NOTES AND NUGGETS SEASON 56

Omaha began the 56th season in franchise history March 28 against the I-Cubs at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa ... this is the 14th season in the Storm Chasers era.
The Chasers are coming off a 2024 campaign where they went 89-59 (.601 winning percentage) to finish 1st in the 20-team International League in the regular season, before winning the International League Championship Series.

WHAT A RELIEF!

- Relievers stepped up lately for Omaha, including 3 bullpen games last week.
- Since last Wednesday, relief innings accounted for 42.1 of the 56.2 innings, approximately 75% of the team's total innings.
- 14.1 innings from Omaha's starting pitchers across the last 6 games are the fewest of any MiLB team in the last week (since April 16).
- When accounting for the 2 relief pitchers that "opened" games last week, Omaha's bullpen arms got 106 of the team's 135 outs last week (79%).

LEAN WITH IT, WALK WITH IT

- Omaha's 104 walks are 3rd in the International League league and the 14th-most in Minor League Baseball.
- Through 21 games, the Chasers are averaging 4.95 walks per game, and are on pace to draw 738 walks ... the franchise record is 671 walks drawn in the 2023 season and they have drawn more than 600 walks just twice.
- Nick Loftin is responsible for nearly 1/4 of Omaha's walks ... the 25 walks Loftin has drawn are the 2nd-most of any Minor Leaguer and lead all Triple-A hitters.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Storm Chasers overcame a deficit to win last Friday's game (10-8 vs. Norfolk), Omaha's 8th time this year winning a game in which the team trailed at some point ... this means 8 of the team's 10 wins can be considered "comeback" wins.
- Omaha trailed for at least one inning in all 3 of last week's wins over Norfolk ... twice, the Chasers came back in the 8th inning to beat the Tides ... twice, they trailed by 4 or more runs ... twice, they trailed for over 5 innings.
- In Friday's win, Omaha trailed from the 1st until taking a lead in the bottom of the 6th ... the Chasers faced a 4-run deficit from the top of the 4th into the 6th.
- In 4 of Omaha's 8 comeback wins this year, the team has trailed for at least 4 innings ... twice last week, Omaha has found itself behind Norfolk for over 5 innings, but still come out on top.

SO HE WALKS A LOT ... HE GETS ON BASE A LOT!

- Infielder Nick Loftin has been an on-base machine for Omaha in 2025.
- Loftin is 2nd in Minor League Baseball with 25 walks ... he is 2nd in the International League and 3rd in Triple-A with a .485 on-base percentage.
- Loftin has drawn a walk in 17 of 21 games ... he has multiple walks in 6 games, including 3-walk games last Thursday and Friday.
- Beyond the walks, Loftin has consistently reached base for Omaha, he reached base at least once in his first 20 games this year ... 20 games is tied for the longest on-base streak in the Minor Leagues, with Louisville's Tyler Callihan, who also reached base in his first 20 games he's played this year.
- For the first time this season, Loftin did not reach base yesterday ... he was 0-for-5 at the plate against Toledo, putting the ball in play every plate appearance.

GET TO KNOW THIS FEELIN' THAT'S SO STRONG ... LEAD ON

- Outfielder John Rave has been Omaha's leadoff hitter since mid-April 2024 and has started 2025 as one of the top leadoff hitters in the Minors.
- Rave has hit leadoff in 18 of Omaha's 21 games this year, and he's gotten on base to begin 7 games, including 5 hits to open the first inning ... his 2 leadoff home runs are tied for the most in the Minor Leagues, while 5 hits are tied 4th.
- He is tied 4th in the Minor Leagues with 18 total bases to lead off innings, while 9 hits are tied 9th ... he's slashing .310/.375/.621 leading off innings.
- Omaha's .294 average and .865 OPS as a team leading off innings lead the league.

WELCOME HOME WIEMER

- Storm Chasers outfielder Joey Wiemer returns to Toledo this week to play in his hometown for just the second time in his professional career.
- Born in Sylvania, Ohio (20 minutes Northwest of Toledo), Wiemer attended Bedford Senior High School in Temperance, Michigan (20 minutes North of Toledo) ... he also played four years of football and two years of basketball at Bedford, was named all-state, all-region and all-district in baseball.
- The only other time Wiemer has played in Toledo as a professional was at the start of last season ... in 2024, the Nashville Sounds opened their season at Fifth Third Field from March 29 to 31, but Wiemer collected just one hit that weekend.

CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN SCOUTING REPORT

MLB Pipeline

Scouting grades: Fastball: 50 | Curveball: 50 | Slider: 50 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 50 | Overall: 40

A well-regarded high school pitching prospect, Champlain honored his Southern California commitment in 2018 and stayed close to home. Three years later, the Yankees selected him in the ninth round of the 2021 Draft and then traded him to the Royals as part of a three-pitcher package for Andrew Benintendi in 2022. Champlain returned to Double-A in '24 and showed he had mastered it with a 3.50 ERA, a 0.92 WHIP and a 34.5% strikeout rate in seven starts. The move to Triple-A was more challenging; Champlain made 28 appearances (27 starts) there for a 5.61 ERA, 15.5% strikeout rate and a 1.56 WHIP while batters hit .283 against him.

Champlain's average cutting fastball sits 91-94 mph, touching 97 in 2024. He spins the ball well and has improved his upper-70s curveball into a solid weapon. That pitch is different from his low- to mid-80s slider which has good depth and got some chase in '24 in a limited sample. Champlain also shows a cutter, which could be an out pitch eventually because of his natural movement, and his mid-80s changeup is still a work in progress, as it has been for several years. The lack of a pitch against lefties has hindered Champlain as he's faced better hitters. He has some effort in his delivery which affects his command at times, but he showed up to Spring Training over 10 pounds lighter.

Champlain has the look and mentality of a workhorse on the mound and has proven durable in the Minors, throwing 135 and 140 innings the past two seasons respectively. But he'll need to develop a weapon against lefties for him to reach his ceiling, otherwise there's thought he would have more in the tank as a multi-inning reliever with a fastball-curveball combination. He wasn't added to the 40-man when eligible for the Rule 5 Draft, but he'll return to Triple-A, be part of the Royals' depth and could make his debut in '25.

Track Record: Champlain was off to a good start in his return to Double-A in his second full year in the Royals organization since being acquired from the Yankees midway through 2022. In seven starts with Northwest Arkansas, the most noticeable statistic was an impressive 12 strikeouts per nine innings compared to just 1.8 walks. His promotion to Triple-A Omaha proved to be more challenging for Champlain. His strikeout rate decreased to 6.2 per nine innings, his walk rate rose to 4.0 and opponents hit .282 with 17 home runs in 104.1 innings.

Scouting Report: Champlain's four-seam fastball comes to the plate on a downward angle, sits 92-94 mph and touches 97—but he struggled to command it when he got to Triple-A. His 76-80 mph curveball improved enough in 2024 to be graded a plus pitch. At times it looked like one of the better benders in the minor leagues and misses plenty of bats in the zone with 12-to-6 shape and great finish. The slider is a distinct pitch from the curveball, averaging 85 mph with good depth. Champlain rounds out his repertoire with an 85 mph changeup and 86 mph cutter, both still in development. There's not a lot of athleticism in his delivery, making it more difficult to repeat and affecting his command.

The Future: Champlain projects as a big-bodied back-of-the-rotation starter, although his stuff would tick up in shorter stints if he moved to the bullpen. He was not added to the 40-man roster when eligible after the 2024 season.
