RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (16-12) Visalia Rawhide (13-16)





RHP Cam Day (1-1, 4.11 ERA) vs. RHP Roman Angelo (2-1, 3.60 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes continue a 12-game road trip with game four of a six-game series against the Visalia Rawhide (AZ) at Valley Strong Ballpark. At the completion of this six-game set, the Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, May 14, hosting the Inland Empire 66ers.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the fourth of 30 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the fourth of 15 at Valley Strong Ballpark. Last season, the Quakes went 17-13 against the Rawhide, 10-8 here at Valley Strong Ballpark. LAST GAME: The Rawhide jumped to a huge lead, then hung on for an 8-6 win over the Quakes on Thursday night at Valley Strong Ballpark. Rancho starter Jose Rodriguez (4-1) suffered his first defeat of the year, as he was charged with seven earned runs over 3.2 innings. Trailing 7-0 in the sixth, the Quakes benefitted from six consecutive walks issued by Visalia pitching, as well as a two-run single from Josue De Paula, making it a 7-5 game. The teams traded one more run down the stretch, with Visalia closer stranding the tying run in the on-deck circle to end the ninth and earn his second save of the year. Visalia starter Jacob Steinmetz (1-1) got the win with five scoreless innings.

BAD TIMING: Wednesday's win helped right the ship, but the Quakes are in the midst of their worst stretch of baseball in 2024, as they've dropped seven of their last nine, all on this current road trip. Injuries to key players have played a huge role, as Joe Vetrano, Josue De Paula and Zyhir Hope have all missed time on the current trip. De Paula was activated during the Modesto series and Vetrano made his return to the lineup on Wednesday. Hope is still on the Injured List with a shoulder injury. Logan Wagner has not played in a game since May 1, but is also not on the Injured List, after suffering several "hit-by-pitches" to the same area of his right leg. Wagner will return to the lineup today. "AIR" JORDAN: Jordan Thompson was a bright spot in Tuesday's loss to the Rawhide, finishing with three hits, including a pair of home runs. Thompson became the second Quake this year to record a multi-homer game, joining Jeral Perez who slugged a pair on April 20 at Inland Empire. Thompson has three homers in his last two games and has taken over the team lead with five round-trippers on the year and is now the "active" team leader with 15 RBIs. Jake Gelof, who was promoted to Great Lakes on Tuesday, leads the club overall with 26 RBIs, second in the league.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes made a total of three moves on Wednesday, as 1B Joe Vetrano was activated from the Injured List. RHP Carlos Duran was placed on the Development List in order to make room for Vetrano, who's been out since April 25 with a right shoulder injury. In addition, RHP Edgardo Henriquez was promoted to High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League. On Tuesday, 3B Jake Gelof was promoted to Great Lakes. Gelof was spectacular to start the year, leading the team in several offensive categories. Taking his spot on the roster was infielder Oswaldo Ozorio, who opened the year on the Rancho roster, but was sent to Arizona just a few days into the season.

CAM DAY: Cam Day will make his third start and sixth appearance of the year, his first start against Visalia. In his last outing, he allowed one hit over two scoreless innings in a no-decision, finishing off a 4-0 win in game one of a double-header over Modesto on May 5. Day signed as an undrafted free agent with the Dodgers, after playing collegiately at the University of Utah.

ROMAN ANGELO: Right-hander Roman Angelo makes his sixth appearance and fifth start, his first against the Quakes. In his last outing overall, he allowed four runs on seven hits over 5.1 innings in a win at Stockton on May 3. Angelo was signed as an undrafted free agent in July of 2023 after playing college-ball at Fresno State University. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2024 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog. from the ease of your phone, smart device or computer.
