SEASONS GREETINGS: The Cardinals host Wichita (MIN) in the 2nd game of a 3-game series and brief 3-game homestand ... celebrate Christmas in July with a Christmas-themed jersey auction benefitting Knights of Columbus and a Hiland Dairy Kids Jersey auction.

RINC MASTER: RHP Hancel Rincon makes his 7th appearance (6th start) for the Cards and his 2nd vs. WCH ... picked up a win in last start allowing 1 run on 6 hits with 6 SO and no walks over 6.0 IP on 7/11 at CC ... in only other start against Wind Surge gave up 2 runs on 5 hits with 8 SO over 5.0 frames on 6/29 at Equity Bank Park.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Springfield walked off Wichita on a C Leonardo Bernal RBI-infield single in the 9th inning ... IF Dakota Harris hit a 2-run shot and IF Jeremy Rivas hit a solo HR ... LHP Pete Hansen allowed 2 runs over 5.2 IP in the start ... LHP Nick Raquet got the win, his 8th, in relief.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME FOR THE HOLIDAYS: The Cards have won a season-high 9-straight home games ... have not lost at Hammons Field since 6/17 ... are 16-1 in the Queen City since June 1.

DUB STEPS: Springfield is riding a season-high 8-game win streak that began on 7/6 at NWA ... is a season-high 26 games above .500 at 57-31 ... holds the best record in the TXL.

A GOOD STRETCH: The Cardinals are 45-15 (.750 win pct) over their last 60 games ... are 25-5 (.833) over last 30 games and 14-2 (.875) over last 16 games.

HO HO HO-MERS: The Cardinals have hit home runs in a season-high 6-straight games dating back to 7/10 at CC ... are 42-9 in games in which they hit a home run this season.
