KANNAPOLIS SINKS MYRTLE BEACH, EVENS SERIES

The Myrtle Beach Pelicans were defeated by the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers 3-2 in walk-off fashion on Wednesday evening at Atrium Health Ballpark. The Pelicans (19-32) took the lead in the fourth when Matt Halbach singled to score Leonel Espinoza, and Owen Ayers scored on a forceout by Yahil Melendez, aided by a throwing error by Kannapolis second baseman Ryan Burrowes, making it 2-0. The Cannon Ballers (28-25) got on the board in the seventh when Caleb Bonemer homered to left, cutting the deficit to 2-1. In the ninth, Ryan Burrowes tied the game with a leadoff homer, and Miguel Santos delivered a walk-off single to score Nathan Archer, with Javier Mogollon and Ronny Hernandez on base, sealing the 3-2 win. Myrtle Beach's Ethan Bell (0-1) took the loss and a blown save, allowing two runs on three hits over 1.2 innings with four strikeouts and two walks. Kannapolis reliever Gabriel Rodriguez (1-1) earned the win, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings, allowing no hits with two strikeouts and one walk, despite hitting two batters. Pelicans starter Will Frisch pitched 4.1 scoreless innings, allowing two hits with three strikeouts and five walks. Brayden Spears threw 2.2 innings, allowing one run on three hits. Kannapolis starter Seth Keener went 7.0 innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on five hits with nine strikeouts and no walks. Halbach led the Pelicans with an RBI single, going 1-for-3, while Espinoza went 2-for-4 with a run scored. Myrtle Beach went 3-for-6 with runners in scoring position, leaving four runners on base, while Kannapolis went 2-for-11, leaving 12.

2024 SECOND-HALF SURGE

After enduring their longest losing streak in five years by dropping eight straight games from June 29th to July 6th, the Pelicans turned it around to win 16 of 22 games from July 9-August 10th, and eight games in a row from July 23rd-August 1st. During that time, the Pelicans led the league in batting average (.257), runs scored (121), OPS (.784), and are third in home runs with 17 and ERA (2.97). The late-season run propelled the Birds from 6th to 3rd in the second-half standings in the South Division. The eightgame winning streak from July 23rd-August 1st was the longest in two years, when the Pelicans won a franchise-record 12 conescutive games from May 14th to the 27th.

THE SILVER SEASON

The Pelicans celebrated their 25th season in 2024. After the departure of the Myrtle Beach Hurricanes in 1992, the Pelicans were established in 1999 following the relocation of the Durham Bulls to Myrtle Beach. During their 25 seasons, the Pelicans have won four Carolina League titles in 1999, 2000, 2015, and 2016. Myrtle Beach has been affiliated with three teams in their 25 seasons, including the Atlanta Braves (1999-2010), Texas Rangers (2011-2014), and the Chicago Cubs (2015-present)

A NEW SHERIFF IN TOWN

The Pelicans have a new manager in 2025. **Yovanny Cuevas** joined the Chicago Cubs organization as a player in 2015. His minor league career ran through 2021 with stops in the Dominican Summer League (DSL), the Arizona Complex League (ACL), and the Northwest League with the Eugene Emeralds. Overall, Cuevas' minor league slash line was .241/.369/.356 over 272 games. In 2022 Cuevas transitioned into a coach. His first assignment was with the ACL Cubs. The following season Cuevas was the hitting coach for the DSL Cubs Red squad, the Cubs affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. Last season he returned to the ACL Cubs as the hitting coach.

MEET THE "SQUADRON"

Highlighting the Pelicans roster are five of the Cubs' Top 30 prospects in Cole Mathis, Angel Cepeda, Yahil Melendez, Nazier Mule and Ty Southisene. Mathis is the 15th ranked prospect in the organization and will make his minor league debut this season with the Pelicans after being drafted 54th overall by the Cubs out of the College of Charleston in 2024. Cepeda slots into the 17th spot in the prospect rankings and is also the youngest player on the roster, having turned 19 in January. Angel grew up in New Jersey and scouts began taking interest in his talent when he was just 14 years old. He moved back to the Dominican Republic before signing with the Cubs in 2023.

The Pelicans Opening Day roster also welcomed eight Cubs' picks from the 2024 MLB Draft to the Grand Strand, including Mathis. Of the eight 2024 draftees, four are pitchers and four are position players. Brooks Caple, Evan Aschenbeck, Hayden Frank, Brayden Risedorph make up the pitchers while the hitters include Mathis, Owen Ayers, Matt Halbach and Cameron Sisneros.

16 players who have experience wearing the Pelicans uniform will return in 2025. **Nazier Mule** made 13 starts last season for the Pelicans, which was third most by any pitcher last season and leads all returners. In 2022 he was drafted by the Cubs in the 4th round and the 20-year-old is ready for his second season in Myrtle Beach.

Other returning players include Ayers, Sisneros, Jeral Vizcaino, Leonel Espinoza, Eriandys Ramon, Christopher Paciolla, Jose Escobar, Dilan Granadillo, Yenrri Rojas, JP Wheat, Anderson Suriel, Alfredo Romero, Will Frisch, Luis Martinez-Gomez and Mathew Peters.

BIRD DROPPINGS

- After leading the league in home runs in both 2023 and 2024, the Pelicans have hit 26 homers this season which is the sixth most in the league. Myrtle Beach has hit 20 of their 26 homers on the road, the second most road homers of any team in the league. Their 6 homers at home rank eleventh. - Leonel Espinoza's 11-game hitting streak from 4/6-4/18 was the longest hitting streak in the league when it ended. Cameron Sisneros matched his streak with an 11-gamer from 4/25 to 5/11. Angel Cepeda's 21-game on-base streak from 4/24 to current is the longest streak for a Myrtle Beach hitter since Parker Chavers reached base in 27 consecutive games from 5/31/23-7/14/2023.

-Eriandys Ramon set the single-game franchise record with four doubles on 8/15/24 vs. Columbia. He is 1 of 12 MB hitters with 2+ doubles as the Pelicans rank 2nd in the Carolina League with 78 two-baggers. Owen Ayers is responsible for 10 doubles, a tie for eighth place on the individual league leaderboard. -Pelicans' backstop Owen Ayers has been a dominant force in controlling the running game...he leads all of minor league baseball with 27 caught stealings while ranking 15th in total innings caught. -Defensively, Myrtle Beach is 1 of 2 teams in the Carolina League with a fielding percentage above. 970. -MB ranks 6th in the league in total runners left on base and recently became the 10th to try a SAC bunt.
