NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.

- Of 17 series played this year, Omaha has won 6, lost 8 and split 3 ... the Chasers are on a season-high 4 game winning streak after a weekend sweep of Lehigh Valley and have won 5 of their last 6 games (since July 10) after going 2-7 over the previous 9 (July 2-9), dropping back-to-back series before the All-Star Break.
- Omaha went 13-12 in April ... with a 13-14 record in May and 10-15 in June, the Chasers had back-to-back losing months for the first time since June/July 2025.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Chasers have 26 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 28 losses this year.

- 26 comeback wins are tied for 3rd-most in the International League, tied 5th in Triple-A (Salt Lake's 33 comeback wins lead Triple-A, tied for the most among full-season Minor League teams) ... Omaha's 28 blown leads are the 3rd-most in the league, 5th in Triple-A.
- The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 16 of their last 27 losses, including 4 games where the team led for at least half the game and 2 losses where Omaha had a 6+ run lead at some point in the game.
- In the last 60 games (since May 9), Omaha is 27-33 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 19 of 28 wins and led at some point in 18 of 32 losses, meaning 37 of Omaha's last 60 games (62%) have had a lead change ... in this stretch, 39 of 60 games (65%) have been decided by 3 runs or less.

PITCH, PLEASE!

Storm Chasers starting pitchers have not consistently gotten deep into games this year, leaving the bullpen heavily relied upon.

- Omaha's starting pitchers have thrown 354.2 innings this season, the 5th-fewest among Triple-A clubs, while 7 wins from Chasers starting pitchers are the fewest in Triple-A ... 9 quality starts rank 12th-most in the 20-team IL.
- Storm Chasers relievers have had 44 save opportunities, 3rd-most among Triple-A clubs and tied for the 4th-most in the Minors ... the Chasers have only converted 21 saves, with 23 blown saves ranking tied for the 2nd-most in the Minors.

SUMMER HEAT

A pair of Storm Chasers bats have especially been performing well in recent weeks.

- Over his last 20 games (since June 21), **Brett Squires** is slashing .352/.407/.620 (25-for-71) with 15 RBI ... last week, he snapped an on-base streak of 17 straight games, tied for the longest on-base streak among Storm Chasers hitters this year ... Squires hit safely in a career-best 14 straight games (June 16 to July 2).
- Since his first game with Omaha on June 4, **Matthew Lugo** has hit .287 (37-for-129) with 8 home runs and 27 RBI in 33 games ... since his arrival, he is 4th in the International League in extra-base hits (20), tied 5th in doubles (11), tied 6th in home runs, 7th in total bases (74) and tied 7th in runs scored (26).

HONEST ABE

Abraham Toro started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May

- Since May 12, Toro has a .324 average (57-for-176) ... he ranks 1st in the IL in OPS (.994), 3rd in SLG (.602) and tied 6th in AVG (.324) ... his 42 RBI over 47 games since May 12 rank tied as the 6th-most in the league.
- From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 12, Toro has hits in 35 of 47 games, with 4+ hits in 3 games.

CROSS ME UP

Gavin Cross had one of the league's slowest start to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.

- Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) ... but in his last 48 games (since May 16), he's hitting .301 (52-for-173), with 15 XBH and 22 RBI, with 15 multi-hit games, including 5 of his last 9 games.
- Cross enters today on a season-best 12-game hitting streak since July 2 ... on the streak, he's hitting .340 (17-for-50) with 6 extra-base hits, 9 RBI and a .855 OPS.

TRANSACTION ACTION

The Storm Chasers have made a flurry of moves in July, including the last 24 hours.

- Today, INF **Jack Pineda** was transferred from Double-A Northwest Arkansas and is on the verge of his Triple-A debut ... former Nebraska Cornhusker LHP **Aaron Bummer** was signed as a free agent and assigned to Omaha today ... additionally, OF **Kyle Isbel** was transferred to Omaha for an MLB rehab assignment.
- The Chasers have made 37 roster moves this month, with 8 new players added to the team in the last 20 days.

TODAY'S APPEARANCE

- Henry Williams is making his **10th start** this year with the Storm Chasers, his **12th Triple-A appearance** and his **19th overall appearance** this season.
- Playing his **4th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- This is Williams' 1st career start against the Bees and his 3rd against the Angels and their affiliates ... he threw 8.0 scoreless innings against Single-A Inland Empire in 2023.

HENRY'S HUNCH

- FINDING HIS FOOTING:** Williams made his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers last season, but he made just 2 spot starts in the 1st half of the season ... he opened 2026 in Double-A, but since being promoted to Omaha on May 12, he has pitched in 10 games ... after posting an 8.59 ERA (14 ER in 14.2 IP) with 14 strikeouts (8.59 K/9) over his first 4 outings, Williams has worked a 6.21 ERA (23 ER in 33.1 IP) with 30 strikeouts (8.10 K/9) over his last 7 appearances.
- HOME RUN HURTING:** Much of the damage off Williams in Triple-A this year has come on the long ball, but he has limited home runs recently ... he allowed 9 home runs (all solo homers) in his first 5 starts and 20.2 innings, accounting for 50% (9 of 18) of the runs he allowed, but he has allowed just 2 home runs in his last 6 starts, accounting for just 10% (2 of 21) of the runs he has allowed.
- QUALITY CONTROL:** Williams is tied for the team lead in quality starts (3) ... he comes into today's game having fired consecutive quality starts, on July 5 vs. Indianapolis (PIT) and July 11 @ Louisville (CIN) ... he has a 4.50 ERA (6 ER in 12.0 IP) over 2 July starts, with 9 strikeouts.

LAST OUTING: SATURDAY, JULY 11 @ LOUISVILLE

- Made his 2nd straight quality start, 3rd with Omaha 4th overall in 2026 ... allowed a first pitch leadoff homer to Carlos Jorge, but retired the next 3 in the bottom of the 1st inning ... worked around a leadoff hit-by-pitch for a scoreless 2nd inning ... allowed an RBI double and single in the 3rd inning ... navigated a two-out error in the 4th inning and one-out single in the 5th inning for back-to-back scoreless frames ... struck out 2 without allowing a run in the 6th inning and did not return for the 7th.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made 7 starts for Northwest Arkansas before his promotion to Omaha ... worked a 4.72 ERA (18 ER in 34.1 IP) with a 1.37 WHIP ... 3 of his 7 starts went 5.0+ innings with 1 or less runs allowed.

CAREER NOTES

2025

- Spent most of the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA), but also made 2 starts for Omaha ... among Royals Minor League pitchers, ranked 5th in innings pitched (115.1) and tied 6th in strikeouts (106).
- Opened the year with the Nationals and threw 5 quality starts over his first 8 appearances ... made his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers on May 28 vs. St. Paul (MIN) ... in 2 starts for Omaha and allowed 9 ER in 8.0 IP (10.13 ERA) before returning to Northwest Arkansas on June 6 to finish his season.

- In Northwest Arkansas, totaled 21 appearances (19 starts) and worked a 4.24 ERA (51 ER in 108.1 IP) with 100 strikeouts and a 1.37 WHIP throughout the season ... named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week for his start on July 2 @ Springfield (STL), tossing 5.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit and 7 strikeouts

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+) ... appeared in 22 games (21 starts) with a 3.68 ERA (42 ER in 102.2 IP) and 92 strikeouts at High-A ... 7 of his 21 starts were scoreless, including his last 3 of the season, for a career-high 21.0-inning scoreless streak that stretched into April 2025.
- Split 2023 between the Royals and Padres organizations ... opened the year with the Lake Elsinore Storm (A) in San Diego's system but the Padres traded him to Kansas City at the trade deadline ... after the trade, made 5 starts for Columbia (A) and posted a 3.38 ERA (9 ER in 24.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts for the Fireflies.
- Made his professional debut at the start of the 2023 season with Lake Elsinore after San Diego drafted him in the 3rd round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Duke University ... made 12 starts for the Storm before his trade to the Royals, working a 5.74 ERA (27 ER in 42.1 IP) with 40 strikeouts for Lake Elsinore ... missed the 2022 season as he recovered from Tommy John surgery.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Attended Duke University (2019-2021), where he appeared in 9 games (7 starts) over 3 seasons with the Blue Devils (ACC), going 3-3 with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER in 37.2 IP) and 45 strikeouts ... only pitched one full season in Durham (2021) due to the COVID-19 pandemic shortening his freshman campaign (2020) and Tommy John surgery in December 2021, keeping him out of action his junior year (2022).
- Lettered in both baseball and basketball all 4 years at Darien High School (CT) ... was a team captain for the basketball team his senior season.
- Father David played collegiate baseball at Davidson College from 1987 to 1991.
