SHRIMP SWEPT IN 11-2 LOSS TO RED WINGS

The Jumbo Shrimp were swept on Sunday in an 11-2 defeat to the Red Wings. Rochester opened up the scoring with a six-run third inning that featured a grand slam from **Abimelec Ortiz**. The Red Wings added three more runs in the fifth. **Gage Miller** collected an RBI single in the sixth, but in the bottom of the inning, Rochester scored twice to go up 11-1. In the ninth inning, **Kemp Alderman** notched an RBI single to set the final margin at 11-2. Jacksonville was outscored 24-9 during the three-game series. The Jumbo Shrimp were out-hit by a 31-21 margin.

TOUGH TIMES DON'T LAST, TOUGH TEAMS DO

Directly on the heels of winning 12 of 14 games, including seven of their previous eight, Jacksonville has dropped 10 of their last 11 contests. The Jumbo Shrimp's current six-game losing streak is the club's longest since getting broomed in a six-game set at Durham from April 29-May 4, 2025 - which is also the last time Jacksonville was swept until this past weekend in Western New York. The Jumbo Shrimp have suffered three straight series losses for the first time since dropping three consecutive sets from April 30-May 19, 2024. Jacksonville has not suffered four straight series losses since May 1-20, 2019, when they were still in Double-A.

ONE IS THE LONELIEST NUMBER

Jacksonville has lost 10 of their last 11 games heading into play on Tuesday. Of those 10 defeats, remarkably, seven have come by just one run. In comparison, the club had won 11 of their previous 14 one-run affairs prior to this rough stretch beginning on July 4. Over the last 11 games, the Jumbo Shrimp are 1-10 despite getting outscored by a margin of only 73-58.

GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT!

Jacksonville's pitching staff has recorded a whopping 951 strikeouts through 94 games, a rate of 10.1 per game. The Jumbo Shrimp have 54 more punchouts than Charlotte, the team that ranks second in Triple-A. Thus, the Knights' 897 strikeouts are as close to 10th-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (843) as they are to Jacksonville in first. In addition to the swings and misses, the Jumbo Shrimp have also shown an ability to limit hard contact; their 87.1 average exit velocity against is the second-best such figure in Triple-A.

OH GREAT STARTING PITCHING, WHERE ART THOU

Jacksonville ranks second in Triple-A in innings pitched by starting pitchers at 425.1. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have struggled to get length from their starting pitching of late. Just once has the club seen its lid-lifter toss at least 5.0 innings in the 12 games since July 2 (**Braxton Garrett**, 6.0 IP on July 8). Jacksonville starters have mustered only 39.2 innings pitched over the last 12 games (3.3 per game) with a 9.08 ERA (40 ER in 39.2 IP).

RISP-Y BUSINESS

The Jumbo Shrimp have dropped 10 of their last 11 contests, and a big culprit has been their lack of success hitting with runners in scoring position. Over the last 11 games, Jacksonville is just 23-for-112 (.205) at the plate with runners in scoring position. The Jumbo Shrimp have stranded 87 bases runners during their stretch, a rate of 7.9 per game. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .248/.343/.401/.744 with runners in scoring position, better than their .225/.323/.369/.692 line with the bases empty.

ETZEL DAY? WELL, I LIKE ETZEL DAY

Matthew Etzel got off to a very slow start to the season, hitting just .183/.256/.254/.510 over his first 20 games of the season. Over the last 54 contests, however, the Texas native is a scorching 55-for-196 at the plate, slashing a robust .281/.388/.505/.893 with 10 doubles, two triples, 10 home runs, 32 RBIs, 34 walks and 42 runs scored. Since this stretch began on May 3, Etzel ranks tied for seventh in the IL in runs, 16th in OBP, tied for 16th in walks, 17th in OPS, 22nd in slugging and tied for 22nd in home runs.

SHRIMP BITES

Gage Miller is hitting .354/.480/.608/1.088 (5 2B, 5 HR, 18 RBIs, 16 BB, 19 R) in 25 games with the Jumbo Shrimp... Jacksonville is seeking to avoid its first seven-game losing streak since an eight-game skid from May 9-17 of the 2024 season... **Kemp Alderman** is batting .318/.400/.500/.900 (3 2B, 3 HR, 14 RBIs, 8 BB, 14 R) over his last 18 games... The Jumbo Shrimp used eight pitchers in Sunday's series finale at Rochester. It was their most in a game since using 11 in the Triple-A National Championship last season, and their most in the regular season since utilizing nine on August 3, 2025 vs. Columbus.

ABOUT BRANDON

-White was originally selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 14th round of the 2018 draft out of W.F. West High School (Chehalis, Wash.). He opted to honor a commitment to play at Washington State University, where he appeared in 30 games, including 29 starts, over three seasons (8-12, 5.69 ERA, 131.1 IP, 153 H, 67 BB, 119 K). At Washington State, White was teammates with current Cleveland Guardians first baseman Kyle Manzardo.

-The Miami Marlins selected White in the 12th round of the 2021 draft, but did not appear in a professional game until 2023 while recovering from injuries. With his professional debut for the FCL Marlins on June 6, 2023, 693 days went by between when he was drafted and when he first stepped on a mound in professional baseball.

-White was a terrific basketball player at W.F. West High School, where he was coached by his dad, Chris. Brandon earned four letters and was a two-time All-Evergreen League forward. He was named to the All-State Tournament team as a senior after leading WFHS to a 24-5 record and second-place finish in the 2A tournament.
