YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels threw the team's first-ever no-hitter in a 2-0 win over the Senators, setting a new franchise record with their eighth straight win. **Matt Frisbee** worked 6.0 perfect innings with six strikeouts. **Joey Marciano** took over in the seventh and allowed one baserunner, a walk, over 1.2 innings with two strikeouts. **Matt Seelinger** faced one batter to close out the eighth and picked up a strikeout. **Patrick Ruotolo** pitched the ninth to close out the no-hitter. **Vince Fernandez** opened the scoring with a solo homer in the fourth inning. In the sixth, Frisbee scored from third on a throwing error on a pick-off attempt by Harrisburg starter Sterling Sharp.

NO-NO: The no-hitter on Thursday night was the second in Flying Squirrels history. On April 5, 2013, **Jack Snodgrass** and **Daryl Maday** combined for a seven-inning no-hitter during a double-header against the New Britain Rock Cats. The Flying Squirrels' no-hitter was the second in the minors this year. The Iowa Cubs (Triple-A East) tossed a hitless performance against the Indianapolis Indians on May 9 in a combined effort from Shelby Miller, Tommy Nance, Brad Wieck and Ryan Meisinger.

REPRESENTING RVA: Dating back to 1954, which was the first season of the Triple-A Richmond Virginians, there have been six no-hitters thrown by Richmond teams, including the two by the Flying Squirrels. On May 12, 1962, Al Downing threw a no-hitter for the Virginians against Syracuse at Parker Field. On June 1, 1977, Mickey Mahler pitched the first no-hitter in Richmond Braves history. On June 27, 1989, Charlie Puleo and Steve Ziem combined for a no-hitter for the R-Braves at Oklahoma City. On May 3, 1992, Pete Smith pitched a seven-inning perfect game at Rochester for the R-Braves.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels continue the first road series of 2021, facing off against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, at FNB Field on City Island in the fourth of six games. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' lone trip to Pennsylvania's capital city this season. The Senators come to Richmond for a six-game series from June 8-13. The Flying Squirrels enter the series riding a five-game winning streak.

GOING STREAKING: The Flying Squirrels have won eight straight games, a new franchise record for the longest winning streak. The team previously won seven consecutive games from April 27-May 3, 2010 and June 20-26, 2014. The Flying Squirrels' eight-game win streak is the longest active in the minors and tied for the longest overall in MiLB this year (Lynchburg).

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 8-1 record through the first nine games of the season is the best start in the franchise's history. The previous best start through nine games was a 6-3 record, which was set during the 2018 and 2019 seasons. The Flying Squirrels' best record in team history through ten games is 7-3, which was set during the 2018 season.

BEST OF THE BEST: At 8-1, the Flying Squirrels are tied for the best record in all of the minors. Two teams, Lynchburg (Low-A East) and Down East (Low-A East), dropped to 8-1 with losses on Thursday. Two Triple-A West teams, Reno and Sugar Land, are 6-1 and are the only other teams in the minors with one loss.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS sit in first place in the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 1.5 games ahead of Akron. The Flying Squirrels finished the 2019 season with a 55-84 record, the worst in the franchise's history, and finished in last place in the Eastern League's Western Division for the second consecutive year. Seven players from the 2019 team are back in Richmond to start the 2021 season, including **Jacob Heyward**, **Sean Hjelle**, **Ryan Howard**, **Peter Maris**, **Heliot Ramos**, **Frank Rubio** and **Raffi Vizcaino**. Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** did not appear with the Flying Squirrels in 2019, but he did pitch in Richmond in 2018. Outfielder **Vince Fernandez** played in the Eastern League with Hartford in 2019.

THE SENATORS have lost six consecutive games entering play tonight by a combined score of 29-11. Harrisburg's six-game losing streak is tied for the longest active losing slide in the minors. The Senators are batting .118 as a team, which is the worst team average of the 120 teams in the minors. The Harrisburg roster includes 10 players who appeared in a game for the team prior to this season. There are six of *Baseball America's* top-30 Nationals prospects on the Senators' roster, including LHP Tim Cate (8), INF Drew Mendoza (11), INF Jackson Cluff (12), C Jaksen Reetz (25), OF Nick Banks (29) and RHP Sterling Sharpe (29). In 2019, the Senators went 76-63, finishing in second place in the Eastern League Western Division, before falling to the Bowie Baysox in the divisional round of the playoffs.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Gerson Garabito** makes his second start of the season. In his Giants organization debut on Saturday in the second game of the double-header against Hartford, Garabito worked 4.0 innings and allowed one unearned run in a no-decision. He was with the Kansas City Royals organization from 2013-2019, reaching as high as Double-A. He spent 2019 pitching in the Texas League with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals, going 6-12 with a 3.77 ERA in 26 starts. Garabito's performance in 2019 earned him a selection as a Texas League Mid-Season All-Star. He signed as a minor league free agent with the Giants on November 20, 2020. **For more on Frisbee, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Luis Reyes makes his second start of the season. Last time out, he was charged with a loss after allowing two runs (one earned) over 4.2 innings on Saturday at Somerset. He signed with the Nationals as an international free agent in 2012 and first reached Double-A with Harrisburg in 2018, going 5-6 with a 5.18 ERA in 12 starts. He spent 2019 working mostly out of the bullpen with A-Adv. Potomac, going 5-5 with a 4.81 ERA. In seven starts in 2019, Reyes went 2-3 with a 7.18 ERA, compared to a 3.18 ERA in 24 relief outings.

STRONG ARMS: Over the last six games since May 8, the Flying Squirrels pitching staff has combined for a 1.80 (10 ER/50.0 IP), which is the best in all of Double-A during that span. The Richmond pitchers also have the best BAA (.149) in Double-A in that stretch and the second-best WHIP (0.98).

RIGHT OFF THE BAT: 2019 Eastern League All-Star **Jacob Heyward** made his season debut on Tuesday night at Harrisburg. In his first plate appearance of the season in the first inning, he launched a solo home run. He added an RBI double that hit the left-field wall on the fly in his second plate appearance. On Wednesday, he entered as a pinch-hitter and went 1-for-2. In 2019, Heyward set the Flying Squirrels' single-season record for walks with 80, which surpassed the previous record of 62 set by Mark Miniccozzi during the 2013 season.

RAMOS RAKING: **Heliot Ramos** went hitless for the first time this season on Thursday, ending his 13-game hitting streak, but he worked a walk to extend his Double-A on-base streak to 16 games. Ramos is currently ranked ninth in the Double-A Northeast in batting average (.345), ninth in on-base percentage (.457), seventh in slugging percentage (.690), fifth in OPS (1.147), tied for fourth in doubles (4), tied for second in extra-base hits (6), tied for seventh in total bases (20), tied for second in runs scored (9) and tied for first in stolen bases (3).

POWER SURGE: **David Villar** has homered three times in the first nine games of the 2021 season, which is tied for fourth in the league. He hit 13 home runs in 2018 in short-season with Salem-Keizer and clubbed 13 home runs again in 2019 with A-Adv. San Jose. Villar is also ranked tied for fifth in the league in RBIs (8).

WELCOME BACK, AUGGIE: **José Alguacil** returns to manage the Flying Squirrels after leading the team to a 72-68 record in 2015, the most recent season the team has posted a winning record. Alguacil is in his 15th overall season with the Giants organization and worked at the Alternate Training Site in 2020. He previously served as the first base coach and oversaw bunting instruction while assisting with infield defense and baserunning in San Francisco from 2017-2019 on Bruce Bochy's major league staff.

ALL OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (4), Georgia (4), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12) and **Sean Hjelle** (13). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Ramos (3), Hjelle (11) and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
