YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Portland Sea Dogs, 5-2, at The Diamond. Portland tied the game, 2-2, in the top of the eighth inning with a run scoring on a passed ball. The Sea Dogs moved ahead, 5-2, in the top of the ninth with RBI singles by Kole Cottam and Elih Marrero and another passed ball. The Flying Squirrels opened the scoring in the first inning with a two-run homer by **Diego Rincones**. Portland moved the score to 2-1 in the fifth with a bases-loaded walk by Marrero. Richmond starter **Kyle Harrison** struck out nine batters over five innings, matching a Double-A high.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. This series is the first between the two teams since 2019. That year, the Flying Squirrels won two in a three-game set at Hadlock Field from June 4-6 before being swept in a three-game set at The Diamond from July 30-August 1. This year, the Flying Squirrels and Sea Dogs will also face each other in a six-game series in Portland from August 9-14. Richmond 2-5 in games against teams from the Northeast Division this year.

PLAYOFF HUNT: Richmond is tied for first place in the Southwest Division, even with Akron and one game ahead of Erie. The Flying Squirrels hold the tiebreaker against both teams with a winning head-to-head record. Five games remain before the Eastern League's first half closes on Sunday. The first-half and second-half division champions will meet in a best-of-three series in the Eastern League Postseason, followed by a best-of-three championship series.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won 14-of-20 games since May 29 after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they won four-of-six on the road against Harrisburg, maintaining first place in the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost three and split one this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 71 strikeouts and 57 HBPs. They are second with 83 homers. Richmond pitchers lead the league with 274 walks issued. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 1.41 ERA (10 ER/64.0 IP) over the last 19 games since May 31. The Flying Squirrels are 19-12 at home this year, which is tied for third-best in the Eastern League.

THE SEA DOGS have won four-of-six after losing their previous seven games from June 7-14. Portland is 6-16 since May 27. The Sea Dogs are 8-5 against the Southwest Division this season, having faced Harrisburg in two sets prior to this week. Portland's roster includes four of MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including LHP Chris Murphy (10), LHP Jay Groome (11), SS Christian Koss (26) and OF/INF Cedanne Rafaela (27).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Jake Dahlberg** makes his 12th start of the season. He last pitched on Thursday at Harrisburg and allowed two runs in five innings in a loss. Dahlberg spent parts of three seasons with the independent Chicago Dogs before signing with the Giants during the 2021 season. He joined the High-A Eugene Emeralds in July and made 10 starts, going 2-5 with a 6.60 ERA. He closed the year with two outings with Triple-A Sacramento and tossed 9.0 scoreless innings. After being named Horizon League Pitcher of the Year twice at the University of Illinois-Chicago, he was selected in the 21st round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. **For more on Dahlberg, see page two.**

FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Brian Van Belle makes his second Double-A start. He made his Double-A debut last Thursday at Reading and allowed three runs in five innings in a loss. Van Belle signed with the Red Sox as a free agent out of the University of Miami in 2020, where he was the Friday starter for the Hurricanes in his redshirt senior year in the shortened 2020 season. Last year, he spent his pro-debut season with High-A Greenville, going 4-3 with a 4.10 ERA in 18 starts. He returned to the Drive to open this season, making 12 appearances with a 3-2 record and a 6.14 ERA. He was promoted to Double-A Portland on June 14.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,011) and are second in total attendance (186,338). Richmond is 12th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 83 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (84). **Sean Roby** is tied for second in the league with 16 homers on the season, with 13 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 179 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in 2010 (71), 2012 (76), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61) and tied with 2011 and 2016.

A LITTLE RELIEF: The Richmond bullpen has posted a 1.41 ERA (10 ER/64.0 IP) over the last 19 games since May 31. In that stretch, **Blake Rivera** has made four scoreless outings with 8.0 scoreless innings. **John Russell** has worked four straight scoreless outings in that span, totaling 4.2 innings. **Chris Wright**, **R.J. Dabovich** and **Cole Waites** have combined to convert five of the team's seven save opportunities in that stretch.

GO, DIEGO, GO! After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .421 (16-for-38) with three doubles, four homers and 13 RBIs over his last 10 games since June 7. He started the stretch with two doubles on June 7 against the SeaWolves and hit his first homer of the season the next day. He collected a season-high three hits in the series finale against the SeaWolves on June 12, capping the game with a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning. It was his second walk-off hit as a member of the Flying Squirrels. He has hit a home run in three consecutive games played, going deep on Friday and Saturday at Harrisburg and again on Tuesday against the Sea Dogs.

HOMER STREAKING: **Diego Rincones** has homered in his last three games, the third time in his Richmond career he has compiled a three-game homer streak, which is the most in team history. He also hit homers in three consecutive games from July 17-20, 2021 and August 21-24, 2021. No player in team history has homered in four straight games. The only other player with multiple three-game homer streaks is **Sean Roby**, who did it in April and again earlier this month. Other three-game homer streaks for the Flying Squirrels were accomplished by **Charlie Culberson** (2011), **Jarrett Parker** (2013), **Adam Duvall** (2013), **K.C. Hobson** (2017) and **Gio Brusa** (2019).

SHANE TRAIN: Since May 1, **Shane Matheny** is batting .314 (32-for-102) with six homers, four doubles, a triple and 19 RBIs. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season, even with a 13-game streak for Portland's Pedro Castellanos from May 6-22. He was placed on the 7-day IL on May 29 and reinstated on June 7. In his return, he picked up a pair of RBI singles. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season.

TOASTY: **Frankie Tostado** went hitless over his five-game stretch from June 9-15, going 0-for-19 in that span with six strikeouts before picking up four hits over his last four games since Thursday. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked sixth in batting average (.294) and fifth hits (65).

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** hit his 16th homer of the season on June 10 against Erie, his third straight game with a homer. He is tied for second in the EL in home runs this year, trailing Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 13 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. With two homers on May 29 against Hartford, he set a new Flying Squirrels record with his third multi-homer game of the season. Roby hit eight homers over a 15-game stretch from April 10-29. He had hit just one homer over a 16-game stretch from April 30-May 25 prior to knocking seven in his last 12 games from May 26-June 10. He has not homered in his last eight games.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked sixth in batting average (.294) and fifth hits (65). **Sean Roby** is tied second in home runs (16). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for seventh in stolen bases (15). **Ryan Walker** is tied for first in wins (6) and **Bryan Brickhouse** is tied for third in wins (5). **Chris Wright** is tied for fifth in saves (6).

WHERE THE SEA DOGS RANK: In the Eastern League, Pedro Castellanos is ninth in batting average (.282), tied for fifth in RBIs (42), fourth in hits (66), tied for fourth in doubles (17) tied for seventh in extra-base hits (26) and tied for fifth in total bases (109). David Hamilton is first in triples (6) and is first in stolen bases (25). Devlin Granberg and Christian Koss are tied for second in triples (4). Chase Shugart is tied for fifth in games pitched (22).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Ricardo Genovés** (24) and **Chris Wright** (27). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (16), **Brett Auerbach** (27), Genovés (29) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
