

**CARDINALS' STREAK SNAPPED BY LATE NATURALS RALLY: The NW** Arkansas Naturals scored single runs in the 7th and 8th to come from behind and defeat the Cardinals 4-3 on Friday night at Hammons Field, snapping Springfield's 5-game winning streak. Lars Nootbaar had 2 hits including a home run for Springfield, and Jacob Buchberger added a pair of hits as well. Jimmy Crooks went 1-for-3 with and RBI single and has at least one hit and one RBI in each of his last 4 games, and Trent Baker fired 3.0 perfect innings in his 9th start of the season, but was on a pitch count and handed it



**DPPOSING STARTER:** Lefty **Tyson Guerrero** makes his 13th start (15th appearance) of the season and 2nd of the series in the finale for NW Arkansas...Took the loss in the series opener allowing 4 ER on 8 H over 4.0 IP with 4 K...Best start of the season came on June 14 against the Cardinals at Hammons Field, firing 6.0 scoreless frames allowing just 4 H with 3 K...In 3 starts against the Cardinals is 1-2 with a 3.60 ERA...Made 3 starts with the Naturals at the end of the 2023 season and went 1-2 with a 6.55 ERA... Began 2023 at High-A Quad Cities going 2-4 with a 3.63 ERA in 18 apperances (17 starts), racking up 106 K to just 29 BB in 84.1 IP...Limited to just 6 starts with Quad Cities in 2022 because of shoulder injuries... Made 9 apperances between the ACL and Low-A Columbia in 2021...Selected by the Royals in the 12th round of the 2021 draft out of Washington...Went 3-3 with a 2.96 ERA in his redshirt sophomore season with the Huskies...Pithed at Lower Columbia CC in 2020...Was a two-way player at Washington State as a freshman in 2019, going 1-2 with a 3.63 ERA in 19 appearances while hitting .277 with 2 HR and 5 2B in 94 AB...25 years old

#### CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

## **CARDS' RADIO HOME**



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

**NDDDDDDDDT:** For the 2nd time during the 2024 season, Cardinals OF **Lars Nootbaar** is rehabbing with Springfield. He has been on the IL with St. Louis since May 31 with an oblique strain. **Nootbaar** appeared in one game for Springfield on April 9 rehabbing from fractured ribs, going 1-for-4 with an RBI and 2 runs scored before being activated by St. Louis on April 11. In 5 games with Triple-A Memphis at the start of the season, he went 3-for-17 with a 2B. **Nootbaar** is batting .234 with 5 HR and 19 RBI to go along with 7 2B and a .741 OPS in 39 big league games this season.

Six games into his current rehab stint with Springfield, **Nootbaar** is 6-for-22 (.273) with a double, 2 HR and 3 RBIs.

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE: After dropping 4 of their first 5 games to start the 2nd half of Texas League play, the Cardinals have won 5 of their last 6 games to run their 2nd-half record to 6-5. Springfield had a 5-game winning streak snapped by NW Arkansas on Friday night, their longest since winning 9 in a row to start the 2024 campaign.

**HOME SWEET HOME?:** With wins in 2 of their last 3 games at Hammons Field, the Cardinals are doing their best to reverse their fortunes at home. Over their last three home games, during which the Cardinals have outscored their opponent 18-7, Springfield has lowered its home ERA from 6.07 to 5.72. Going into Sunday's game against the Travelers the Cards had dropped 11 of their last 12 and 22 of 28 at Hammons Field after an 8-0 start to the season. The Cards are now 16-23 (.410) at home this season.

On the road meanwhile, the Cardinals have a league-best 27-14 record on the road this season and have the 2nd-best road ERA at 3.55, just 0.10 behind Frisco and tops in the North Division.

**GRINDIN':** Simply put, the Cardinals don't strike out very much. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 569 whiffs in 80 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (544 K in 80 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.1 K's per game. The Cardinals this week are up against the top strikeout staff in the Texas League; the Naturals average 10 K's per game.

**PITCHING LEADING THE WAY:** The Cardinals pitching staff has been the backbone for the club winning 5 of their last 6. The Cards have a 2.17 team ERA since last Sunday, 2nd in the league during that time behind San Antonio (1.00).

**CROOKS CRUSHING:** Springfield C **Jimmy Crooks** has been filling up the box score recently. Over his last 10 games since June 23, the last day of the first half, **Crooks** is batting .441 (15-for-34) with 2 2B, a 3B, 2 HR with 9 RBIs and a 1.235 OPS. Crooks has hit safely and driven in at least one run in each of his last 4 games.

**RED-HOT RIVAS:** Cardinals SS **Jeremy Rivas** is enjoying a breakout campaign at the plate in 2024, and has been swinging it well recently. Despite going 0-for-3 on Friday, **Rivas** is batting .370 (17-for-46) over his last 13 games with 3 2B, a HR, and is 4-for-4 in SB. For the season **Rivas** is batting .304/.382/.363, a drastic improvement over his line at High-A Peoria last season (.209/.293/.277). He has also cut his strikeout rate from 22.3% to 16%.

**SEE YOU IN ARLINGTON:** Major League Baseball announced the AL and NL rosters for the 25th annual All-Star Futures Game, and two Cardinals pitchers were honored with a nod. **RHP Tink Hence** will be taking part in the event for the 2nd straight season, and **LHP Quinn Mathews** also received the honor in his first full season of professional baseball. The game will take place Saturday, July 13 at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX.

**REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY:** With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 220.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 42 straight games without a home run.
