TODAY'S GAME: Tonight is the third game of the longest road trip of the year for the Quakes, as they take on the Stockton Ports (ATH) in game three of a six-game set and game three of a 12-game, 13-day road trip. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 3rd to face the San Jose Giants. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE PORTS: Today's game is the 15th of 18 games (all in the first half) against the Ports and the ninth of 12 at Banner Island Ballpark. The Quakes have dropped six of eight in Stockton in 2025, but after winning five of six at home, are now 7-7 against Stockton in 2025. In 2024, Rancho went 8-2 against the Ports, 5-1 in Stockton.

LAST GAME: The Ports downed the Quakes for a second consecutive night, defeating Rancho by a final of 11-2 on Wednesday night at Banner Island Ballpark. Jared Sprague-Lott had three hits and three RBIs, while starting pitcher Ryan Magdic (2-1) allowed two runs over five innings to secure the win, Stockton's fourth straight overall. Rancho got two hits each from Eduardo Quintero and Mairo Martinus, but finished with just six on the night. Rancho reliever Michael Vilchez (1-1) took the loss, surrendering two runs over two innings.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes have made several roster moves over the last few days, including one on Thursday. Three days after sending RHP Jhonny Jimenez back to the ACL, they've transferred him back to Rancho. Gio Cueto was placed on the Injured List on Tuesday, while INF Raynerd Ortega was added to the roster from the ACL. Marco Corcho was also activated from the Injured List on Wednesday.

POW TREND KEEPS GOING: The Quakes have snapped up five of the 12 weekly awards that have been handed out this year, with Samuel Munoz keeping the trend going, as he was named the league's Player of the Week on Monday. Munoz hit .417 (10-for-24) against Inland Empire with two homers, five RBIs, 11 runs scored and five walks. Other winners this year include P Sean Paul Linan, P Sterling Patick, OF Mike Sirota and OF Eduard Quintero.

UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY: The Quakes dropped their second straight game last night, but it's the first time Rancho has lost two straight since they dropped back-to-back games against San Jose on April 17-18. The Quakes have only had three losing streaks this season, two two-game streaks and their longest of the year, a three-game losing streak here in Stockton back in April. Rancho's best record in a single half was in the second half of the 2018 season, when they went 52-18 and finished a whopping 15 games ahead of second-place Lancaster. That 2018 season also marked their last Cal League Championship, their third in franchise history.

AIDAN FOELLER: Right-hander Aidan Foeller makes his eighth start and ninth appearance, his fourth appearance and third start against Stockton. In three games against Stockton, Foeller is 1-0, while allowing five runs (two earned) on six hits over 10.2 innings. In his last outing overall, he earned the win over Inland Empire on May 16th, allowing two runs on six hits over five innings. Last year, Foeller got a brief taste of the Cal League, striking out four, without surrendering a hit or run over three scoreless innings for Rancho. Foeller was an 11th-round selection in last year's draft, out of Southern Illinois.

WEI-EN-LIN: 19-year-old lefty Wei-En Lin makes his ninth appearance and sixth start for Stockton and his fourth appearance and third start against the Quakes. In three games against Rancho this year, he's 0-1, allowing nine runs on 16 hits over 10.2 innings, with 15 strikeouts and only one walk. In his last outing overall, he allowed two runs on five hits over six innings in a no-decision vs San Jose on May 16th. He was the Cal League Pitcher of the Week back in early April, after firing three perfect innings with seven strikeouts in a no-decision at Fresno. Lin signed with the A's in June of 2024 out of Taiwan and is now in his first pro season.
