YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Bowie Baysox, 6-1, for their fifth loss in the last six games. The Baysox opened the scoring in the top of the first with an RBI single by Jaylen Ferguson. Bowie scored four runs in the third. J.C. Escarra hit a two-run single. Robert Neustrom and Doran Turchin followed with RBI singles. In the sixth, Cadyn Grenier hit an RBI double to extend the lead to 6-0. The Flying Squirrels broke the shutout in the bottom of the eighth with an RBI single by Andres Angulo. Richmond starter Gerson Garabito allowed a season-high five runs over 2.2 innings. The bullpen allowed one run over 6.1 innings. Bowie starter Kevin Smith struck out eight batters in 4.2 innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels played the fourth of a six-game set against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The two teams will face of 24 times this season, with two series in Bowie and two in Richmond. The Flying Squirrels enter on a three-game losing streak. The Baysox are in first place in the AA-NE Southwest and have won eight of their last nine games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have dropped two straight games and five of the last six. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 2.5 games behind Bowie. Over the last six games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .217 (43-for-198) as a team. Through the previous 10 games, the Flying Squirrels hit .264 (84-for-318), third-best in the league.

THE BAYSOX lead the Double-A Northeast Southwest Division by a half-game over Erie. Patrick Dorrian was named the Double-A Northeast Player of the Week after hitting .333 with three homers and 11 RBIs last week against Reading. Bowie's roster includes five of MLB.com's Top-30 Orioles prospects, including Adley Rutschman (1), D.L. Hall (4), Terrin Vavra (11), Kyle Bradish (13) and Kevin Smith (17). The Baysox lead all of Double-A in runs scored (94) and rank fifth in batting average (.251).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Tristan Beck** makes his fourth start of the season. Last time out, he worked 4.1 innings at Harrisburg on Saturday and was hit with his second loss after allowing four runs. Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the fourth round in 2018, Beck was traded to the Giants along with RHP Dan Winkler for reliever Mark Melancon on July 31, 2019 at the trade deadline. That year, his first full professional season, he began the campaign with the High-A Florida Fire Frogs and went 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA through his first four starts before being placed on the injured list with an oblique injury in late-April. After a rehab assignment in the GCL, Beck returned to make four more starts before being traded. He made six total starts with High-A San Jose to close out 2019, and went 3-0 with a 0.47 ERA (1 ER/19.0 IP) in his last three outings of the season. **For more on Beck, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Ofelky Peralta makes his second start and third appearance of the season. He made his season debut on May 7 at Altoona and allowed two runs in 4.0 innings in a no-decision. He pitched 4.0 relief innings in his most recent outing last Friday, allowing just one run on one hit. Peralta is in his first Double-A season after splitting 2019 between Single-A Delmarva and A-Adv. Frederick, combining to go 9-5 with a 4.03 ERA in 23 starts and two relief outings. He was selected as a South Atlantic League Mid-Season All-Star in 2019. He spent four straight seasons pitching at the two full-season Single-A levels from 2016 to 2019 before earning his first promotion to Double-A this year.

STRONG ARMS: This season, the Flying Squirrels rank second in all of Double-A in ERA (2.95). The Richmond pitching staff also ranks tied for second in shutouts (2), tied for second in saves (6), fifth in fewest runs allowed (52) and fourth in opponents' batting average (.208). Starting pitcher **Matt Frisbee** is tied for fourth among qualified pitchers in ERA (0.56). He leads Double-A and sits second in all of the minors in WHIP (0.38). **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for second in Double-A with three saves.

AIN'T THAT GRAND: On Tuesday, **Andres Angulo** clubbed a go-ahead grand slam for his first Double-A home run. It was the first grand slam for the Flying Squirrels since **Jacob Heyward** hit a walk-off slam in the tenth inning to beat the Erie SeaWolves on August 19, 2019. Angulo now tenth in the Double-A Northeast with a .318 batting average this season, tops on the Richmond roster. Prior to the 2021 season, Angulo had not played above the Low-A level. He spent the 2019 season with Single-A Augusta, seeing time in 73 games.

CLOSING IT OUT: Reliever **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for the lead in the Double-A Northeast with three saves this season. He is also tied for third in games pitched (6). Last Thursday, Ruotolo pitched the ninth inning to finish a combined no-hitter, the first nine-inning no-hitter in the history of the Flying Squirrels franchise.

TOP OF THE CLASS: Adley Rutschman is the fourth player selected No. 1 overall in the MLB Draft to play against the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond. In 2011, Harrisburg's Bryce Harper (2010 Draft) played five games in Richmond, batting .278 (5-for-18) with a double from July 21-24. In 2019, Reading's Mickey Moniak (2016) played six games in Richmond, batting .308 (8-for-26) with two doubles and six RBIs. Also in 2019, Casey Mize (2018) pitched against the Flying Squirrels on July 21 and allowed six runs (five earned) while only recording two outs in his start. Two other top overall draft picks who played in the Eastern League/Double-A Northeast during the Flying Squirrels' existence, Gerrit Cole (2011 Draft) and Stephen Strasburg (2009 Draft), never pitched at The Diamond.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 9-6 record is tied for the second-best start through 15 games in team history, even with their start in 2014 and trailing only an 11-4 start in 2018.

A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS: The Flying Squirrels have sold out their maximum capacity crowds at The Diamond for six of their seven openings this year. For the first homestand, the Flying Squirrels drew the maximum allotted crowd of 2,943 for all five openings. In the current homestand, the maximum capacity is 3,448. After drawing 3,057 fans on Tuesday (89%), the Flying Squirrels have sold out the last two games. Tonight's game and Saturday's game have also sold out. Limited tickets remain for Sunday's homestand finale.

ALL OVER THE MAP: The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (4), Georgia (4), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12) and **Sean Hjelle** (13). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Ramos (3), Hjelle (11) and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: On Monday night, 2019 Flying Squirrels outfielder **Johneshwy Fargas** made his Major League debut for the New York Mets in Atlanta. He picked up his first MLB hit in the game, an RBI double. In 2019, Fargas was named the Flying Squirrels Player of the Year after hitting .249 over 127 games. He also set the franchise's single-season stolen base record with 50 on the year.

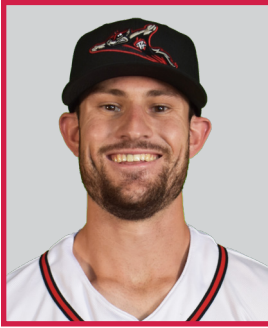
