The Final Countdown (of the first half)

The Fightin Phils continue the final week of the first half with game two of a six-game series at the New Hampshire Fisher Cats on Wednesday night. It is the second-of-18 matchups between the teams this season, and second-of-12 at New Hampshire. Reading goes back to New Hampshire from July 23-28, and the Fisher Cats come to Reading from Aug. 13-18. New Hampshire won the 2023 season series over Reading 17-7, and leads 1-0 in this season's series.

Falling in the First Game

The Fightin Phils dropped the opener of the series at New Hampshire 6-5 on Tuesday night. Marcus Lee Sang hit a two-run homer and Robert Moore had two hits and drove in two runs. Trevor Schwecke had a RBI double in his first game back in New Hampshire since playing there last season. Lachlan Wells took the loss, while matching a season-high six innings. He allowed 10 hits, which are tied for the most hits allowed by a Reading pitcher in a game this season. Wells also allowed three home runs which is the second time a Reading pitcher allowed three homers in a game this season, with the other coming from Robinson Pina on Apr. 13 against Portland.

Road Woes

The Fightin Phils have played vastly better defense at home than on the road this season. At home, Reading owns a 21-15 record, which is compared to just 7-21 on the road. Additionally, the Fightin Phils are hitting .261 at home, while averaging 5.6 runs per game at home. On the road, the R-Phils are hitting .209 and average 3.7 runs per game away from home. Reading has 31 more home runs at home, and 47 more extra-base hits at home, compared to on the road.

Simmons Gettin' On Base

Kendall Simmons is currently riding a 19-game on-base streak dating back to May 21. Over that streak, he's slashing .292/.410/.600, with a 1.010 OPS. He's added 13 runs, three doubles, one triple, five homers and 15 RBI over that stretch. Simmons 19-game on-base streak is currently the longest active streak in the Eastern League, and tied for the fifth-longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. If Simmons can get to a 20-game on-base streak he will be the first R-Phil to reach that mark since Carlos De La Cruz (38; 5/12-6-25) and Oliver Dunn (22; 5/26-6/23) did it last season.

Bombs Away

The Fightin Phils have been hitting home runs at a much-higher clip as of late. After hitting a home run Tuesday, Reading has homered in 12-of-13 games, and five in a row. Prior to that, Reading hit home runs in seven-straight games, prior to that being snapped briefly. Additionally, the Fightin Phils are now second in the Eastern League with 65 home runs hit this season. In June, Reading has hit 23 home runs, which is best in the Eastern League this month. Binghamton is in second place with 21. The Fightin Phils 23 home runs in June also lead all of Double-A for the month.

Packing The House

Last week, 45,601 fans attended the six games at FirstEnergy Stadium, which was an average of 7,600 fans per game. It was both the highest average and total in over five years, and since the schedule shifted to the six-game series format. It was also the highest mark in the Eastern League and all of Double-A. Out of the 60 Minor League teams that were home last week, Reading also had the fifth highest total and average attendance.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 19, 2013: At Reading, the Fightin Phils storm back from an early 8-2 hole to stun Portland, 9-8. While Chase Utley's rehab is the big pre-game story, Jim Murphy steals the show by going 4-for-4 with two homers, a walk, four RBIs and three runs scored. Reading plates the tying run on a wild pitch in the 9th, then wins it in the 10th on Tyson Gillies' run-scoring single.

Scouting the Fisher Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight in fifth place place in the Eastern League's Northeast Divison with a 28-36 record. New Hampshire most recently dropped four-of-six at home against the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Following this week, New Hampshire heads to Hartford to take on the Yard Goats. New Hampshire's roster features five players ranked amongst the Toronto Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Adam Macko (9), Josh Kasevich (11), CJ Van Eyk (17), Alex De Jesus (23) and TJ Brock (29).

On the Mound for New Hampshire

Lefty, and Blue Jays, number-nine propsect, Adam Macko makes the start tonight for New Hampshire. This season, Macko is 4-2, with a 3.69 ERA over 12 starts. He's pitched 61 innings, allowed 48 hits, 21 walks and 74 strikeouts. Macko last pitched June 13 against Richmond and took no-decision. Over six innings, he allowed three runs on six hits, with two walks and three strikeouts. Macko had a stretch of three-straight wins from May 15-26, and won four-of-five outings. Macko spent last season with High-A Vancouver, going 5-5, with a 4.81 ERA over 20 starts. Macko was traded from the Seattle Mariners to Toronto Blue Jays, along with pitcher Erik Swanson for Teoscar Hernandez on November 11, 2023. The Blue Jays added him to the 40-man roster in November of 2023, but he has yet to make his big-league debut. The 23-year old was drafted in the seventh round by Seattle in 2019 out of Vauxhall High School in Alberta, Canada.
