lead.

SWB responded in the bottom of the first by sending all nine batters to the plate and scoring three runs. MLB rehabber DJ LeMahieu led off with a walk and Oswald Peraza followed with a single. After T.J. Rumfield walked to load the bases, Carlos Narvaez drove in a pair, cutting the lead to three. Jose Rojas used a pitch challenge to earn a walk, setting up Oscar Gonzalez's infield base hit that scored Rumfield for the third run, making it 5-3.

The Mets answered in the top of the second. Ritter hit a 344-foot two-run homer and Thomas drove in two runs with a single up the middle, giving the Mets a 9-3 lead. Clayton Andrews came on in relief to strike out Acuña and stranded the bases loaded and limit the damage. The RailRiders chipped away at Syracuse's lead in the bottom of the third. Narvaez singled and Taylor Trammell roped a double to right center. Rojas followed with a two-run double to pull SWB within four at 9-5. In the bottom of the fourth, the RailRiders continued added another. After back-to-back base hits from Peraza and Rumfield, Trammell walked to load the bases. A Rojas single plated Peraza, making it 9-6.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre threatened in each of the final four innings, but could not manage to complete the comeback effort. Ben Shields (L0-1), making his Triple-A debut, pitched 1.2 innings giving up eight hits and nine runs. Andrews, Mosqueda, and Alex Mauricio all worked relief for SWB, allowing zero runs through seven and a third frames. Syracuse starting pitcher, Dom Hamel, pitched 3.1 innings giving up eight hits and six runs. Jon Duplantier (W,2-1) was credited with the win for the Mets.

NEWS & NOTES

SECOND PLACE: With a loss last night, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fall a game and a half behind the the Omaha Storm Chasers for second place in the International League. Omaha has played three less games this season and will only make up one of them. Syracuse keeps trying to push their way into the conversation, but are now three games back.

TUESDAY DÉJÀ VU: Sunday will see a rematch from Tuesday's starting pitcher matchup. Righties Jose Buttó and Will Warren are set to make their second starts of the series. Syracuse and Buttó took the win in game one behind his six shutout innings. He allowed just two hits and no walks while striking out seven. Warren worked four frames giving up nine runs on six hits with a pair of homers. The series is now tied at three wins apiece.

MISSED OPPORTUNITIES: The RailRiders left a season-high thirteen runners on base last night in their loss. The team went 3-for-18 with runners in scoring position. This was the most runners left aboard since opening night at Buffalo when a dozen were stranded on the basepaths.

MORE MAURICIO PLEASE: Alex Mauricio lowered his earned run average to 1.13 with SWB. The righty has allowed runs in just two of his 13 appearances. In 24.0 frames, he has let up just three earned runs. Last night, his three innings matched a season-high outing in length with 42 pitches. He has just eight walks to 26 strikeouts. Mauricio was originally drafted by NYY in the 27th round of 2017, but retired on December 13, 2019. He returned to baseball for the 2022 season.

CARLOS CAN: Carlos Narvaez impressed behind the plate last night throwing three runners out, including two in the seventh inning to get out of the frame scoreless. He even caught the Mets #5 prospect Luisangel Acuña stealing. Narvi has caught eight of 32 runners this season for a 20% caught stealing percentage. Carlos was promoted to the Yankees for a couple of games, but did not play. The 25-year-old is still on their 40-man roster.

PERAZA ON THE MOVE: Oswald Peraza stole his third base in six games last night after taking two on Friday. After returning from the Injured List with a right shoulder strain, Peraza looks to pick up where Caleb Durbin left off. Fifteen players have at least one. The team is second overall in Triple-A baseball with 80 as to Tacoma leads with 107 steals.

KRANICK KRAZE: Scranton-native Max Kranick is back in town with the New York Mets organization this week. Kranick has tossed 3.1 clean innings as a part of two separate appearances out of the bullpen. The 26-year-old has a 4.50 ERA with three levels in the Mets system. Kranick was originally drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 11th round back in 2016. The Valley View graduate has pitched in eleven big league games for a 5.56 ERA with two wins and 36 strikeouts.

- New York Yankees traded RHP Joshua Quezada to Milwaukee Brewers for LHP Clayton Andrews on February 14, 2024
- **2024:** Began the season with SWB but was DFA'ed on 4/8 and was outrighted to SWB a few days later
- **2023:** Began the season in Nashville, before being selected by Milwaukee for his Major League debut on 07/01/23...in Triple-A, made 48 appearances for a 2.53 ERA and six wins (57.0IP, 74K, 31BB, 55)...31.1% strikeout rate was quite strong and he got grounders on 45.7% of balls in play but he also issued walks to 13% of hitters that came to the plate against him...in the big leagues, made 4 appearances for a 27.00 ERA (3.1IP, 4K, 2 BB)
- **2022:** Returned from injury in August following Tommy John surgery, pitching in 2 rehab games with ACL Brewers Gold and 7 games with Double-A Biloxi (9.72 ERA, 7G, 8.1 IP, 16K, 7BB)
