Today: It's both **Farmer Appreciation Day** and **Tacos and Tallboys Night**, featuring \$4 tacos and \$4 tallboys, as the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the opener of a six-game series against the Fort Wayne TinCaps, High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. The Nuts' last home game was all the way back on July 23rd; Lansing is coming off a 4-8 road trip to the Hawkeye State, splitting a six-game series at Quad Cities and dropping five of six at Cedar Rapids.

Last Game, Sunday: Lugnuts 2, Cedar Rapids Kernels 1. Opening Day starter **Joelvis Del Rosario** whiffed nine batters in six dominant shutout innings, allowing two singles and a walk, and **Pedro Santos** followed with six strikeouts in three innings in relief to help the Nuts avoid a six-game sweep at Rise 2 Greatness Field at Veterans Memorial Stadium.

On the Air: **Adam Jaksa** and **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler**, the Lugnuts' broadcast team since 2019, call the action on Bally Live, MiLB.TV and (audio only) StreamGuys.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a 1:05 p.m. Summer Fun Day and a Dog Days of Summer, with dogs welcome to the park. Then on Thursday, attention all Lanstronauts... the reigning eating champion of the world, **Joey Chestnut**, arrives as the Lugnuts play as the Lansing Olive Burgers on Lansing Facts Night / Coors Light Thirsty Thursday featuring \$1 hot dogs, \$2 domestic drafts and \$5 craft drafts.

LUG•NOTES

Streaking: 1B/OF **Danny Bautista, Jr.**, enters today on a team high 13-game hitting streak, longest of the Lugnuts' season, and an 18-game on-base streak, tied for the longest of the year with **Caeden Trenkle** and **Daniel Susac**. Bautista, Jr., who was honored as the Midwest League's Player of the Week for the week of July 25-30, collecting 11 hits in 24 at-bats (.458 avg.) with three doubles, one home run and four RBIs in six games, is hitting .346 (18-52) during the hit streak, which began on July 23, the last Lugnuts home game.

Welcome Aboard: SS **Jacob Wilson**, the Athletics' first round pick in the 2023 draft from Grand Canyon University, taken sixth overall, makes his home debut tonight after joining the Lugnuts last Tuesday in Cedar Rapids. An All-WAC 1st Team honoree in all three years at GCU, Wilson was named the 2023 WAC Defensive Player of the Year and batted .411 with only five strikeouts in 49 games. His father, Jack, played in the Major Leagues from 2001-2012 and was named a National League All-Star. Jack coached Jacob and former Lugnut **Max Muncy** at Thousand Oaks High School before going on to coach Jacob at Grand Canyon. Wilson doubled in his first Midwest League at-bat, collected three hits on Friday, and is hitting .308 overall through four games with two doubles, two walks, one steal, a .438 OBP and a .462 slugging percentage.

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: **Pedro Santos** recorded the save in Sunday's victory, meaning that 21 of the last 23 games that the Lugnuts have played have featured a save. By month: 7 saves in 20 games in April (35%), 9 in 27 in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and six in all six games played in August.

Turnaround: Outfielder **Junior Pérez** opened the year batting .082 (5-for-60) in his first 20 games, including a streak of 32 consecutive hitless at-bats. Since then, he is hitting .270 (68-for-252). His slash line by month: April - .089/.192/.089, .281 OPS; May - .238/.295/.438, .733 OPS; June - .256/.326/.372, .698 OPS; July - .262/.361/.393, .754 OPS; August - 8-for-25, two home runs, two walks, .320/.370/.600, .970 OPS. He has reached base 21 times in the last ten games thanks to 15 hits and six walks.

One to Remember: On September 5, 2017, an 18-year-old **Davis Schneider** went 1-for-3 with a single and a run scored for the Lugnuts in the Crosstown Showdown exhibition against Michigan State. Schneider had been flown in to Lansing from the Gulf Coast League; he never ended up playing in a regular season game for the Nuts. Six years later, a now 24-year-old Schneider made his Major League debut last Friday for the Toronto Blue Jays in Boston, homered in his first at-bat over the Green Monster, and went 2-for-4 in his debut, 3-for-3 with a walk in his second game, and 4-for-5 with a home run in his third game, finishing the series with nine hits in 13 at-bats (.692) against the Red Sox.

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, **Jack Winkler** went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: **Corey Patterson** (7/5/99 at South Bend); **Donnie Hood** (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); **Chip Cannon** (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); **Travis Snider** (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); **Brad Glenn** (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); **Edward Olivares** (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and **Ryan Gold** (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections, though catcher **Daniel Susac**, taken 19th overall out of Arizona last year, was placed on the Injured List on Wednesday. A day prior, shortstop **Jacob Wilson**, the sixth overall pick in 2023, joined the Lugnuts. Wilson's high school teammate, 2021 first-rounder **Max Muncy**, played for the Nuts earlier this season and is now in Double-A Midland.

Big League Nuts: Six Lugnuts have made their MLB debuts in 2023, totaling 179 all-time. Five debuted with the A's (**Ryan Noda** on March 30; **Hogan Harris** on April 14; **Mason Miller** on April 19; **Garrett Acton** on May 14; and **Tyler Soderstrom** on July 14) and one with the Royals (**Samad Taylor** on June 18). **Davis Schneider** (debut with Toronto, August 4) was in the 2017 Crosstown Showdown but did not play in any regular season Lansing games.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: Dayton No. 9 hitter Kevin Feiner went 5-for-6 with four doubles, a solo home run and 6 RBIs, and the Dragons won, 18-5, at Lansing behind 21 hits and nine walks. The Dragons were 14-for-34 with runners in scoring position and stranded 15 runners on base.

2010: Southpaw Greg Wilborn struck out 12 Lugnuts in seven shutout innings, and the Lugnuts were three-hit in an 11-0 loss at Great Lakes.

2015: Dawel Lugo became the latest Lugnut to be traded, joining Tim Locastro and Jesus Tinoco, shipped to the Arizona Diamondbacks (specifically, the Kane County Cougars) in exchange for Cliff Pennington. Meanwhile, Starlyn Surriel gave up a home run to Joe Bennie on the game's first pitch and then settled in to strike out 12 batters in 6 1/3 innings in an 8-5 win over Beloit at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2018: Coincidence? The Lugnuts won their third consecutive game by the same exact 5-4 score, knocking off Dayton in Lansing. (On August 9, the Nuts beat the Dragons... 4-3.)

In a Nutshell: Opened season with Single-A Stockton... debuted in the MWL May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win over the Captains... one of ten starters for Lansing this season... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams... @JakeGarland25.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg).

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

2023 Season: Opened the current campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... lefties batted .260/.302/.380 while righties batted .269/.321/.359... coaxed six double-play balls... avg./OBP by inning: .143/.200 in the 1st, .133/.188 in the 2nd, .188/.188 in the 3rd, .357/.419 in the 4th, .150/.190 in the 5th, .476/.522 in the 6th, .286/.375 in the 7th, .286/.375 in the 8th... opponent base stealers were successful in all four of their attempts.
