EVAN CARTER PROPELS RIDERS TO WIN OVER SAN ANTONIO:

Evan Carter tripled and homered and the Frisco RoughRiders never trailed to the San Antonio Missions in a 6-2 win at Riders Field on Tuesday. Carter tripled in the first inning to take the lead, scoring **Luisangel Acuña** after Acuña's double. The Riders (8-8, 39-45) did not have an extra base hit their previous two games but recorded two in the first inning on Tuesday and three on the night. San Antonio (6-10, 43-42) notched just one extra base hit and no multiple-run innings. Carter led off the fifth inning with a homer, added two walks and equaled a career high by scoring three times. The 20-year-old has torched San Antonio this season, going 26-for-61 (.426) with five home runs. **Dane Acker** (1-0) made his third start with the RoughRiders and collected his first win. He lasted five innings with just two hits allowed and one run. **Ryan Bergert** (0-1) took the loss for San Antonio, charged with four runs in three innings. **Nick Starr** struck out a pair in a scoreless sixth inning as the first of four Frisco relievers, who combined to go four innings with one run allowed. **Matt Bush** and **Michael Brewer** did not allow a hit to finish off the final two innings. **Chris Seise** and **Aaron Zavala** both recorded three hits for the first time this season for the Riders. They did so on back-to-back pitches in the eighth inning. Zavala also picked up a two-out RBI when he singled in the fourth inning to bring home **Josh Hatcher**. All nine Riders hitters reached base at least once, combining for 10 hits, five walks and three hit batters. Frisco is now 10-9 against San Antonio this season by winning the first game of this series, which is the fourth and final series of the regular season against the Missions.

GENTLEMEN, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the starting pitching side of things this season. This year, Frisco has a 6.06 starting pitcher ERA which is the highest in recorded franchise history (dating back to 2005) and second in the league to Amarillo (6.22). Including Slaten, they have used 20 different starting pitchers, more than the 14 they used all season in 2022 and one more than they used the whole year in 2021. Frisco has not had a start of more than 5.1 innings since June 10th, when **Ryan Garcia** went seven innings. Over those 29 games since June 10th, the Riders' starters' ERA is 7.46 (87ER/105.0IP) while the bullpen has a 4.52 ERA (73ER/145.1IP). Over the 29 games, the Riders have the fifth-best offense in the league by OPS (.775) and have hit 28 home runs.

HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:

Since coming to Frisco in June from High-A Hickory, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 15 games, he has driven in 17 runs and in July, Hatcher is hitting .353/.385/.529/.914 with two homers and 13 RBIs in nine games.

WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 21 games since his return, he has eight multi-hit games, batting .354 (29-for-82)/.426/.622/1.048 with three doubles, two triples, five home runs, 16 RBIs and 18 runs scored.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over his last 33 games, he is hitting .357/.440/.651/1.091 with nine home runs and 30 RBIs. The California native is currently fifth in the league in batting average (.310), third in RBIs (65), eighth in slugging percentage (.508), second in hits (102), fourth in doubles (20) and second in total bases (167).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League (min. 11 at-bats) with a .567 average (17-for-30) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.494 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .464 (26-for-56) on the initial offering while his 26 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors.

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 36 and is on pace for a career-best 60 swipes. Acuña is on pace to set a single-season record for the Riders, as **Elvis Andrus** has the record with 54 swipes in 2008. The RoughRiders are fifth in Texas League steals with 110 bases in 132 attempts (83 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season. They are one of four teams with at least seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .346/.414/.442/.856 in July. He is fifth in the Texas League in batting average (.308), third in hits (100), third in doubles (21), second in runs (60) and first in steals (36).

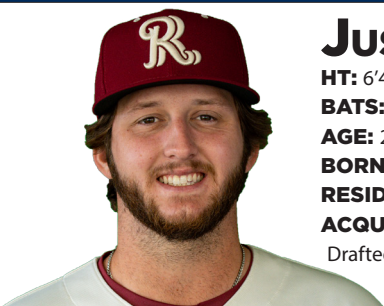

ABOUT JUSTIN

-5A Hallsville High School in Hallsville, Texas (a little over two hours from Frisco toward the Louisiana border). Thought he was going to play in junior college before owning a 1.49 ERA his senior year. He received an offer from University of New Mexico. Helped Hallsville to a 5A regional quarterfinal appearance in 2016 as a senior.

-At New Mexico, Slaten was a three-year player with two spent in the starting rotation. After owning a 7.02 ERA his sophomore season, Slaten went 5-5 with a 2.51 ERA while striking out 98 in 82.1 innings to earn 2nd-Team All-Mountain West Conference honors.

-His third-round selection (86th overall), made Slaten the highest New Mexico pitcher taken in the MLB draft since Kevin Andersh was taken in the first round (15th overall) by the Pirates in 1984.

-After being acquired in the offseason by the Rangers, catcher Mitch Garver is the only former Lobo on Texas. Garver was drafted out of New Mexico in 2013 by the Twins.

2023 SEASON

-Began season in bullpen for Frisco.

2022 SEASON

-First appearance for the Riders came out of the bullpen on Opening Night, throwing a scoreless inning with a pair of strikeouts.

-Pitched first shutout outing among Riders starters on April 28th at Midland, going five shutout innings. The Riders trailed 1-0 into the ninth before scoring six runs in a 6-1 victory.

-Piggy backed with Zak Kent on May 22nd, striking out a season-best seven over 3.2 innings against Corpus Christi.

2021 SEASON

-Finished the 2021 season as the No. 29 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Ended the year with the 5th-most strikeouts (110) and 10th-most innings (82.1) among Rangers minor leaguers in his 20 games (19 starts) with High-A Hickory.

-Over last 12 games, Slaten went 4-4 with a 1.14 ERA to conclude the year.

-Entered the season as the No. 15 prospect in the system by Fangraphs.

2020 SEASON

-Struck out 17 of 44 (38.6 percent) batters faced in the Fall Developmental league while allowing just two runs over 10.2 innings.

2019 SEASON

-Averaged 12.1 K/9 over his 11 games (10 starts) during first professional season.
