Today: The Lugnuts look for a fourth straight win as they welcome in the Dayton Dragons for the start of a six-game series. The Nuts are 6-6 against Dayton this year, splitting six-game series at Day Air Ballpark in May and at Jackson® Field™ in July. Lansing is coming off winning four out of six games at the Lake County Captains, tied for second place with Dayton in the High-A Central's East Division. 6-foot-8 right-hander **Jorge Juan**, rated by MLB.com as the A's No. 29 prospect, makes his second Lugnuts start as well as his home debut.

Sunday: Lugnuts 12, Captains 4. Starter Jack Cushing overcame a four-run third inning to win his sixth straight decision, Lester Madden, Jr., and William Simoneit homered, and the Nuts scored seven runs in the final three innings against Lake County's best relievers to blow out the Caps in the series finale at Classic Park.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a matinee, with the Nuts and Dragons convening at 1:05 p.m. on a Dog Days of Summer.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

Lug•Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Hoya Saxa: The Lugnuts have won all seven games in which Jack Cushing has pitched, including both games the Georgetown right-hander pitched at Lake County, Tuesday's opener and Sunday's finale. In just seven appearances, six starts, in the High-A Central, Cushing is already tied for the league lead with six victories

Going Yard: Lansing hit nine home runs in the six games at Lake County: three by Jordan Díaz, two by William Simoneit, and one apiece by Patrick McColl, Cobie Vance, Jared McDonald and Lester Madden, Jr.

Going Streaking: William Simoneit went 3-for-5 in Sunday's series finale at Lake County and has now hit safely in nine straight games, with a batting average of .361 (13-for-36) dating back to July 30. Simoneit's nine-game hitting streak ties Michael Guldberg (May 15-27) for the longest hitting streak on the Lugnuts this season.

Head Count: Catcher Cooper Uhi joined the ballclub on the road from Triple-A Stockton and became the newest Nut to debut on August 5, the 47th different player on the ballclub this season and the 851st Lugnuts player all-time.

Three Nuts Go to Washington: On July 30, catcher Drew Millas and pitchers Richard Guasch and Seth Shuman were traded by the Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher Yan Gomes and utilityman Josh Harrison. Millas debuted on Thursday, Guasch debuted Friday, and Shuman debuted Saturday, tossing five innings and allowing four runs on four hits (two homers) and two walks with seven strikeouts in a loss to Bowling Green. The three players are staying with Delaware native Colin Peluse's parents.

Alumni Report: Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., who played for the 2017 Lansing squad at 18 years old, is second in the Majors in home runs (35), first in RBIs (87), third in on-base percentage (.412), third in slugging percentage (.635), first in OPS (1.047), first in total bases (254), and tied for first in runs scored (86) with 2017 Lugnuts teammate Bo Bichette. 2019 Lugnuts outfielder Griffin Conine leads the Minors with 29 home runs.

Never Count Out the Stockton Ports: A level below the Lugnuts on the A's organizational ladder, the Low-A West Stockton Ports trailed 12-0 going to the bottom of the 6th inning on Sunday vs. Modesto, but scored four runs in the 6th, seven runs in the 7th and then walked off with a 14-12 win on **Alexander Campos**'s one-out, three-run homer in the bottom of the 9th. Earlier this season, Stockton had come back from a 9-0 deficit to win.

Nut-lympics Report: Event 3, Juggling, was held before Saturday night's game, with Jared McDonald winning the gold medal, DJ Lee capturing silver and Yerdel Vargas taking bronze. Event 2, Grape Catching, was held three days earlier, on Wednesday, with the pairing of tosser Brock Whittlesey and catcher William Simoneit winning gold, followed by Leudeny Pineda/Elvis Peralta, Jr. taking silver, and Jorge Juan/José Mora earning bronze. Event 1, Fungo Golf, came two Sundays ago, opening the Nut-lympics, with Anthony Phillips winning gold, Javier Godard silver and Charles Hall bronze.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2018: With an 11-4 victory over the Dayton Dragons at Cooley Law School Stadium, the Nuts completed an 11-0 home sweep of the Dragons in 2018, improving to 15-3 in the season series. The Lugnuts (70-47) also became the fifth MiLB to reach the 70-win threshold

2019: A Miles Gordon one-out triple in the sixth inning supplied Dayton's only base runner in a near perfect game for the Lugnuts, settling for a 6-0 win at Dayton. Troy Watson fired seven innings, striking out four, before Will McAffer struck out the vide in the eighth and Cre Finfrock struck out two in the ninth. Griffin Conine led the offense with a two-run tiebreaking single in the sixth and a solo home run in the eighth.

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Pitching is an Art... and **So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland**, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Five former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season - pitcher Ty Tice '18 (Toronto, now with Arizona), outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher Tayler Saucedo '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher Conner Greene '15 (Baltimore) and pitcher Kirby Snead '16-'17 (Toronto). Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals. Snead most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero**, **Jr.**, who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, Max Schuemann broke Samad Taylor's franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Creat Lakes Leaves.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, Stevie Emanuels broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Nuts have used 16 different starting pitchers this season, Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Charlie Cerny, Jeff Criswell, Jack Cushing, David Leal, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Jorge Juan, Rafael Kelly, Bryce Nightengale, Colin Peluse, Leudeny Pineda, Seth Shuman, Shohei Tomioka and Brock Whittlesey.

The Long and Short of it: The 6'8 right-hander, the tallest player on the Lugnuts, was promoted to High-A from Low-A Stockton due to the July 30 trading of Seth Shuman and Richard Guasch to the Washington Nationals with Drew Millas in exchange for Josh Harrison and Yan Gomes.

Last Time Out: In his Lugnuts debut, August 4 at Lake County, Juan retired the first two batters he faced before allowing a Micah Pries single, George Valera walk, Joe Naranjo two-run double and Victor Nova RBI double, striking out Raynel Delgado to finally end the 1st inning... after that nervy start, he relaxed, pitching around a one-out walk with two strikeouts in the 2nd inning... gave up a two-out walk in the 3rd inning and departed in favor of Brandon Withers... 64 pitches, 34 strikes.

Prospecting: Jorge is ranked MLB Pipeline's No. 29 prospect in the Oakland Athletics organization, moving into the Top 30 after Greg Deichmann and Drew Millas were traded at the deadline. His Pipeline grades: fastball - 65, curve - 55, change - 40, control - 45. Quoting MLB.com, "Juan has opened a lot of eyes this season by filling up the strike zone mostly with a two-pitch power mix. His fastball has been up to 99 mph, sitting at 92-97 mph consistently. He couples it with a curve ball that flashes plus, thrown 85 mph, that can have slider/slurve tendencies.... The biggest change for Juan has been his ability to throw downhill consistently and command the ball better. He's missed a ton of bats with a pretty repeatable delivery. If the changeup can improve, that would give him the chance to start."

2017, Signing Day: Juan signed for \$10,000 with Oakland's Juan C. De La Cruz, who was also the signing scout for former Lugnuts pitchers Richard Guasch and Rafael Kelly.

2018, Dominican Summer League: Spent the entire season in the DSL, beginning in a piggyback tandem with Carlos Leandro, alternating starts and relief appearances... the team also included future Lugnut Richard Guasch... struggled with his control, hitting ten batters in his first nine appearances but only one in his last six... opposiing base stealers went 14-for-18 in effectiveness against him.... dominated left-handed batters (5-for-46, .109) compared to right-handers (27-for-111, 10 HBP, .243).... gave up only five extra-base hits, all doubles

2019, Arizona League: Started the third game of the season for A's Green, bursting out of the gates with an impressive 3 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 7 K... followed up with three scoreless innings in his second appearance but then hit a road block, allowing at least one run in every subsequent appearance, including three games with 4+ runs allowed and seven games with 3+ walks... opposing base stealers were 11-for-16... again handled lefties (11-for-52, .212, .364 OBP, .614 OPS) compared to right-handers (21-for-72, .292, .469 OBP, .886 OPS)... allowed eight extra-base hits (6 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run).

2021, Low-A West: Joined Stockton for the 44th game of the year, starting June 24 at Inland Empire and tossing two innings (4 H, 3 R, 2 BB, 2 K) before current Lugnut Jack Cushing relieved him and threw six dazzling innings (1 UER) of relief... followed up with a gem, four hitless innings vs. San Jose, July 1... opposing base stealers went 4-for-4... left-handed batters hit .214 (9-for-42, 2 2B, 2 HR), right-handers hit .188 (6-for-32, 1 3B).
