Leading Off

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is the third of 18 matchups between the teams this season, with nine at each location. Reading won the season-series over Somerset in 2023 10-8, which included a 2-4 record at home and 8-4 on the road. Robinson Pina gets the start for Reading today, opposite Trystan Vrieling for Somerset.

A Winning Streak

Reading continued its hot week with a 4-3 win on Wednesday. It marked the Fightin Phils third-straight win and fourth in five games. Gabriel Rincones Jr. and Jose Rodriguez each homered in the win. Both teams had plenty of opportunities, leaving 14 runners on base per side. That figure is the highest left aboard for Reading, and its opponents, this season. Reading's three wins in a row is its longest streak since four-straight from Sept. 5-8 last season.

Closer Tandem

Max Lazar and Tommy McCollum have established themselves as the early closers for Reading this season. Lazar leads the team with three saves and McCollum picked up his second on Wednesday. Reading as a team is 5/6 in save opportunities this year. Lazar has now allowed an earned run or walk thus far in 2024.

Rincones Rolling

Gabriel Rincones Jr. stayed hot Wednesday with two hits and a homer. He is on a 13-game on-base streak and has been impressive as of late. Since April 10, he is slashing .342/.405/.579, with a .984 OPS. He also has three doubles, two homers, three RBI and nine runs scored over that span.

Carson on a "Tear"lor

Carson Taylor's scorching-hot start to the season continued on Tuesday night, with two hits, including a triple, and two RBI. His .375 average is tied for the best in the Eastern League. His 16 RBI lead the league and also rank second in all of Double-A. He is additionally hitting .314 with two outs and .643 (9-14) with RISP, which is the best in the Eastern League second in Double-A and third in all of Minor League Baseball. With RISP, Taylor also has: 3 HR (5 XBH) and 15 RBI. On Wednesday, Taylor stole two bases, which was both a season and career-high for him.

Swiper Yes Swiping

On Wednesday, Reading stole a season-high five bases. Which included two from Carson Taylor, and one each from Gabriel Rincones Jr., Robert Moore and Trevor Schwicke. Reading's 24 stolen bases this season ranks third in the Eastern League. This comes after Reading finished 10th in the league last season in stolen bases. The Fightin Phils also executed their first double steal since May 25, 2023, which was with Johan Rojas and Matt Kroon.

Magic Number

Wednesday marked the first time this season when Reading won a game scoring less than five runs. Five runs is appearing to be the magic number in runs scored for the Fightin Phils this season. So far, Reading is 7-1 when scoring north of five runs in a game this season, while the Fightin Phils are 1-8 when failing to hit the five-run plateau.

This Day in Baseballtown History

April 25, 1967: At Williamsport, 40-year old Robin Roberts starts his comeback attempt with the Reading Phillies with a 1-0 loss to the Mets. Roberts allows eight singles, four of them infield hits, and strikes out nine, claiming after the game, "I was satisfied." The Phillies leave 11 men on base in absorbing their first loss.

Somerset Synopsis

Somerset enters today with a 7-10 record, after going 3-3 vs Hartford last week. After this week, the Patriots host New Hampshire. Somerset finished 84-53 last season and ultimately lost to Binghamton in the Eastern League Semifinals. Nine of the Yankees' top-30 prospects are on Somerset's roster, featuring: Spencer Jones (2), Chase Hampton (4), Brock Selvidge (10), Ben Rice (12), Agustin Ramirez (21), Zach Messinger (22), Trystan Vrieling (23), Jack Neely (25), Tyler Hardman (26) and Danny Watson (28).

Patriots Pitcher

Righty, and Yankees No. 23 Prospect, Trystan Vrieling, makes the start tonight for Somerset. Vrieling was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week this past Monday. Last Friday against Hartford he had a no-decision with a line of: 7.2 IP, 0 H, 0 ER, 2 BB, 6 SO. Tonight is his fourth start of the season, and so far he is 2-0, with 0.48 ERA. Vrieling has tossed 18.2 innings, allowed just five hits, one-earned run, six walks and 18 strikeouts. He has a 0.59 WHIP and .082 average against. This season is his professional debut as he did not pitch in 2022 or '23 as he came back from injury. The Yankees selected him in the third round of the 2022 draft out of Gonzaga. Over his career at Gonzaga, he went 5-7, with a 4.31 ERA over 42 games and 17 starts. He was named WCC All-Conference Honorable Mention in 2021.

2024 Notes: On Fightin Phils Opening Day roster. Made first start Apr. 7 at Bowie. Allowed just two-earned runs over five innings, but did not record any strikeouts or walks. Picked up season-best to date seven punchouts Apr. 13 vs Portland, but suffered loss as he gave up five-earned runs over just three innings pitched. Was efficient, throwing 40-of-63 pitches for strikes in loss. Twirled best start of season Apr. 19 at BNG. Matched season-high with five innings and set new-season best with nine strikeouts in the win.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Signed by Los Angeles Angels as International Free Agent on February 15, 2017. Elected free agency on November 6, 2023. Signed by Philadelphia Phillies to Minor League contract on December 11, 2023.

2023: Split season between three levels in Angels system. Began season with High-A Tri-City Dust Devils. Boasted impressive 0.79 ERA and 14.3 strikeouts per nine innings with Tri-City. Promoted to Triple-A Salt Lake Bees on May 12. Spent two weeks with Salt Lake before being assigned to Double-A Rocket City Trash Pandas. Made 19 appearances (7 starts) with Rocket City and had 3.29 ERA. Struck out 58 hitters across 68 innings. Returned to Triple-A Salt Lake on Sept. 1 to close out season.
