LAST GAME

The Baysox took down the Altoona Curve 4-0 on Friday night, firing the 12th no-hitter in franchise history. Right-handed starter Chayce McDermott carefully worked around a pair of walks in both the first and fourth inning, but was able to keep the Curve from doing any damage through five strong frames, striking out four. Offensivley, Billy Cook provided the spark with a two-run blast down the left field line to get the scoring started in the bottom of the second. The Baysox would add on two more runs in the fourth, as John Rhodes scored on a wild pitch after reaching on an infield single. Donta' Williams also walked in the frame and was plated on an RBI groundout by Bowie's Tim Susnara. Right-hander Nolan Hoffman entered in the sixth for Bowie and pitched two perfect frames with five strikeouts, before handing the ball to left-hander Easton Lucas to record the final six outs, with three strikeouts of his own, and polish off the no-hitter.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve enter tonight with a record of 17-18, Altoona currently sits fourth in the Southwest division standings - just two games out of first place. The Curve are coming off a series in which they lost four of six games to the Akron RubberDucks at home. Altoona took four of five games played against the Baysox last month at Peoples Natural Gas Field. The Curve are led by C Henry Davis, as the No. 3 Pirates prospect and No. 48 overall prospect (per MLB Pipeline) ranks top five in the Eastern League in OPS (1.094 - 1st), on-base percentage (.459 - 1st), slugging (.635 - 1st), batting average (.308 - 4th), home runs (9 - 3rd), and extra-base hits (15 - 5th). Davis' on-base percentage and OPS leads all of Double-A, while his slugging is second. Davis is one of six prospects in the MLB Pipeline Top 30 for the Pirates, alongside INF Liover Peguero (No. 6 PIT), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11 PIT), OF Matt Gorski (No. 16 PIT), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 19 PIT), and OF Matt Frazier (No. 22 PIT)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Altoona looks to start left-hander Braeden Ogle on the mound tonight. Ogle will be making his first start since the 2019 season, when he played for Advanced-A Bradenton. Thus far in 2023, Ogle has made 11 appearances, but they have only spanned 12 innings, where he has walked 14 batters and also yielded 11 hits, including four home runs. He threw a scoreless inning against the Baysox on April 18 in Altoona. Ogle re-signed with the Pirates this offseason as a minor league free agent. He was initially a fourth round pick of Pittsburgh in 2016, before being dealt to the Phillies' organization in July of 2021, in exchange for catching prospect Abrahan Gutierrez 4-seam fastball and a slider

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern Leauge with 53 htis and a .387 average - 70 points above the next highest qualified average Prieto has hit a scorching .426 in the month of May with a .462 on-base percentage. He has collected hits in 14 of his 15 games this month, and has 17 multi-hit games in his first 34 contests of 2023. The No. 17 O's prospect also ranks third in the league in on-base percentage (.429) and OPS (.984).

GETTING BACK TO WINNING WAYS

The Baysox are hoping to string together consecutive victories for the first time since the opening two games of the season. Bowie is the only team in the Eastern League yet to have a winning streak of at least three games yet this season. The Baysox are also the only team in the league to not win consecutive games at least three times in 2023 (Bowie has only done so once). Overall, the Baysox are 1-9, averaging just 2.8 runs per game, following a victory this season.

TANDEM TROUBLES

Bowie's abundance of starting pitching experience is leading to a statistical split based on when each pitcher enters the game. Bowie has had eight different pitchers start multiple games this season, and those pitchers sport a 3.35 ERA with 164 strikeouts in 145.2 innings when they start their respective games. When those same pitchers enter games as relievers, they sport a collective 7.02 ERA, with only 56 strikeouts in 59

HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kjerstad currently sits third in the Eastern League with nine home runs. Beyond the long ball, the Orioles' No. 5 prospect has also demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - sitting third in the Eastern League in average (.310), along with second in slugging percentage (.627) and OPS (1.019) among qualifiers, while also ranking second in extra-base hits (19) and total bases (79), and sitting tied for the league lead with three triples. Kjerstad is in the midst of a 22-game on-base streak - the longest streak in the Eastern League this season. He has reached base safely in 31 of his first 32 Double-A contests
