FROM THE CROWS NEST

BRING OUT THE BROOMS: Bradenton goes for their second six-game sweep of the season on Sunday afternoon. Ironically, Bradenton swept the Mets back in May at LECOM Park as a part of their franchise-record 11-game winning streak. Last season, Bradenton swept the Palm Beach Cardinals in a five-game series after weather forced one of the games to be canceled. Their last six-game sweep came back in July of 2022 when the Marauders won all six in Lakeland.

TOP OF THE TABLE: Bradenton's pitching staff has found their form once again in St. Lucie. Through the first five games, Bradenton has allowed just nine earned runs in 45.0 innings which is good for a 1.80 ERA, the best in the Florida State League and fourth-best in Single-A.

CURSE REVERSED: With a win on Friday night, the Bradenton Marauders clinched their first road series victory of the season. Bradenton had split a pair of road trips in June in Clearwater and Dunedin. Their previous road series victory came in their last in the 2023 season when they won four out of six in Fort Myers.

GRAND SALAMI: C Derek Berg's first professional home run came on an inside-the-park grand slam on Thursday night in Port St. Lucie. For the Marauders, it's their second inside-the-park grand slam this year, with the other coming from **Esmerlyn Valdez** against the Mets at LECOM Park on May 10. Bradenton has five grand slams this year, which is the second-most in Single-A and tied for the 10th-most in all of Minor League Baseball.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: Since their promotions from the FCL Pirates last week, both INF Jhonny Severino and INF Yordany De Los Santos have held their own. Severino and De Los Santos have reached base in all eight games they've played in. Severino's best game of the season came on Thursday night, when he went 4-for-5 with two triples, a walk, and three runs. The four hits tied his career-high, last accomplishing the feat on 7/2/22 when he was a member of the DSL Brewers. The four-hits are also the most by a Marauder batter in a single-game this year.

CUE LAZY MARY: On Sunday, the Bradenton Marauders wrap up their lone trip of the season to Clover Park. Last year, Bradenton won five out of the six games in St. Lucie and have won 14-straight overall meetings against the Mets after they won all six at LECOM Park against them in May. Bradenton has dominated the all-time series, leading 105-79.

AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: The Marauders hold three of the top eight home run leaders in the Florida State League, with Esmerlyn Valdez leading the way in second with 17 longballs. Avial Plaz is currently in third with 15 and Shalin Polanco is tied for eighth with 10. Valdez is one just HR shy of tying league leader in Ariel Almonte (Daytona). The 17 HR hit by a Valdez are the second-most by a Marauder since the Florida State League was moved from High-A to Low-A. Rodolfo Nolasco hit 20 bombs last year for Bradenton to lead the way.

LOST AT SEA: The Marauders have won the first five games in St. Lucie and are have tied their season-high road winning streak (5). The Marauders won five-straight road games from June June 15 - June 28. The .302 win percentage on the road is the worst in Minor League Baseball this season. Bradenton dropped their first nine road games to the start the year as well.

BOMBS AWAY: Since May 1st, the Bradenton Marauders have clubbed 84 home runs in 85 games which is the most by any team in Single-A. Bradenton led Single-A with 31 longballs in the month of June and were just three shy of tying their franchise record. In July, Bradenton racked up 26 in 22 games with Axiel Plaz and Esmerlyn Valdez accounting for 12 of the 26. The 26 home runs were the third-most in Single-A in July, trailing the Inland Empire 66 ers who had 29.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Sunday afternoons loss to the Cardinals marked the Marauders' 37th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 18-19 record in those games. Bradenton has lost their last four one-run games.
