Trouble with the Curve: The Somerset Patriots take on the Altoona Curve at Peoples Natural Gas Field this week. The two teams previously met in Bridgewater and split a six-game seet in late July. Altoona has taken three of the first four games of the current series.

Back-to-Back Duds: Somerset dropped last night's ballgame 11-3, one run shy of its largest margin of defeat this year. They were shutout the previous night in Altoona. Their -13 run differential across these two losses is the largest in any consecutive losses for the team this season. Additionally, the team is 10-for-63 (.159) from the plate over these two games, well below the team's .249 batting average prior to the two losses. The Patriots have now lost three games in a row for only the fourth time this year, but second time in the last two weeks. Somerset is 4-10 ever since it improved to a season-best 21 games over .500 (50-29) to top off a six-game win streak after a 6-2 win over Bowie (8/4) at home.

It's So Semple: Despite allowing five runs over five innings in his last start, Shawn Semple has still been very strong for the Patriots since he was transferred from High-A Hudson Valley in late July. Semple is 3-0 with a 2.66 ERA and 33 strikeouts against seven walks over 23.2 innings of work across five appearances (two starts) since returning to Somerset. That includes four perfect innings of relief as a part of the team's first-ever no-hitter on 8/8 vs. Bowie.

Peraza Party: Shorstop Oswald Peraza returned to this week after spending the last week as a member of the New York Yankees taxi squad. After beginning the series 7-for-16 with two walks, Peraza went 0-for-5 last night and saw both an eight-game hit streak and 11-game onbase streak come to a close. He hit .471 (16-for-34) with two home runs, six RBI and a .500 OBP over the hit streak.

Battering Bastidas: INF Jesus Bastidas has reached base in six of his eight plate appearances since returning to the lineup Thursday night (three hits, three walks). Bastidas has now reached base safely in all 14 games he's played at the Double-A level since his promotion on 7/18 and has hit safely in 11 of those 14 games. He currently owns a .318 batting average with a .464 OBP in Double-A, including a .389 average and a .545 OBP over six games in August.

Post Milone: Thomas Milone extended his on-base streak to a team-high 35 games with a pair of walks Friday night. Milone's streak dates back to May 11th and spans three tours in Somerset sandwhiched around two separate stops with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He has now reached base safely in 39 of the 40 games in which he's played with Somerset.

An Ernst Effort: RHP Nick Ernst tossed three scoreless innings of relief last night with three strikeouts. He has now only allowed one run and three baserunners over his first three appearances in Double-A with eight strikeouts spanning 7.0 innings of work.

Arms Race: Somerset's pitching staff owns the lowest BAA (.212) and most shutout wins (15) across all MiLB levels. Additionally, the team boasts the second-lowest ERA (3.43), third-lowest WHIP (1.17) and ranks fifth in strikeouts (1,015). The strikeout total is already the fourth-most for a Patriots pitching staff in the last ten years.
