By the Numbers

INF Nate Furman is currently on a team-best 11-game hitting streak, which is the second-longest active streak in the Midwest League. Furman batted .412 (7-for-17) with a 1.032 OPS, 8 RBI, and 5 R against Lansing two weeks ago to earn inaugural [Captain of the Week](#) honors.

OF Jonah Advincula is currently on a 14-game on-base streak, which is tied for the longest streak in the Midwest League, and is the longest streak by a Captain this season. The 2023 eighth-round pick has recorded 8 RBI, 6 walks, and 7 stolen bases, while tallying a .386 OBP over his first 14 career High-A games.

As a team, the Captains have hit 19 home runs so far this season, which are the third-most in the Midwest League. Lake County hit 4 home runs last week at West Michigan, and 7 in its first 5 games against Fort Wayne this year.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: On Sunday afternoon, the Captains defeated the West Michigan Whitecaps in the finale of a six-game road series by a final score of 9-4 at LMCU Ballpark in Comstock Park, Michigan. Lake County won the final five games of the set, and has tied its longest winning streak of the season.

Offensively, the Captains overcame a 2-0 deficit with a 3-run second inning. DH Tyrese Turner hit a two-out RBI single, and another run scored via a throwing error on the play. Two hitters later, CF Jonah Advincula hit a two-out RBI single to put Lake County in front for good. Two innings later, the Captains scored five runs with two outs. A wild pitch and throwing error on the play resulted in 2 runs, LF C.J. Kayfus hit a two-run double, and 1B Maick Collado hit an RBI single. Finally, Turner added an RBI double in the top of the fifth frame.

Lake County RHP Jake Miller (ND) tied a season-high with 4 innings of work, allowing 4 hits, 2 earned runs, and 1 walk, while throwing 3 strikeouts in 66 pitches (44 strikes). LHP Adam Tulloch (1-0) earned his first career High-A win with 3 innings of relief, allowing 2 hits, 2 earned runs, and 2 walks, while throwing 1 strikeout. Finally, RHPs Zane Morehouse and Allan Hernández each pitched a scoreless inning out of the Captains' bullpen.

COPA DE LA DIVERSIÓN: According to MiLB.com, "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" is a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities."

For every Tuesday home game this season, the Captains will play as their Copa de la Diversión alter ego: **Los Picantes de Lake County**. As part of its alter ego, the team uses a flaming pepper logo and wears alternate uniforms. According to MiLB.com, "Lake County's 'Picantes' moniker represents the area's spice of life, both literally and figuratively. The identity celebrates both the chile pepper's place in spicier LatinX cuisine and the community's edgier, fiery personalities."

The Captains went 4-3 as **Los Picantes de Lake County** this season, last defeating the Lansing Lugnuts on September 5, 2023. Of note, Lake County defeated the Quad Cities River Bandits as Los Picantes by a score of 5-4 in 10 innings on May 30, 2023. Against Quad Cities, OF Jorge Burgos hit a walk-off solo home run, his 2nd home run of the game and Lake County's only walk-off home run of the year. This walk-off ended the River Bandits' 12-game winning streak. In 2022, the Captains went a perfect 7-0 as **Los Picantes de Lake County**.

21ST SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,754 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,384-1,370 (.503).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

PLENTY OF '23 IN LC: Six players on the Captains' current active roster were selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 2023 MLB Draft. INF/OF C.J. Kayfus was drafted in Round 3, C Cooper Ingle in Round 4, INF Alex Mooney in Round 7, OF Jonah Advincula in Round 8, RHP Jay Driver in Round 9, and RHP Zane Morehouse in Round 14.

MOONEY'S STELLAR SERIES: Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, was named the [second Captain of the Week](#), presented by Official League, for his performance in last week's series at West Michigan. The 21-year-old hit 8-for-21 (.381), with 7 runs, 3 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, one walk, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches. Mooney's 2 home runs (tied for 2nd), 5 extra-base hits (3rd), and 7 runs (tied for 3rd) all ranked top-three in the Midwest League this past week.

THE FURMANATOR'S STREAK: With 2 singles in Saturday afternoon's contest, Lake County INF Nate Furman extended his hitting streak to 11 games, which is the second-longest active streak in the Midwest League. During this streak, the 2022 fourth-round pick is hitting .340 (16-for-47) with 10 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 9 RBI, 5 walks, 2 stolen bases, and an .862 OPS.

KAYFUS CRUSHING THE BALL: Captains INF/OF C.J. Kayfus has been one of the Midwest League's premier hitters in his first 13 career High-A games. The 22-year-old ranks top-six in the Midwest League in slugging percentage (.620, 3rd), batting average (.360, 4th), OPS (1.041, 5th), and RBI (15, tied for 6th). He is also currently on a 5-game hitting streak, during which he is hitting .368 with 7 hits, 5 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 7 RBI, 3 walks, and a 1.090 OPS.

COLLADO COLLECTING BASES: Lake County INF Maick Collado has reached base at an incredible rate in his first 13 career High-A games. The 21-year-old's .536 on-base percentage leads the Midwest League, and ranks 4th in all of Minor League Baseball. Collado also ranks top-10 in the Midwest League in batting average (.350, 6th), walks (15, tied for 7th), and OPS (.986, 10th). He is also currently on an 8-game hitting streak, during which he is hitting .379 with 11 hits, 2 runs, 1 home run, 5 RBI, 7 walks, and a .997 OPS.

INGLE'S INCREDIBLE START: Lake County C Cooper Ingle has gotten off to a strong start at the plate to begin this season. In his first nine games, the 2023 fourth-round pick is hitting a team-best .371 with 13 hits, 4 runs, a team-best 6 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 2 walks, a .405 OBP, .629 SLG, and 1.034 OPS. His 0.67 doubles per game are tied for the most in the Midwest League with Peoria's Alex Iadernia.

MOONEY MAKES HISTORY: On Saturday, April 27, Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, tied a pair of franchise records. The 2023 seventh-round pick went 5-for-5 with 3 doubles, becoming the 16th Captain to record a 5-hit game, and the 13th to record a 3-double game. Mooney recorded the first 5-hit performance by a Lake County player since Bobby Ison on 8/7/2016 vs. West Michigan, and the first 3-double performance since current Double-A Akron RubberDucks OF Chase DeLauter on 7/9/2023 at Lansing.

LAST TIME OUT: Back on April 24, **Austin Peterson** (3-1) earned his third win of the season in a road start against West Michigan. The right-hander spun his first High-A and his fifth Minor League quality start, pitching a season-high 6 innings. He allowed 5 hits, 2 earned runs, and 1 walk, while throwing 7 strikeouts in 80 pitches (57 strikes) in the 4-2 win. **Peterson's** 2 earned runs were courtesy of a two-out, two-run double in the bottom of the fourth inning.

OFF TO A STELLAR HIGH-A START: Through his first four High-A starts, **Peterson** is tied with Captains teammate **Parker Messick** for the Midwest League lead with 27 strikeouts. He also ranks 4th in the MWL in K/BB ratio (13.50), 8th in WHIP (1.05), 12th in ERA (3.43) and 15th in opposing batting average (.247).

2024 AGAINST THE TINCAPS: In Game 2 of a doubleheader on April 13, **Peterson** faced Fort Wayne in his second career High-A start. He recorded his only loss of the season, but went a strong 5 innings, allowing a season-high 6 hits, 2 earned runs, and no walks, while throwing 8 punchouts in the 3-0 loss.

2023 IN REVIEW: **Peterson** made 24 starts with Single-A Lynchburg last season, which were tied for the most in the Carolina League with RHP and fellow Hillcat **Alonzo Richardson**, as well as Charleston RiverDogs (TB) RHP **Marcus Johnson**. Peterson recorded 4 quality starts, tied for the third-most in the Carolina League.

POUNDING THE ZONE: Last year, **Peterson** finished 4th in the Carolina League with 102 strikeouts. He also ranked second in the Cleveland player development system with a 3.78 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and posted the second-lowest walk rate among qualified arms in the Carolina League (5.4%). The right-hander threw 1,219 strikes, the second-most in the Carolina League.

THE GREAT EIGHT: In 2023, **Peterson** posted two starts of 8.0 shutout innings on June 30 versus the Delmarva Shorebirds (BAL) and July 21 versus the Fayetteville Woodpeckers (HOU). He threw just 83 and 84 pitches, respectively, in these starts, retiring 48 of a combined 55 batters faced.

A STAR IN STORRS: After making 25 appearances at Purdue in 2019 and five appearances at Wabash Valley Community College (IL) in 2020, **Peterson** was a two-time All-Big East pitcher at UConn. In just two seasons with the Huskies, he struck out 226 batters, tied for the sixth-most in program history. In 2022, the right-hander was named a 1st Team NCBWA All-American, NCBWA District Co-Player of the Year, New England Pitcher of the Year, and 1st Team All-Big East. In his final year with the Huskies, **Peterson** struck out a program-record 147 batters, the third-most in the country. He also went 8+ innings in three starts. In 2021, **Peterson** was named 2nd Team All-Big East, ranking fourth in the conference with a 2.58 ERA, and leading the conference with 33 strikeouts looking.

BOILERMAKER BEGINNINGS: **Peterson** began his college career at Purdue, where he led its freshman class with 49 strikeouts, 25 appearances, and 48.0 innings pitched. He earned his first college victory on March 9, 2019, pitching a season-high 5.1 innings of relief and fanning a then-career-best 9 batters in the 9-8 win.
