**YESTERDAY'S RECAP:** The New Hampshire Fisher Cats hit three more home runs on Tuesday night but fell to the Binghamton Rumble Ponies 7-5 in the series opener at Delta Dental Stadium. For the third time in five games, **Orelvis Martinez** delivered a multi-home run game. The Blue Jays No. 4 prospect hit a two-run homer in the first and a solo homer in the third. **Dylan Rock** recorded his second three-hit game at the Double-A level, collecting two doubles and a solo home run in the eighth. On the mound, **Jimmy Robbins** threw five innings, allowing seven hits, four runs and no walks while striking out five in a no-decision. It was Robbins's longest start since his very first start of the year at Altoona when he went five innings on April 8. Leading 4-3 heading into the seventh, Binghamton grabbed four runs off New Hampshire reliever **Alejandro Melean** to take the lead, suffering his first loss of the season.

**WE HIT DINGERS:** New Hampshire has hit 19 home runs in the last seven games after previously only hitting 17 in the first 26 games of the season. The Fisher Cats have homered in eight straight games dating back to Sun. May 7 vs Harrisburg. **Orelvis Martinez, Damiano Palmegiani, Miguel Hiraldo, Zac Cook** and **Dylan Rock** have all hit more than one homer during this stretch (Martinez has seven and Palmegiani, Hiraldo, Cook, and Rock all have two).

**OUTTA HERE ORELVIS:** IF **Orelvis Martinez** is on a home run tear the past six games. The Blue Jays No. 4 prospect has seven home runs in his last six games and has delivered multi-home run performances in three of his last five nights. On Tuesday, he recorded his 11th career multi-homer game. 11 of his 16 hits this season have gone over the wall. In the series at Reading, he hit five home runs and 10 RBIs in the series. The 21-year-old Dominican Republic native is second in the Eastern League with 11 home runs and is tied for second in the Eastern League with 28 RBIs. Martinez's 41 Fisher Cat homers is tied for fifth in New Hampshire history with Ryan Patterson (2006-2008).

**PARTY LIKE A ROCK STAR:** OF **Dylan Rock** is currently on a five-game hit streak, hitting .450 (9-for-20) with four doubles, two homers and five RBIs in these last five contests. Rock has homered in back-to-back games after homering on Sunday in Reading. Coming into the series at Reading last week, Rock was on a 0-for-14 skid.

**'OBP' – ON BASE PALMEGIANI:** IF **Damiano Palmegiani** is in the top-10 of the Eastern League leaderboard on on-base percentage. The corner infielder is getting on-base at a .402 clip, tenth-best in the league. The Blue Jays No. 29 prospect is tied for third in the Eastern League in walks (24). He has as many walks as hits (24). Palmegiani has reached base in an impressive 26 of 30 games played this season.

**CAN'T STOP STEWARD:** OF **Steward Berroa** currently has the longest active hit streak on the team at seven consecutive games. The speedy outfielder has driven in six RBIs over his last seven games after driving in six RBIs all of April. During his hit streak, Berroa is 9-for-26 (.346) with three doubles, a homer and six RBIs.

**THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (May 17, 2022)** – The Fisher Cats broke open the game at Erie with seven runs in the top of the ninth inning in a 13-3 win. Will Robertson homered in his first at bat in the inning, and then added an RBI double later in the frame. Orelvis Martinez also hit a three-run homer in the ninth, his 11<sup>th</sup> home run of the season.

**MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Yankees moved into a third place tie with Toronto (24-18) with a 6-3 win last night at Rogers Centre. The Jays rallied from down 3-0 to tie, only to have Aaron Judge hit a two-run homer in the eighth to put New York in front...Triple-A Buffalo (19-21) opened a home series with Rochester with a 7-4 win. **Drew Hutchison** allowed three runs in five innings for his first win. He did walk six batters. **Cam Eden** had a pair of hits and drove in a run for the Bisons...High-A Vancouver (17-13) fell 4-3 at Tri-City. Alan Roden went 3-for-5 with a pair of doubles for the Canadians. Vancouver fell out of first place, and now trail Eugene by a half-game in the Northwest League....Class A Dunedin (18-16) dropped a 12-7 decision at Tampa. Abiezel Ramirez hit his second homer for the D-Jays.

**COMING UP:** The Fisher Cats play six home games against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies this week. Promotions include Margaritaville Night and Atlas Fireworks on Thursday, Wizards & Wands Night with Atlas Fireworks on Saturday, Princesses at the Park and Kids Run the Bases Sunday, presented by the New Hampshire Liquor Commission Division of Enforcement, and a Youth Jersey Giveaway Sunday, courtesy of Delta Dental.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Allowed two runs (one earned) last Thursday in Reading. Took a no decision in New Hampshire's 9-2 win. He worked the first five, leaving in a 2-2 game. Gave up just one hit, a two-run homer by Oliver Dunn in the fourth. He walked one and struck out seven.

**v. BINGHAMTON** – Made two starts last year vs. Rumble Ponies, and struggled in both. Allowed just one hit, but walked five in a 12-8 loss on July 29 at Mirabito Stadium.

**2023:** Quality start (0 ER- 6 IP) in 3-0 win over Harrisburg 5/5 with 8K. Went 7 innings for the first time at AA on 4/28 vs. HFD in a 2-0 loss....Earned a complete game victory 4/22 at Somerset in game shortened to five innings. Had eight strikeouts in a 3-1 win.

**2022:** Earned first Double-A win with 5.0 IP scoreless 8/16 at Hartford. Pitched season-high six innings in first quality start vs. Erie 8/10..Struck out 10 Sea Dogs in New Hampshire's 5-3 win July 23, but did not earn decision as Fisher Cats won the game late...Made Double-A debut in a relief outing in Erie May 21....Opened season with Adv. A Vancouver, going 0-2 with a 3.81 ERA in six starts. Struck out 30 in 25 IP.

**2021:** Kloffenstein spent the entire season with Class A Advanced Vancouver, making a career-high 23 starts. He pitched 101.1 innings and had a 7-7 record with a 6.22 ERA. He walked 61 batters and struck out 107.

**2019:** Had a 4-4 record and a 2.24 ERA with the Vancouver Canadians, who were the Class A short season affiliate of the Blue Jays in 2019. Kloff made 13 starts and threw 64.1 innings, 23 BB, 64 K. WHIP 1.09. .204 average against.

**2018:** Pitched with the GCL Blue Jays at the rookie level. (2.0 IP/2 starts)

**Obtained:** Kloffenstein was selected in the third round and 88th overall in the 2018 draft. He was drafted out of Magnolia High School, where he was teammates with Blue Jays prospect Jordan Groshans. He was originally committed to play at TCU and received a \$2.45 million signing bonus.

**Personal:** Was ranked the No. 11 prospect in the Toronto system at the beginning of 2022. The slider is Kloffenstein's highest-rated pitch.
