#### FROM THE CROW'S NEST

LAST TIME OUT: The Marauders were unable to hold a one-run lead in the middle innings in Wednesday's 4-2 loss to the Cardinals... Valentin Linarez held Palm Beach to one unearned run across five innings, striking out six and walking none (no-decision)... Juan Jerez tied the score, 1-1, in the fourth inning on an RBI-single, and Jase Bowen plated the go-ahead run in the fifth on an RBI-single... The Cardinals loaded the bases against reliever **Wilkin Ramos** in the sixth and got a sun-aided, go-ahead two-run double from Wade Stauss that proved to be the winning hit... The Marauders collected 10 hits and stole three bases in the game, but left 10 runners stranded and went 3-for-13 with RISP.

THE OPPONENT: The Cardinals were swept in their six-game series at Fort Myers last week but have taken the first two games in the current series with the Marauders... Palm Beach owns the worst record in the FSL at 13-22 and sits 12 games behind first-place St. Lucie in the East Division... The team's roster currently features four players in Baseball America's latest top 30 prospect rankings for the St. Louis Cardinals organization: OF Joshua Baez (#12), RHP Tink Hence (#14), RHP Edwin Nunez (#19), and RHP Zane Mills (#25).

WRONG WAY: The Marauders have lost seven of their last eight games and 11 of their last 14, dating back to May 3... The team held sole possession of first place in the West Division as recently as May 4, but has since fallen to third in the division and 6.5 games out of first place... Bradenton has struggled away from LECOM Park; the team has lost nine of its last ten road games and are 4-13 on the road this season.

<u>I THOUGHT YOU SAID "WEAST":</u> The Marauders are just 2-12 against FSL East Division teams this season, going 1-5 against both Daytona and Jupiter, and 0-2 so far against Palm Beach... Bradenton will face both Jupiter and Palm Beach once more later this summer, in July and August, respectively.

HASTE MAKES WASTE: After committing just 13 errors in their first 17 games, the Marauders have committed 27 errors in their last 18 games and now have the third-highest error total (40) in the FSL... The errors have led to 34 unearned runs on the season, most in the FSL... Additionally, Marauders catchers have allowed a combined eight passed balls, also secondmost in the league (Palm Beach leads with nine).

**TOP PIRATES PROSPECTS:** The Marauders roster currently includes one prospect in *Baseball America*'s Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: outfielder Rodolfo Nolasco (#28)... Baseball America lists the Pirates' farm system as the thirdbest in baseball

FIELD STAFF: Manager Jonathan Johnston, 2021 Low-A Southeast Manager of the Year, is in his second season at the helm for the Marauders... Former major leaguer Yorman Bazardo is the club's new pitching coach after spending 2021 as a pitching coach for the FCL Pirates... Former Pirate Mendy López joins as hitting coach after serving as the Pirates' Latin American Field Coordinator in 2021... Casey Harms is the Marauders' Integrated Baseball Performance Coach after a collegiate coaching career in the Northwoods League (Waterloo Bucks, 2019-20) and at UC Santa Barbara (2013-2018)... Gustavo Omaña is the Marauders' Development Coach after serving on staff at Triple-A Indianapolis in 2021

HITTING TRIPLE DIGITS: The 2022 season marks the 100th year of operation for LECOM Park, known as City Park upon opening in 1923. It has served as a spring training home for six different MLB franchises, including the Pirates since 1969. Baseball hall-of-famers who once called the historic park their spring home include Henry Aaron, Roberto Clemente, Dizzy Dean, Rogers Hornsby, Reggie Jackson, and more.
