DÍAZ, LEBLANC POWER SHRIMP TO 9-1 WIN

Lewin Díaz and Charles Leblanc powered the Jumbo Shrimp to a 9-1 win Wednesday against the Gwinnett Stripers. Brian Miller and Peyton Burdick reached base to start the bottom of the first and Díaz blasted a three-run home run. Charles Leblanc hit a two-rum home run four batters later to increase the lead to 5-0. He followed with a three-run home run in the fifth inning and finished a perfect 4-for-4 with five RBIs. Braxton Garrett tossed seven strong innings, earning him a victory and the first quality start from a Jumbo Shrimp pitcher this season.

HIGH FIVE!

Jacksonville has won five consecutive games, their longest winning streak in an April since April 24-28, 2019, when they won five contests in a row. During their current fivegame winning streak, the Jumbo Shrimp are outscoring their opponents 40-10 with a 56-18 advantage in hits and a 10-1 margin in home runs. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp currently rank fourth out of 120 Minor League Baseball teams in hits, tied for fifth in runs and tied for fifth in home runs over this span.

THE ARM BARN

Before their recent scoreless innings streak, the Jacksonville bullpen allowed at least one earned run in seven of the first 15 games. As of late, though, the bullpen has been outstanding during the club's current five-game winning streak. During this run, the Jacksonville bullpen has ceded just four runs, all earned, on 10 hits in 22.1 innings for a 1.61 ERA (28 K, 10 BB), including a current 14.1 scoreless inning streak. Seven pitchers in the bullpen have tossed at least one inning without allowing a run and all have at least one stikeout during this span.

The Jumbo Shrimp rank in a tie for third in the International League in runs (86; 6.1 per game), and the biggest indication as to why has been the club's strong performance with runners on base. With the bases empty, Jacksonville is hitting .256/.348/.410, producing a .748 OPS that ranks seventh in the 20-team league. However, with runners on base, the club's batting line has surged to .282/.355/.500, with the resulting .855 OPS placing third in the circuit.

CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE

Charles Leblanc bashed two home runs on Wednesday in Jacksonville's 9-1 victory over Gwinnett. The effort marked the third multi-home run game of his career, with Leblanc's five RBIs being one off a career-high. On the season, the native of Laval, QC in Canada leads the International League in OPS (1.283) while ranking second in OBP (.477) and slugging (.806), third in average (.389) and tied for fifth in home runs (4).

LEWIN AND CLARK BURDICK

Both Lewin Díaz and Peyton Burdick have gotten off to a strong starts to the season. Díaz is 15-for-49 to begin the campaign, slashing .306/.397/.551/.948 with three doubles, three home runs, 14 RBIs and 10 runs scored. Meanwhile, Burdick, the Marlins' reigning Minor League Player of the Year, is 11-for-43, slashing .256/.407/.488/.895 with a double, three homers, six RBIs and a league-leading 16 runs. Thus, of the 86 runs the Jumbo Shrimp have scored this season - a figure that ranks tied for third in the International League - the pair have accounted for 40 of those tallies (not double-counting the run scored and RBI from home runs by the pair), a ratio of 46.5 percent.

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 20 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking tied for third in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast of late; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

Through the season's first 10 games, Jacksonville starting pitchers ceded at least four runs on six different outings, posting a collective 7.85 ERA in the process. During this four-game run, the club's lid-lifters have registered 15 strikeouts against 12 hits and six walks.

ABOUT JEFF

-A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2022, he has already totaled 19 minor league starts in 36 career games, collecting an 8-10 record and 3.28 ERA.

-Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

-An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

2021 SEASON

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.

-Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).

-When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

2019 SEASON

-With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.
