ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Mets No. 9 prospect RHP **Dominic Hamel** struck out six over six scoreless innings, while the offense struck for three runs in the top of the fifth to break a scoreless game, sending Brooklyn to a 5-1 triumph Friday night at The Dutch. INF **Shervyen Newton** homered and walked three times, while C **Nic Gaddis** lined a two-run single in the fifth inning. LHP **Nathan Lavender**, pitching for the second time since June 16th, earned a two-inning save, facing the minimum. The series is even at two games apiece heading into Saturday night.

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU FINISH: The Cyclones have a 3.34 ERA in July, good for second-best in the circuit behind Rome (3.32 ERA) and third-best in High-A. However, the Cyclones have five blown saves, ranking as the most for a team in High-A with an ERA sub-3.50. In the month, Brooklyn starters have a 2.49 ERA (35 earned runs in 126.2 IP), while the bullpen has a 4.95 ERA (37 ER in 67.1 IP).

SCHWARTZ SWATTING: 1B **JT Schwartz** has two singles, three doubles, and a grand slam over the first four games of this series with the Renegades, going 6-16 (.375). The Mets' No. 19 prospect has hit two of his four home runs against Hudson Valley.

STEPPING UP IN SUBWAY SET: Last night, INF **Shervyen Newton** drilled his third home run against Hudson Valley this season and fourth with Brooklyn. 1B **JT Schwartz** has hit five of his 18 doubles against Hudson Valley and two of his four home runs, and OF **Rowdey Jordan** had hit five of his 17 doubles against the 'Gades.

RA-RA FOR RAMIREZ: No. 4 Mets prospect OF **Alex Ramirez** went 1-3 last night and has hits in 16 of his past 33 at bats with six multi-hit games over his past nine games. In the span, Ramirez has a two doubles, two home runs, and 14 RBIs.

CON SWAGGER: OF **Stanley Consuegra** has been

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: The New York Yankees High-A farm club and the Cyclones have played 22 of 30 in the 2022 series. So far, the Renegades are 12-10. No. 3 prospect, and the No. 39 prospect in baseball, OF Jasson Dominguez has recently joined the team. The current Renegades roster hosts five of the Yankees Top 30s, including No. 6 SS Trey Sweeney, No. 8 RHP Yoendrys Gomez, No. 22 2B Cooper Bowman, and No. 28 LHP Edgar Barclay.

on a tear since the start of the Greensboro series on July 12. Over his past 13 games, Consuegra is hitting .340 with a 1.030 OPS. In the span, the 21-year-old outfielder has been on base in 11 of the 13 games and has four multi-hit efforts.

NIC KNOWS: After going 0-for-4 on Thursday night to snap a 13-game on-base streak, C/INF Nic Gaddis went 2-5 with two RBIs last night. Since June 21, the 2019 draftee has been on base in 24 of his past 27 games, posting a .421 OBP and a .873 OPS.

METS TRADE WATCH: Thursday night, the Mets made a deal with Cincinnati, bringing in OF Tyler Naquin and LHP Philip Diehl in exchange for two Low-A St. Lucie prospects 2B Hector Rodriguez and RHP Jose Acuna. The 2022 trade deadline is Tuesday, August 2 at 6 p.m. ET.

BOMBOSAS: Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 49 home runs in the past 60 games (0.82 HR/G) after just seven over the team's first 34 games (0.2 HR/G).

PROSPECT POP: Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offenisvely, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect.

ZWACKING DEAD: Zwack has posted a 1.52 ERA over his 13 appearances, including 12 starts. His 2.68 FIP is tied with Bowling Green's Mason Montgomery for the lowest in the South Atlantic League among qualified arms.

SWEET STRIKEOUT SUCCESS: Zwack tossed just 12 2/3 innings with Low-A St. Lucie, making two starts and two other relief appearances, striking out 24 batters. The southpaw's strikeout rate was 46% in the Florida State League with a 3.8% walk rate.

YEAR ONE: After his draft selection mid-summer in 2021, ! Zwack reported to Florida to pitch for the Complex team, making five relief appearances with 13 strikeouts and two walks over just seven total frames.

BIG EAST BEST: Zack earned Big East Conference First-Team accolades after his 2021 campaign for the Xavier Musketeers, tossing a team-high 80 innings. He finished his Xavier career with the 12th-most wins in team history (15) and the sixth-most strikeouts in school history (214).

X MARKS THE SPOT: Xavier has been involved with two Hall of Famers -- Frank Robinson who spent 21 years in the Major Leagues with Cincinnati, Baltimore, Los Angeles (NL), California, and Cleveland. Robinson enrolled in Xavier after his first MLB season. On the pitching side, Jim Bunning, who pitched 591 games in the big leagues, represents the most famous arm out of the small Cincinnati college.

MINNESOTA!: The left hails from Monticello, Minnesota where he played baseball, hockey, and was the quarterback on his high school football team. He is the only player from his high school -- Monticello High School - to ever play professional baseball.
