YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 11-5, in front of a sellout crowd at The Diamond for Independence Day. Bowie opened a 2-0 lead in the second with a two-run homer by Tim Susnara. In the third, Vaun Brown gave the Flying Squirrels a 3-2 lead with a three-run homer. In the sixth, Susnara tied the game with a solo home run, his second of the night. Marco Luciano put Richmond back ahead, 4-3, with a sac fly in the sixth. Billy Cook brought in two runs with a double in the top of the seventh to give the Baysox a 5-4 lead. The Flying Squirrels responded with seven runs in the bottom of the seventh to pull away, 11-5. Wade Meckler hit a two-run homer to put Richmond ahead. Luciano and Shane Matheny hit back-to-back solo homers. Hayden Cantrelle added a two-run single with a third run scoring on a double to cap the inning.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The Flying Squirrels won four-of-five at Prince George's Stadium from April 25-29, with the finale post-poned until June for rain. In their series in Bowie from June 13-18, the Baysox won four-of-seven. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will play a six-game series against the Baysox at The Diamond from August 8-13.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 12-2 in their last 14 games since June 18, including taking five-of-six in last week's series at Reading to open the second half of the season. They won six straight from June 23 through Friday, their longest winning streak since a seven-game stretch from April 28-May 5, 2022. Over the last 14 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .271 (126-for-465) with 19 homers, 27 doubles and have scored 86 runs. In that same stretch, the Richmond pitching staff has a 2.90 ERA (40 ER/124.0 IP) with 157 strikeouts. Over the last 20 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined to go 2-2 with a 2.18 ERA (17 ER/70.1 IP). For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.74 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 271.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 385.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.32 ERA, which is second-lowest in Double-A and tied for the seventh-lowest of the 120 teams in the minors.

THE BAYSDX opened the second half dropping four-of-six in last week's series against the Patriots. They are 2-6 in their last eight games since June 25. Bowie's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including 3B Coby Mayo (No. 9), LHP Cade Povich (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 13), RHP Chayce McDermott (No. 15), OF John Rhodes (No. 26) and RHP Jean Pinto (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes Mayo (No. 7), Povich (No. 11), Fabian (No. 15), McDermott (No. 17) and Rhodes (No. 19).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Parker Dunshee makes his first start of the season. He last pitched on Sunday at Reading and threw two innings, allowing one run. It was the first earned run he had allowed since June 15, snapping a three-outing stretch without surrendering an earned run (5.2 innings). Over his last nine appearances since May 28, Dunshee has potsed a 1.62 ERA. Dunshee was selected by the Athletics in the seventh round of the 2017 MLB Draft out of Wake Forest University. He reached as high as Triple-A. He signed with the Giants in April and joined the Flying Squirrels on May 13. For more on Dunshee, see page two.

FOR BDWIE: Right-hander Chayce McDermott makes his 14th start of the season and his third appearance against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Friday against the Patriots and allowed a season-high four runs over 51 innings with eight strike-outs in a win. After going 5-4 with a 2.47 ERA in his first 13 games of the year, McDermott has a 10.50 ERA (7 ER/6.0 IP) in his last two starts. He faced the Flying Squirrels out of the bullpen on April 25 and surrendered two runs in three innings. He started against Richmond on June 17 in Bowie and struck out a season-high 10 batters while allowing one run in 5.2 innings in a no-decision. McDermott was selected with the 132nd pick of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Astros out of Ball State. He joined the Orioles as part of a three-team trade last August before the deadline, part of the deal that sent Trey Mancini to Houston. After making two starts with High-A Aberdeen, he joined the Baysox in mid-August. McDermott made one start against the Flying Squirrels last year, allowing one run with nine strikeouts over 4.2 innings on Sept. 9 in Bowie. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 15 Orioles prospect and No. 17 by MLB.com. This year in the Eastern League, McDermott has the lowest BAA (165), sits third in strikeouts (85), seventh in ERA (3.22) and seventh in WHIP (1.20).

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, the Flying Squirrels are again at the top of the level in average attendance (6,649) and total attendance (252,676). The team's average attendance is the 13th-highest among the 120 MiLB teams.

A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS: Tuesday night's game marks the third sellout of the 2023 season for the Flying Squirrels. On May 17, the Flying Squirrels beat the RubberDucks, 11-4, in front of 9,810 fans. On May 31, they lost to the SeaWolves, 10-3, in 10 innings with another 9,810 fans in the house. The Diamond has seen six crowds of at least 9,000 fans this season. Tuesday was also the 57th sellout in Flying Squirrels history. Since 2010, they have gone 44-27 in sellouts, including four doubleheaders.

RETURN OF THE MECK: In Game 1 of June 23's doubleheader, Wade Meckler closed his historic performance with a two-run, walk-off single, giving the Flying Squirrels a 9-8 win in extras. Meckler went 5-for-5 and tied the single-game franchise record for hits. It was the 11th time a Richmond player has collected five hits in a game. In his five games of last week's series, Meckler reached base 13 times with 10 hits, including four on Thursday, and three walks. In the series-opener on Tuesday, he clubbed a go-ahead, two-run homer in the eighth inning. Meckler has now reached base in all 22 of his Double-A games, including 35 hits and 15 walks. His on-base streak is the longest active streak in the league and the longest by a Richmond player this season. He also leads the league with nine consecutive games scoring a run. Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 190 PA) this season in batting average (.425), OBP (.489) and BABIP (.472). In the Eastern League (min. 100 PA), Meckler is first in batting average (.398), on-base percentage (.485), ranks second in wRC+ (184) and third in OPS (1.020), he has the fourth-lowest strikeout percentage (12.6) and the second-lowest swinging strike percentage (5.0). He is currently on a nine-game hit streak since June 23, during which he is batting .526 (20-or-38) with two homers, four doubles, nine RBIs and five walks.

VAUN GONE WILD: Vaun Brown is riding a nine-game hit streak since June 22. He has homered four times in that stretch, including home runs in each of the first two games of last week's series at Reading and a three-run blast on Tuesday night at The Diamond. In his last nine games, Brown is batting .385 (14-for-40) with four homers, four doubles and 12 RBIs, adding three stolen bases. Over his previous nine games from June 9-20, Brown hit .057 (2-for-35) with three walks and 16 strikeouts. Brown also has a league-best six-game extra-base hit streak dating back to June 25.

THDMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Andy Thomas has picked up 11 RBIs over his last eight games since June 24. From June 24-29, he collected nine RBIs over a four-game span, including a two-run homer last Thursday night at Reading. On Sunday night, he added a sac fly and a solo homer. In his last eight games, Thomas is batting .355 (11-for-31) with two homers, three doubles, a triple and 11 RBIs. For the season, he leads the Flying Squirrels with 38 RBIs. Thomas has a hit in each of his last eight games dating back to June 24.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Since his promotion to Double-A on June 13, Logan Wyatt is batting .289 (11-for-38) with three homers, two doubles and eight RBIs. Between his time with High-A Eugene and with Richmond, Wyatt has homered 11 times this season in 65 games. Wyatt hit his first Double-A homer on June 23 at The Diamond against the Senators. He hit his second Double-A home run last Thursday night at Reading and finished the game with four RBIs, which tied his career high. Wyatt added another homer, a solo shot, in a two-RBI performance last Friday. He has driven in six runs over his last four starts.

RAGIN' CANTRELLE: In his last 16 games since June 14, Hayden Cantrelle has reached base 26 times, posting a .433 on-base percentage. In that stretch, he has picked up 13 hits, walked 11 times and been hit by a pitch twice in 60 plate appearances. This season, he has been hit by a pitch 13 times, the most in the Eastern League. Cantrelle also ranks fifth in the league in on-base percentage (.395) and tied for sixth in walks (46). He is second among Giants minor leaguers in walks for the year. On Monday at Reading, he hit his third home run of the season. Cantrelle is currently riding a six-game hitting streak.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 2), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 6), OF Vaun Brown (No. 8), RHP Mason Black (No. 9), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 14), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15), OF Wade Meckler (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 27) and RHP José Cruz (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect ist includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
