THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On May 14, 2016, the Sounds had their way with the Fresno Grizzlies in a 9-1 win at First Horizon Park. Five different players drove in runs, Chad Pinder went a perfect 4-for-4, and Chris Smith tossed seven brilliant innings in the win.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds host the Memphis Redbirds tonight in the fourth of a six-game series. Pitcher Bubba Derby delivered a pinch-hit home run to break a 2-2 tie and propel the Nashville Sounds to an 8-2 win over the Memphis Redbirds in front of 3,976 fans last night at First Horizon Park. Left-hander Wade LeBlanc makes his second start for the Sounds against left-hander Bernardo Flores Jr. for the Redbirds.

Wade LeBlanc: 36-year-old Wade LeBlanc makes his second start tonight for the Sounds. LeBlanc pitched 3.0 scoreless innings and struck out four in a no decision at Toledo on May 8. The left-hander is in his second stint with the Milwaukee organization after beginning the 2021 season with the Baltimore Orioles. He made 6 appearances with Baltimore (1 start) and went 0-1 with a 9.45 ERA in 6.2 innings. He started against Oakland on April 24 and allowed 4 runs in 1.2 innings and was designated for assignment the next day. Milwaukee signed LeBlanc to a minor league contract on May 4 and assigned him to Nashville. The Major League veteran has a career record of 46-47 with a 4.55 ERA in 240 big league games. He was drafted by the San Diego Padres in the 2nd round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of

Bernardo Flores Jr.: 25-year-old Bernardo Flores Jr. is making his first start tonight for the Redbirds. He made an appearance out of the bullpen for Memphis on May 8 vs. Durham and gave up one run in 3.1 innings of work. He made an appearance with the St. Louis Cardinals on May 5 vs. New York-AL and gave up one run on one hit without recording an out. He made two appearances with Chicago-AL in 2020, he pitched 2.0 innings and surrendered two runs on four hits. He was named a Carolina Mid-Season All-Star in 2018 and was named a MiLB.com Organization All-Star in 2017 and 2018 (Chicago-AL).

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 0, Second: 0, Third: 1, Fourth: 7, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

NL MVP in Nashville: 2018 National League MVP winner Christian Yelich joins the Sounds today on a MLB rehab assignment. Milwaukee placed Yelich on the injured list on May 4 with a lower back strain. He is batting .353 (12-for-34) in 10 games with the Brewers.

Slugging Sounds: Nashville leads the Triple-A East with a .542 slugging percentage and are tied for second with 17 home runs.

Home Run Derby: Pitcher Bubba Derby hit a pinch-hit home run last night in Nashville's 8-2 win. He is the first Sounds pitcher to homer since June 14, 2014 (Kyle Heckathorn vs. Reno) and the first to hit a pinch-hit homer since July 6, 2016 (Max Muncy at Memphis).

Leadoff Pop: Dee Strange-Gordon hit the Sounds first leadoff home run of the 2021 season on May 12 vs. Memphis and first since June 24, 2019 (Zack Granite at New Orleans).

Start the Streaks: Three active Sounds have modest on-base streaks of six games - Dee Strange-Gordon, Zach Green and Derek Fisher have all reached base safely in six straight.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

There's History Here: The Sounds enjoyed 10 years as the Brewers' top affiliate from 2005-14. The 2005 season culminated with the Sounds winning the Pacific Coast League Championship - the City of Nashville's most recent championship in any sport. Nashville compiled a 723-713 (.503) record during the 10-year stretch and made three consecutive postseason berths from 2005-07. In 2007, the Sounds won 89 games, the second-most in franchise history (97 in 1980).

Top Prospects: Nashville opened the 2021 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 5 prospect, left-handed pitcher Aaron Ashby is the No. 7 prospect, outfielder Corey Ray is the No. 24 prospect and left-handed pitcher Clayton Andrews is the No. 25 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,035-1,924. The 2,035 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

That Doesn't Hurt So Bad: The Sounds have five Major League rehabbers on the roster. Outfielder Christian Yelich (May 4 - lower back strain), infielder Daniel Robertson (April 26 - concussion), outfielder Derek Fisher (April 1 - strained left hamstring), infielder/outfielder Jace Peterson (April 23 - cryotherapy on left thumb) and infielder/outfielder Tim Lopes (March 8 - right oblique) are all on the current roster.

LAST OUTING: LeBlanc pitched 3.0 scoreless innings and struck out four in a no decision at Toledo on May 8. He left the game with the score tied at zero. He threw 57 pitches (35 strikes).

AGAINST OPPONENT: LeBlanc is facing Memphis for the fifth time in his career. He is 1-1 with a 3.50 ERA (7 ER/18 IP) in five starts with 18 strikeouts. He last faced the Redbirds on June 20, 2014 with Salt Lake.
